On August 24, 2023, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) received a No Further Action Request with the applicable fee for the site listed above. The DNR has reviewed the document and concurs that the environment has been restored to the extent practicable as provided in Wisconsin Administrative (Wis. Admin.) Code chapter NR 708.09. The immediate action in response to a discharge has been completed and the DNR is requiring no further action at this time.

On August 3, 2022, Enbridge noted petroleum impacted soils while conducting maintenance on Line 5 at the Holmes Road Transfer Station. It was determined that the source of the contamination was not an active leak and was residual contamination from a valve that was installed in 1974. A total of approximately 340.5 tons of soil was excavated and disposed at the Vonco V Waste Management Landfill. No groundwater was encountered during the excavation.
