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Hey Denice,

Please see the following comments related to the new no anchoring signage (a photo of the current boom landing sign is included for reference):

- 1. Include a statement "Arsenic impacted sediments" on all of the signs. This could be similar to the original signs which used a header/footer "title" on each sign.
- 2. The no anchoring symbol should fit completely within the specified area and none of the arrows/text should obstruct the area that is restricted. The colors should match so people can connect the symbol to the area and text visually.
- 3. If practicable, all the signs should show the same extent.
- 4. For consistency, the last two signs should use the same symbology for the "you are here" sign.
- 5. All the signs should highlight the no anchoring area the same way, red is recommended to reflect the related text.
