This document provides a summary of actions taken by the Air National Guard (ANG) at Truax Field, Wisconsin related to the remedial investigation (RI) for per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS).

## Summary of Completed Activities from July through December 2023

Field activities continued under Mobilization 2 for the RI. Mobilization 2 activities include installation, development, and sampling of new monitoring wells; installation and sampling of lysimeters; and additional soil, surface water, and sediment sampling as necessary to meet the objectives of the RI. Monitoring well installation activities started in Winter 2023 and will continue into Spring 2024. Following a contract modification in 2023, the work plan for the RI is being updated to include the newer U.S Environmental Protection Agency Regional Screening Levels for PFAS, updated in May 2023. The work plan is also being updated to include analysis of groundwater and porewater by Draft Method 1633. Lysimeter installation was completed in November 2023, and sampling will be completed following approval of the updated work plan.

## Summary of Planned Activities from January to June 2024

The team will finalize the Programmatic work plan update, and initiate/continue additional field activities to include:

- Installation, development, and sampling of approximately 80 new monitoring wells (continued)
- Surveying of approximately 80 new monitoring wells
- Collection of additional surface and subsurface soil samples
- Sampling of approximately 10 lysimeters (anticipated quarterly in 2024)
- Collection of additional surface water and sediment samples (as warranted)

The ANG will coordinate with the Dane County Regional Airport for investigation activities completed within the airfield. At the conclusion of field activities, the team will begin development of the RI Report.
