Dave,
As you requested in our earlier phone conversation, here are the questions I have

regarding the Rhinelander Airport PFAS site:

1. Has a second round of sampling at the residential wells occurred yet?
AECOM is working with Randall Myrum, City of Rhinelander DPW Director, to schedule the next round of sampling. AECOM has rebid the laboratory services and we're aiming to send the homeowner letters in the near future.

1. Follow up to that, has a summary report of initial results been developed yet?
No, Results from the first round of sampling were provided to WDNR; a summary report will be submitted after the second round.

2. On page 3, last paragraph of Mr. Lewandowski's Jan. 18, 2023 letter to the department, there is a statement on DNR interpretation of results from municipal wells 7 & 8 and how purge pumping affected those results and how it relates to a well head protection plan submitted to us. Can you clarify the exact request/objective of this statement. Additionally, I do not believe the R&R program has received the well head protection plan for these wells in any submittal to date.
This statement was included with input from Acting Rhinelander City Attorney Steve Sorenson; Please contact legal counsel in regards to information presented in the Jan. 18, 2023 letter to the Department.

3. On page 5, 3rd from last paragraph of the Jan. 18, 2023 letter, it is indicated that due to the wide variety of lab results an analysis of the existing lab results is being performed to determine if AFFF is not the only source of the contamination. Has that analysis been performed yet?
The RP Group is still evaluating the first round sampling data and will look at this further when the next round of sample data are available.

4. Has there been any approval from the FAA regarding the proposed site investigation field work yet?
RHI is still waiting to hear whether the FAA will issue an approval for the proposed site investigation work on airport property.

Thanks for any input you can provide to these questions.
