I'm responding to your request for info on potential vapor sources north of the Mercury Marine Plant No. 1 site.

The soil vapor sample that you asked about was taken in 1989 in the parking lot between Hanover Avenue and Washington Avenue that now services Amy's Candy Kitchen, The Chocolate Factory, and other downtown businesses. It is associated with the closed Cedarburg Platco (Former Drycleaner) site, which has BRRTS number 02-46-550405.

You mention that the BRRTS database does not provide much information regarding the sites immediately north of the Mercury Marine Plant No. 1 site. However, either the entire site file or the continuing obligations packet (which will contain all data collected for a site) is available at each of these sites. If there are any particular documents that you feel you are missing, please let me know and I can attempt to locate them. The BRRTS database and RR sites map contain information on all known contamination sites. If you believe the subject property is being impacted by an off-site property, you can consider submitting for DNR review a request and technical justification for an off-site liability clarification.
