

CONSERVATION WARDEN LIVING REQUIREMENTS

The Division of Public Safety and Resource Protection is recruiting to fill approximately 10-15 vacant positions throughout Wisconsin. According to DNR policy, Conservation Wardens must live:

- Within the State of Wisconsin
- Within their administrative area OR
 - Within 10 driving miles of the administrative area's boundary
 - Within 15 driving miles of the assigned city

No exceptions to these living requirements will be made. Wardens will be required to meet these living requirements once they report to station, after their initial training is concluded. Depending on prior experiences, training will run either 8 or 12 months long. Lodging during training will be provided to recruit wardens.

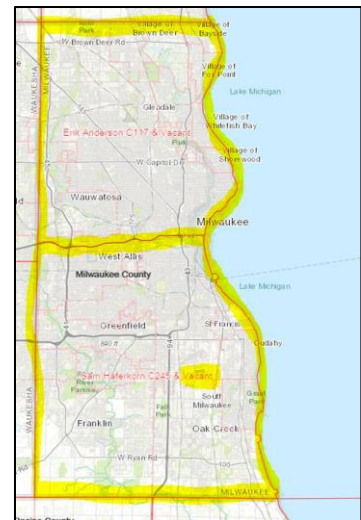
The following stations are currently vacant, and we are planning to fill them with this current recruitment. SOUTHEAST REGION

Milwaukee – South

The Milwaukee County - South station is headquartered in the City of Milwaukee, with an administrative area that includes southern Milwaukee County (South of I-94). Wardens assigned to this station must live within 10 driving miles of the administrative area border or within 15 driving miles of the City of Milwaukee, WI.

SOUTH CENTRAL REGION

Lancaster

The Lancaster station is headquartered in Lancaster, with an administrative area that includes southern Grant County. Wardens assigned to this station must live within 10 driving miles of the administrative area border or within 15 driving miles of Lancaster, WI.

Reedsburg

The Reedsburg station is headquartered in Reedsburg, with an administrative area that includes parts of Sauk County and Richland County. Wardens assigned to this station must live within 10 driving miles of the administrative area border or within 15 driving miles of Reedsburg, WI.

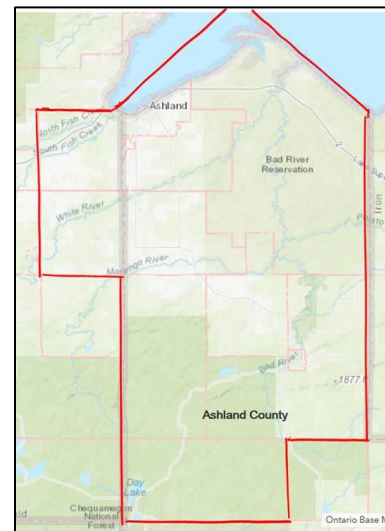


NORTHERN REGION

Ashland

The Ashland station is headquartered in Ashland, with an administrative area that includes northern Ashland County and portions of Bayfield County. Wardens assigned to this station must live within 10 driving miles of the administrative area border or within 15 driving miles of Ashland, WI.

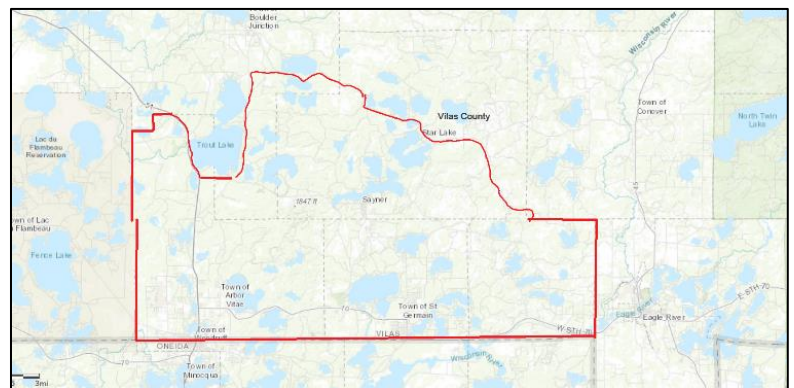

Saint Germain

The Saint Germain station is a property-specific station affiliated with the Northern Highland – American Legion State Forest. The administrative area includes portions of the Northern Highland – American Legion State Forest in central Vilas County as well surrounding private and public lands. Wardens assigned to this station must live within 10 driving miles of the administrative area border or within 15 driving miles of the station office in Boulder Junction.

Prentice/Price County

The Prentice station is headquartered in Prentice, WI with an administrative area that encompasses the southern two-thirds of Price County. Wardens assigned to this station must live within 10 driving miles of the administrative area border or within 15 driving miles of Prentice, WI.

High Cliff State Park

The High Cliff Station is headquartered in Sherwood, WI with a property-specific administrative area of High Cliff State Park. Wardens assigned to this station must live within 10 driving miles of Calumet County or within 15 driving miles of Sherwood, WI.

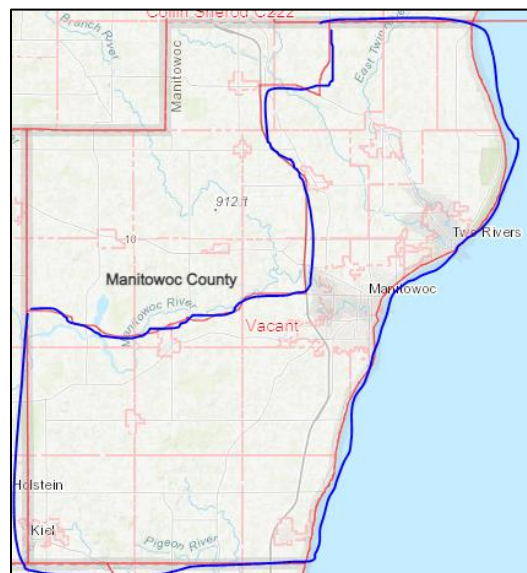

The Manitowoc station is headquartered in Manitowoc, with an administrative area that includes Northeast and Southern Manitowoc County. Wardens assigned to this station must live within 10 driving miles of the administrative area border or within 15 driving miles of Manitowoc, WI.

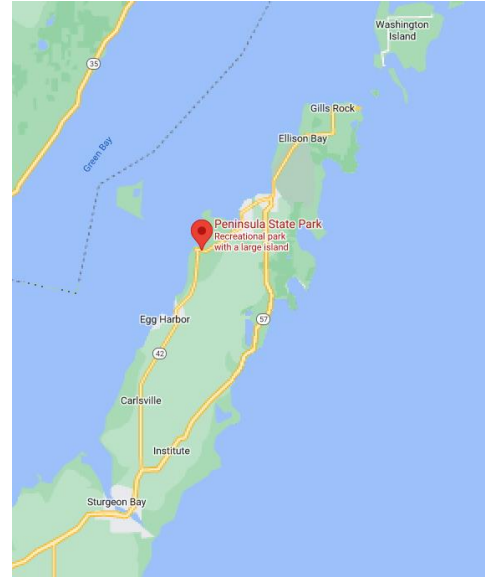

The Peninsula Park station is a property specific station and is headquartered out of Fish Creek, within Door County. Wardens assigned to this station must live within 30 driving miles of Fish Creek, WI

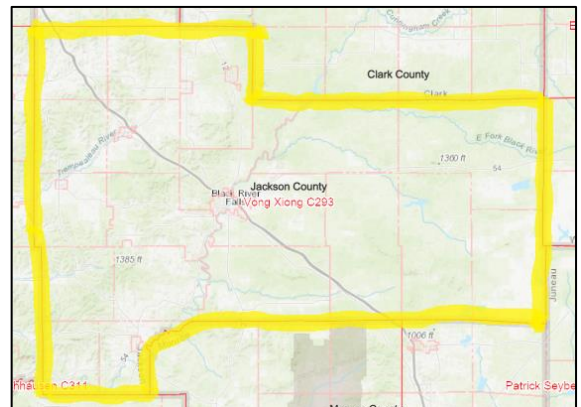


WEST CENTRAL REGION

Jackson County

The Jackson County station is a county-wide station. Conservation Wardens assigned to this station must reside in Jackson County, within 10 driving miles of the Jackson County border, or within 15 driving miles of Black River Falls.
