Notice: Pursuant to ss. 29.179, 29.180 and 29.185(4), Wis. Stats., completion of this form is required to transfer a wolf license from a holder of the license to a person who is at least 18 years of age or a minor and is otherwise eligible to use the license. False representation of facts may result in prosecution, penalty and/or revocation of license. Information collected may be used for participation in surveys, eligibility for approvals, law enforcement purposes and other secondary purposes. Personal Information may be provided to requesters to the extent required by Wisconsin's Open Records Law (ss. 19.31-19.39, Wis. Stats.).

Transfer Qualifications

I am the holder of a wolf harvesting license and am requesting to transfer the license and accompanying carcass tag under the following law: (check one)

- Transfer of License to a Minor** - A person who has been awarded a wolf license may transfer that license to a minor who is under the age of 18, is eligible to use the approval, and has not been previously transferred a wolf license approval. s. 29.179, Wis. Stats. **Application for transfer must be received at least 15 days prior to the start of the season.**
- Transfer of Approval or Preference Points to a Minor Upon Death** - If a person who has been awarded a wolf license dies before the first day of the season, the designee may apply to transfer the license to a minor, s. 29.180, Wis. Stats. Note: there is no limit to the number of times a minor may receive a wolf license which is transferred under this authority. A designee may also apply to transfer any wolf preference points to a minor within one year of the person's death.
- Transfer of Wolf License to anyone at least 18 years of age** - A person who has been awarded a wolf license may transfer that license to another person who is at least 18 years of age and is eligible to use the license, s. 29.185(4), Wis. Stats. **Application for transfer must be received at least 15 days prior to the start of the season.** Note: there is no limit to the number of times an adult may receive a wolf license which is transferred under this authority.

Information

Social Security Number: A social security number is REQUIRED the first time you apply for a hunting or fishing license according to s. 29.024(2g), Wis. Stats. Such number WILL NOT be disclosed to any other person except to the Department of Children & Family Services to determine liability for unpaid child or family support. Once you have applied for a license, the DNR will provide you a DNR Customer Number that you may provide for future transactions.

- There is no transaction fee for the transfer.
- The Transferor may not receive payment or considerations for the transfer of the approval.
- Transferor is NOT required to purchase the license approval before submitting the transfer request. Transferors, who have purchased their license, must submit their license along with the transfer application. Qualified refund requests will be issued for the original license purchase.
- Transferor must not be subject to any suspension or revocation that prevents the exercise of DNR privileges.
- License fees: No license fees are required to be submitted at time of application. Transferee will pay the license fees at time of license purchase.
- Transferees born on or after January 1, 1973, who do not wish to hunt under the Mentor Hunting Rules, must provide a photocopy of their state-issued hunter education certificate.
