Note: CWFP applications are accepted year-round for projects *not* seeking principal forgiveness (PF). For both PF and non-PF CWFP projects, the loan closing must be within eight months of the application acceptance notification date. Note: When a deadline falls on a weekend, that deadline, by statute, is extended to Monday.

Loan closing timeline

To receive its Financial Assistance Agreement (FAA) on time, a municipality must submit any remaining required documentation, including the first request for disbursement (#1), to their DNR project manager *at least five weeks before* its municipal meeting. A municipality must submit to DNR any additional disbursement requests (i.e. #2, #3, etc.) for payment on the closing date one week before its municipal meeting. The loan closing date will occur *approximately two weeks after* the municipal meeting and is held on the 2nd or 4th Wednesday of the month. The DOA will wire the municipality's first disbursement of loan funds on the loan closing date.
