### PLAN SUMMARY

This draft master plan preserves the views into and out of the center of the habitation area by placing the Visitor's Center at the base of a large hill between Highway Q and the stockade wall. This places the most disruptive part of our plan closest to an area that has already been disturbed and investigated. We know that this area contains relatively less archeological artifacts than other parts of the site.

The rest of the plan contains other features that were popular on the preliminary options. These include, interpretive trails, access to the east side of the Crawfish, interpretation of the effigy mounds, an archeological support facility, and many other features.
