Detailed information: Pursuant to s.s 281.36(3g)(g), Wis. Stats., the Department of Natural Resources will hold a public informational hearing on the reissuance of a [statewide general permit for wetland discharges](#) that are a part of development for recreational purposes. The statewide general permit is valid for 5 years and will allow applicants to apply for coverage under the permit for discharges of dredged or fill material into a wetland up to 10,000 square feet (0.23 acres) for purposes of recreational development if the impact meets all of the eligibility criteria and conditions of the general permit.
