

Cougar - Additional Requirements for Captive Wild Animal Farm License



Notice: Pursuant to s. 169.15(5), Wis. Stats., this form is required to be submitted along with form 9400-577, Captive Wild Animal Farm License Application, when applying for a license to have cougar on a captive wild animal farm. The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has additional standards, limitations, and requirements for captive wild animal farm licenses and for captive wild animal farms, including fencing of the farms. Personal information collected may be used for participation in surveys, eligibility for approvals, law enforcement and other secondary purposes and may be provided to requesters to the extent required by Wisconsin's Open Records laws (ss. 19.31-19.39, Wis. Stats.)

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1. Fencing Requirement	
In most cases an outdoor housing facility for harmful wild animals shall be enclosed by a secondary perimeter fence that is at least 8 feet high and at least 3 feet from the primary enclosure and which restricts unauthorized public from entering the area where the primary enclosure is located. Variations or exceptions require special written approval from the DNR.	Height of Perimeter Fence Surrounding Enclosure Feet

2. Written Assurance Requirement
Initial Application - Initial captive wild animal farm applications must be accompanied by written assurance that the application is in compliance with local ordinances and zoning regulations on possession of captive wild animals.

3. Environment Enhancement Plan Requirement	
Holders of bear, cougar, bobcat and/or lynx shall develop, document and follow an appropriate plan for environment enhancement adequate to promote the psychological well being of these captive wild animals. The plan shall be in accordance with the currently accepted professional standards as cited in appropriate professional journals or reference guides, and as directed by the attending veterinarian. The plan shall be made available to DNR staff upon request.

4. Confinement Area
 Cougar pens shall be a minimum of 200 square feet. No more than one cougar may be held in a 200 square-foot pen. At least 100 additional square feet is required for each additional cougar. The pen height shall be a minimum of 8 feet. Resting surfaces shall be elevated, impervious to moisture, and be able to be easily cleaned and sanitized, or easily replaced when soiled or worn. Cougar pens with open tops shall be a minimum of 1,000 square feet. The walls of of open top pens shall be a minimum of 10 feet in height with an additional 4 feet at the top slanted in at a 30 to 45 degree angle.

Facilities that Exhibit: Harmful wild animals may only be exhibited at the location authorized on the license. Exhibition of a harmful wild animal at an alternate location requires special written approval from the DNR. Pens must be surrounded on all sides where the public may approach them by substantial guard rails not less than 3 feet in height. Guard rails must be well supported, fully enclosed with not greater than 6 inch square fencing, and shall be at least 3 feet from the pens.		Draw Primary Enclosure, include dimensions in feet.
