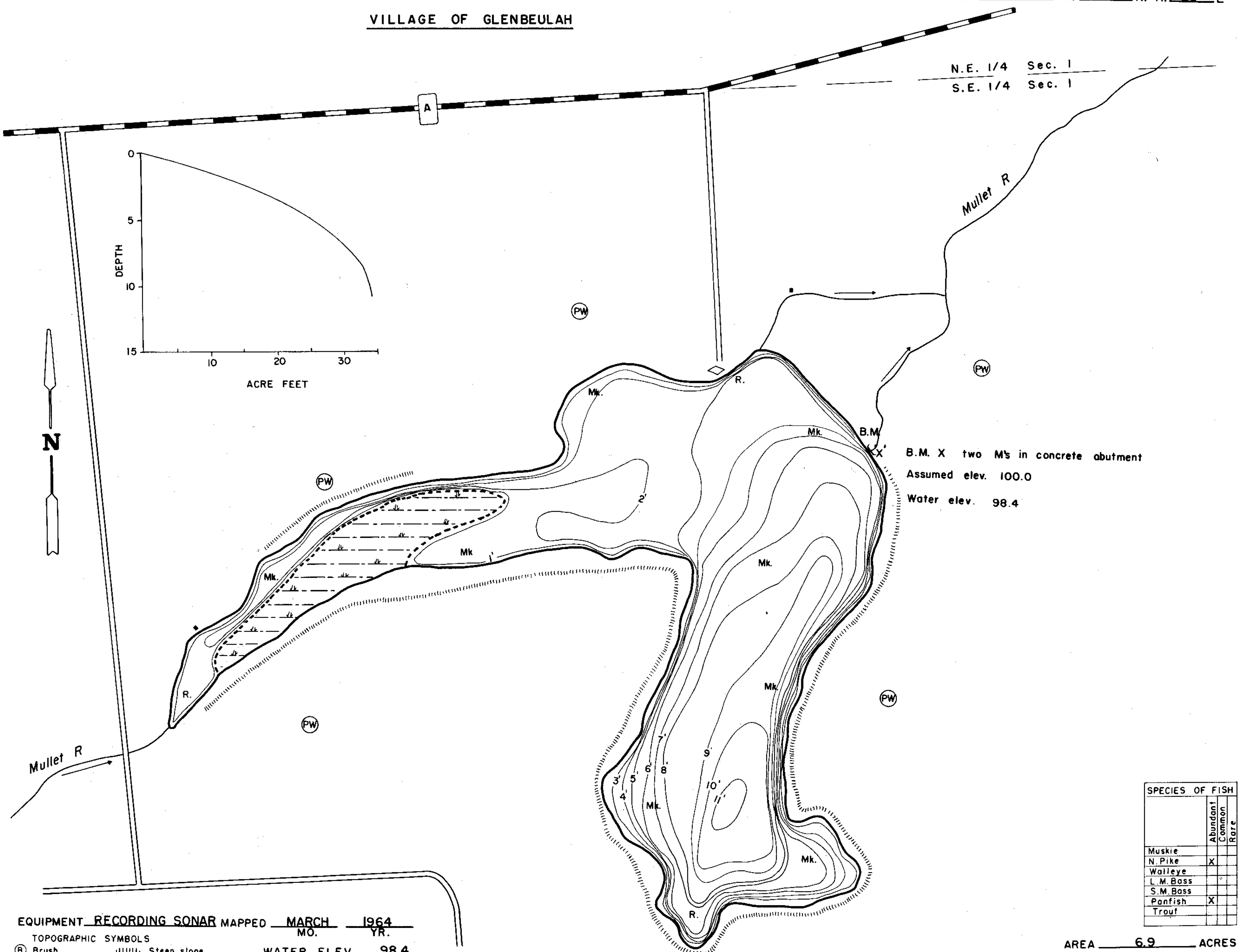
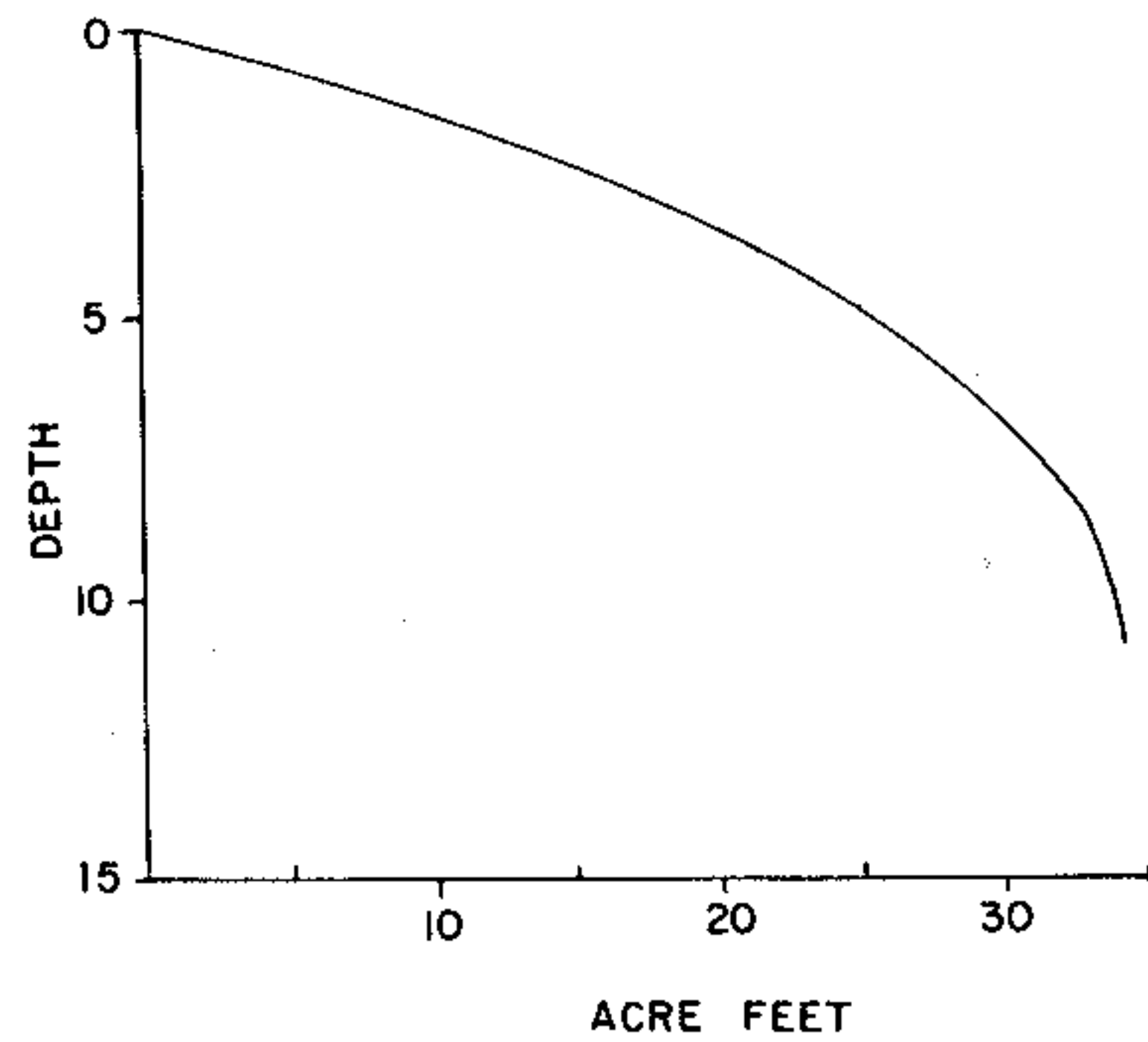

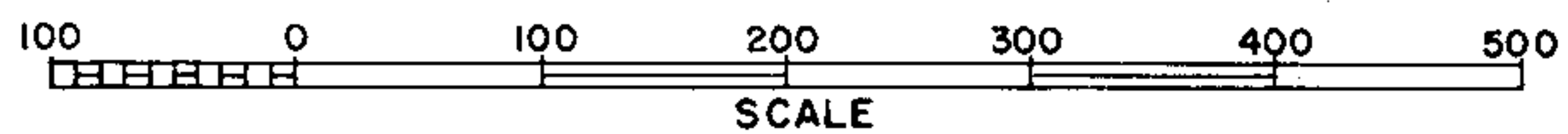
B.M. X two M's in concrete abutment
