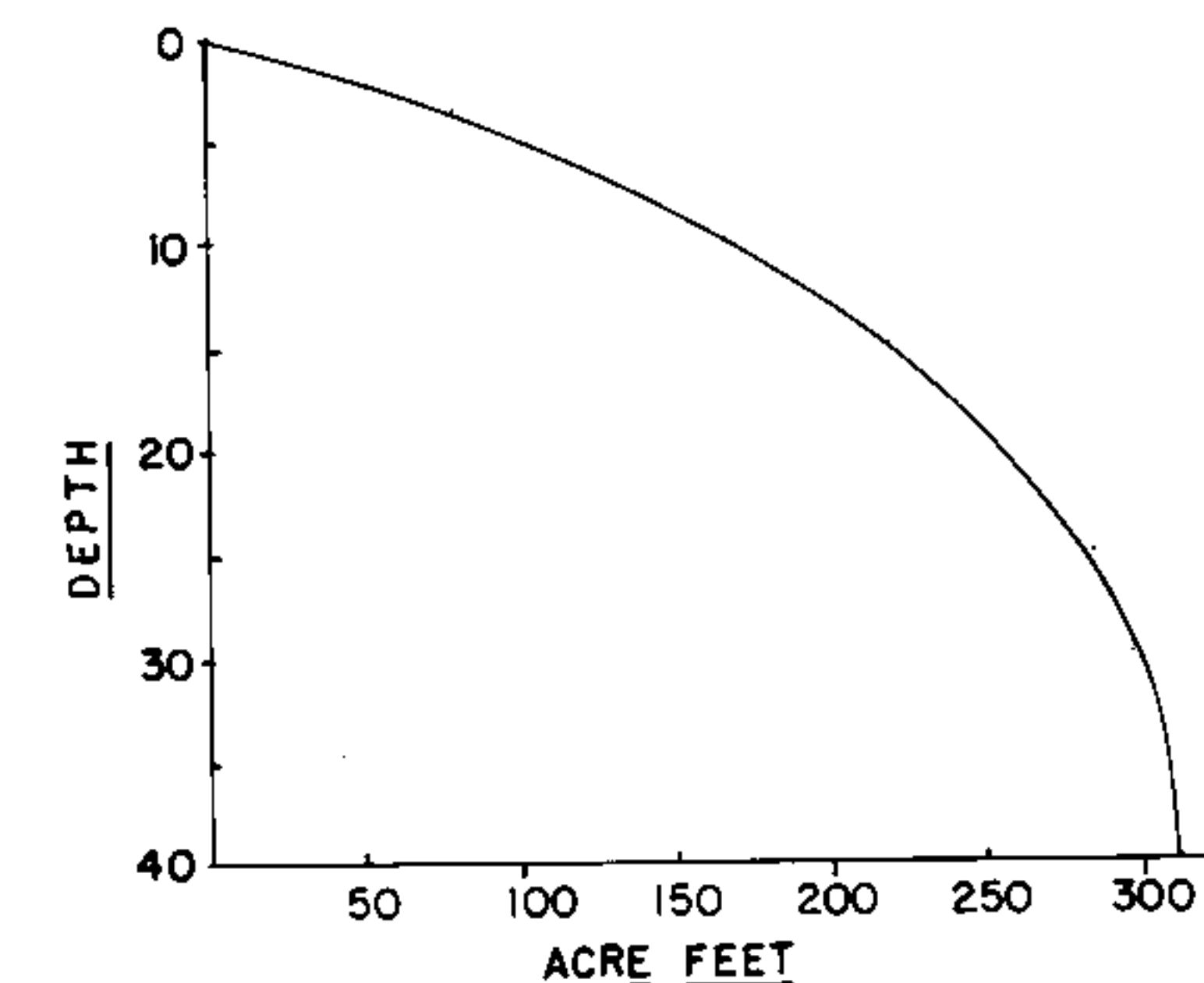
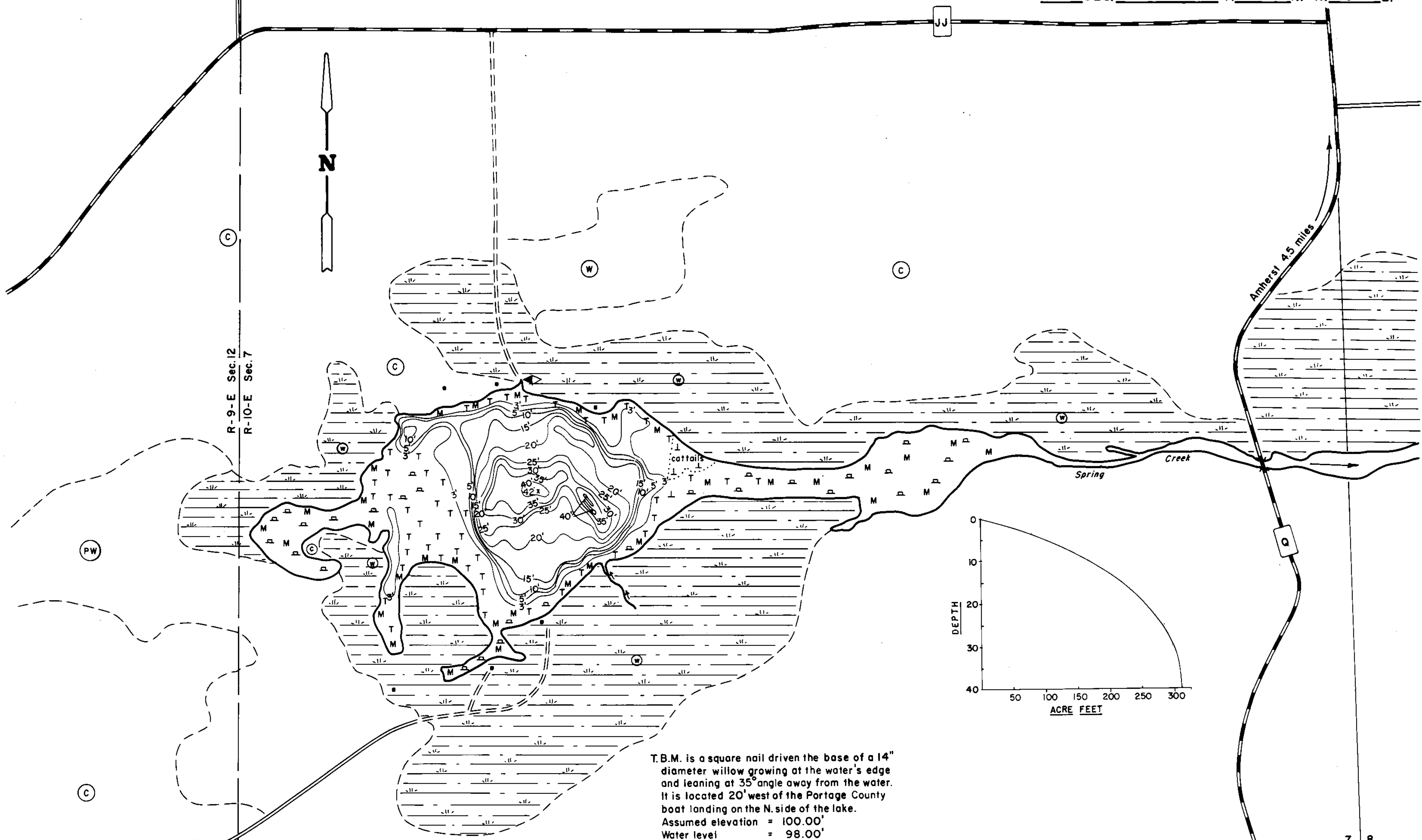


LAKE SURVEY MAP



T.B.M. is a square nail driven the base of a 14" diameter willow growing at the water's edge and leaning at 35° angle away from the water. It is located 20' west of the Portage County boat landing on the N. side of the lake.
Assumed elevation = 100.00'
Water level = 98.00'
