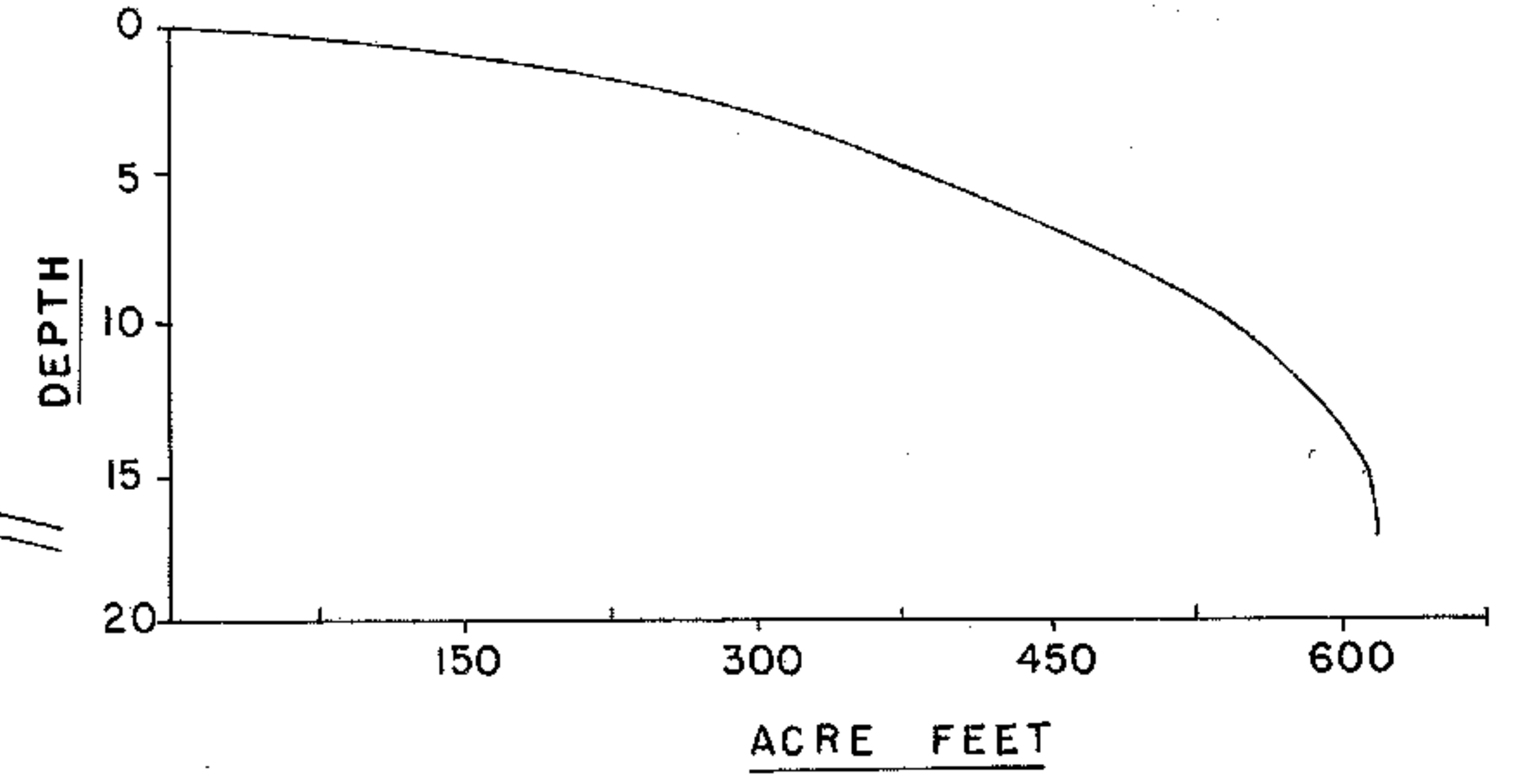
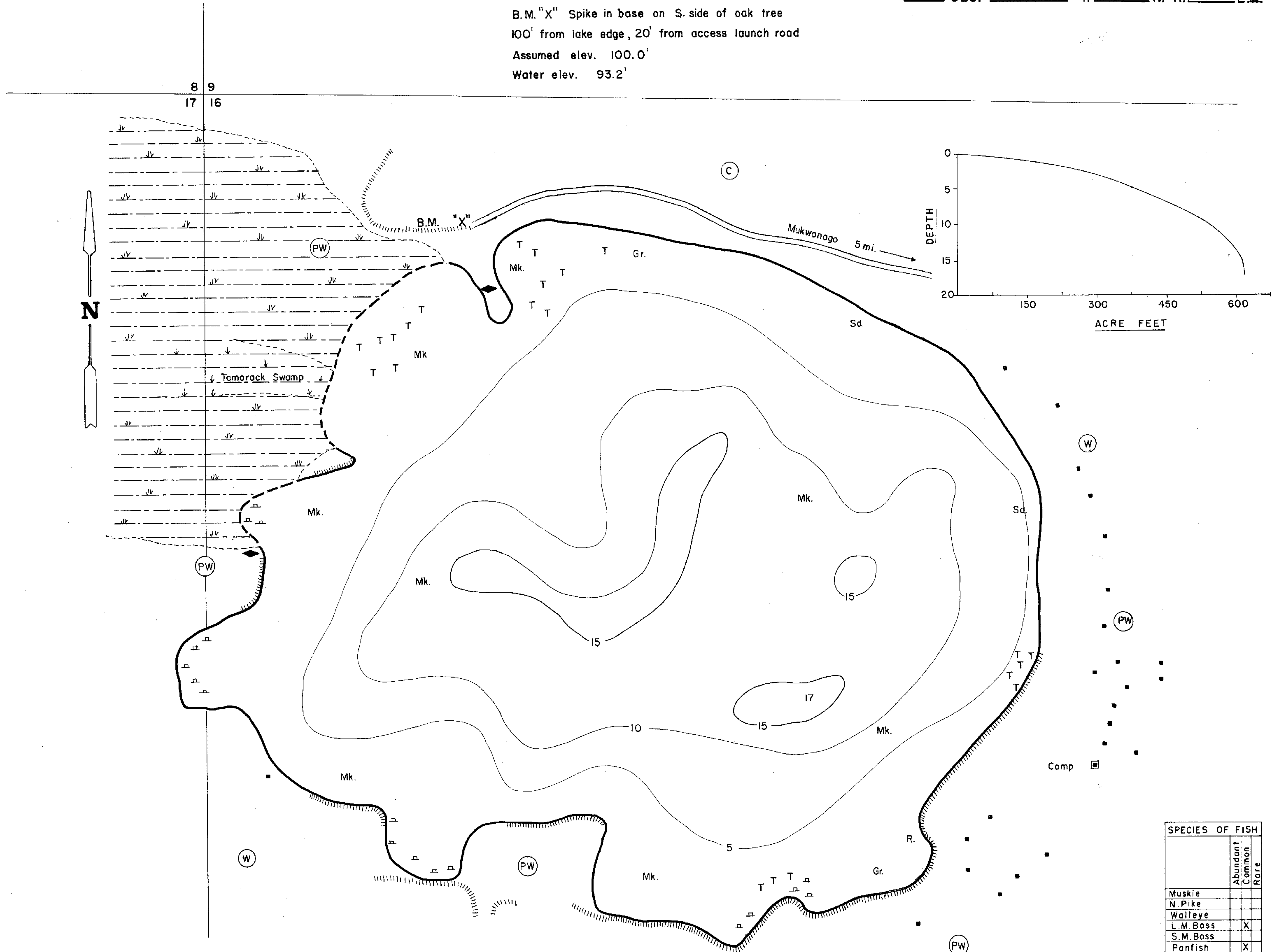


B.M. "X" Spike in base on S. side of oak tree

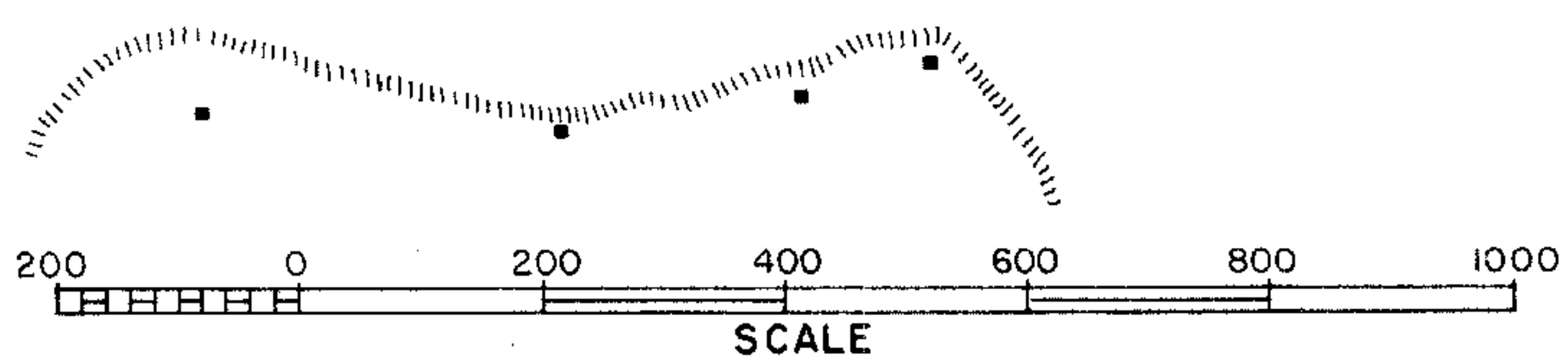
