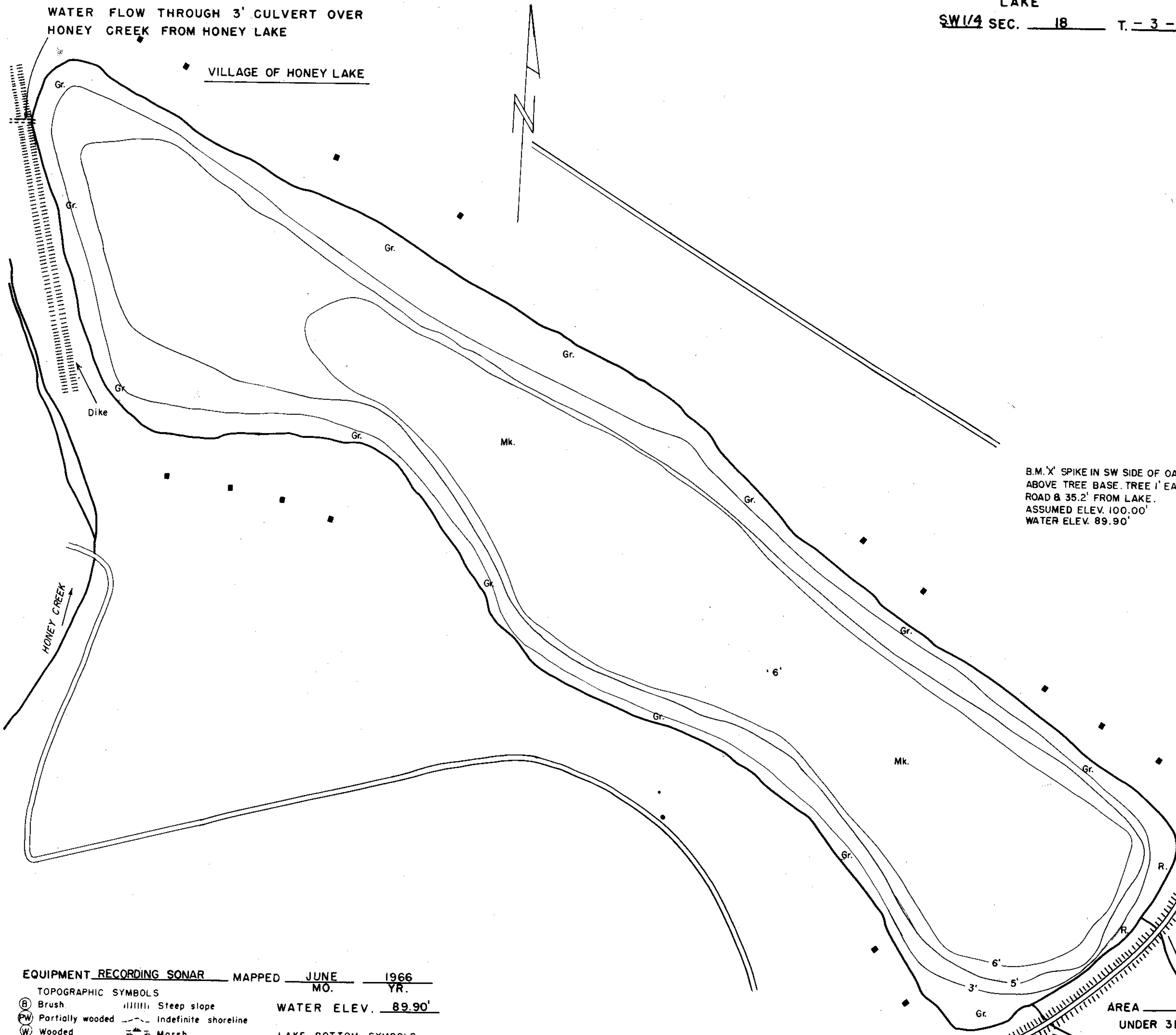


WATER FLOW THROUGH 3' CULVERT OVER HONEY CREEK FROM HONEY LAKE

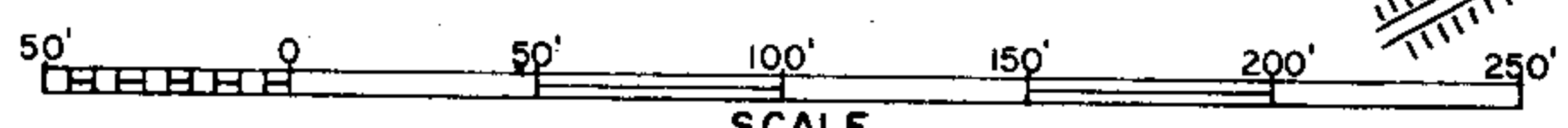
