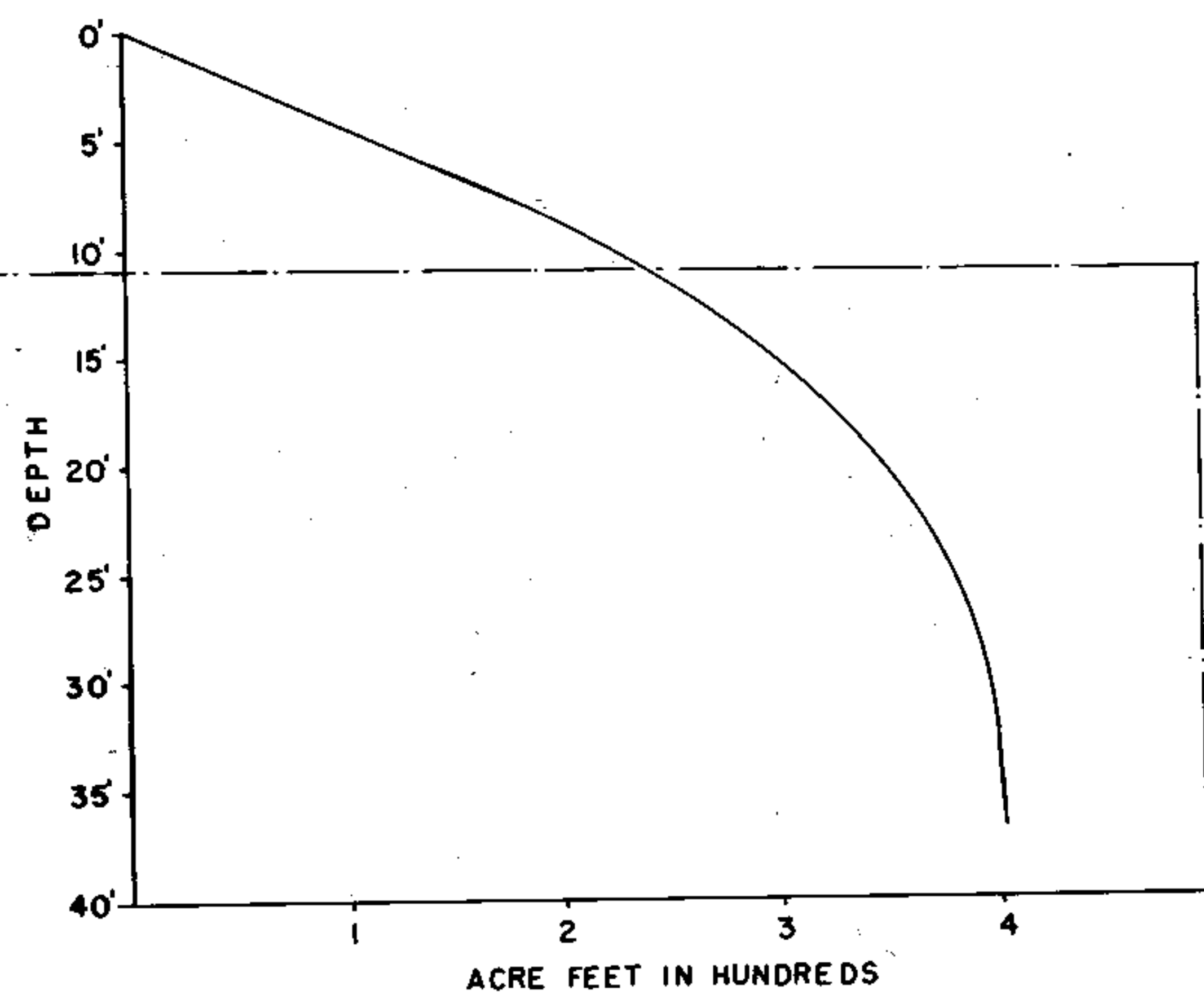
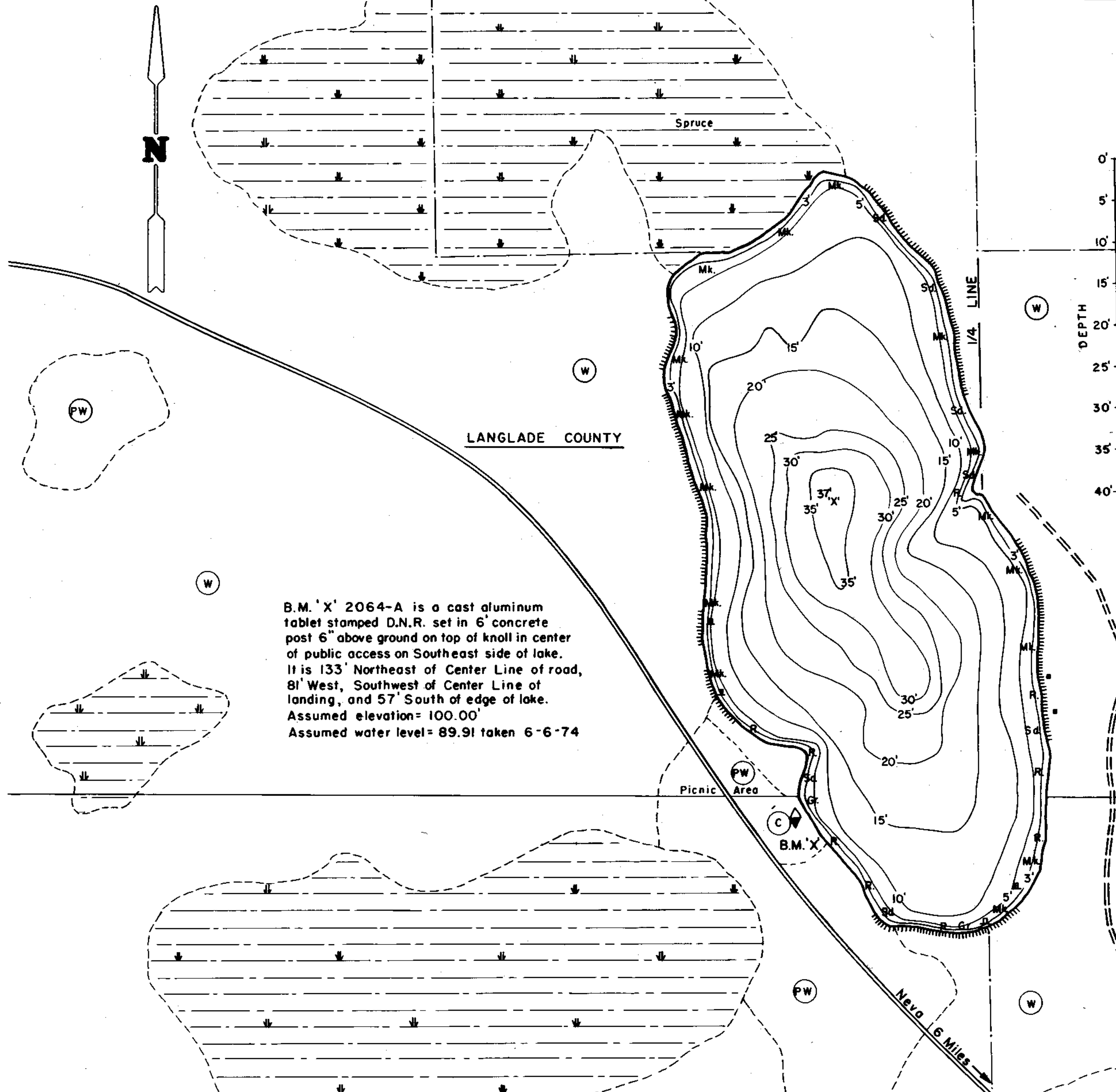


LANGLADE COUNTY
