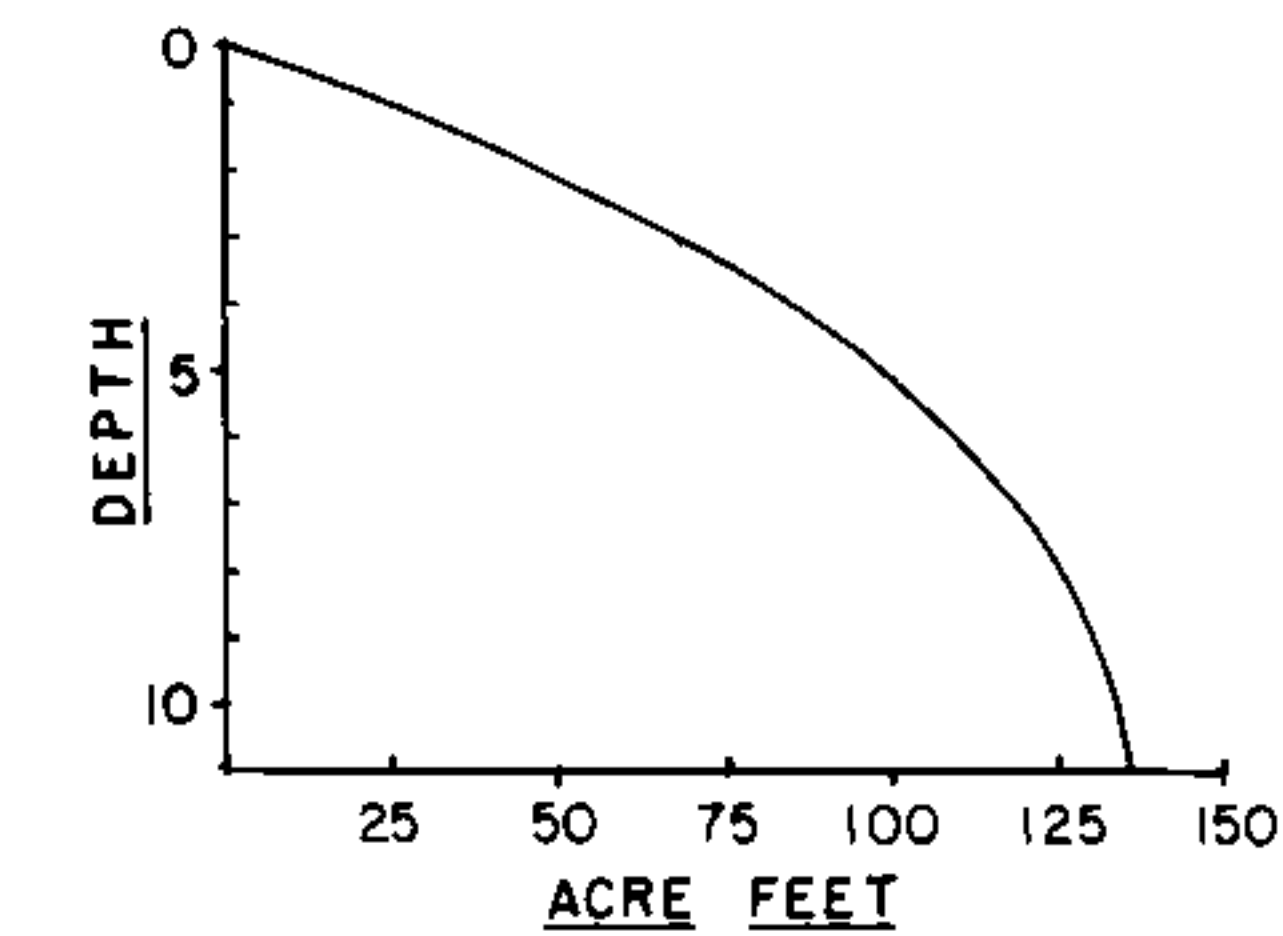

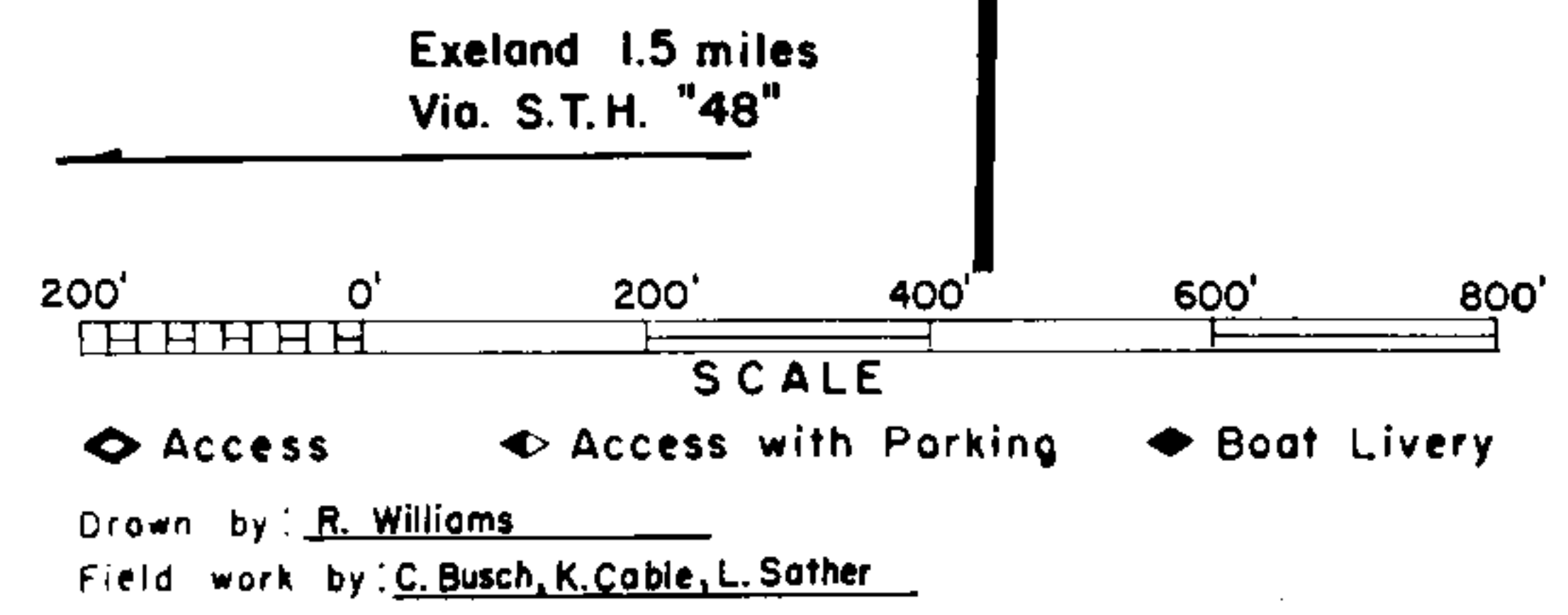
"X" B.M. NW 1/4 Sec. 23
