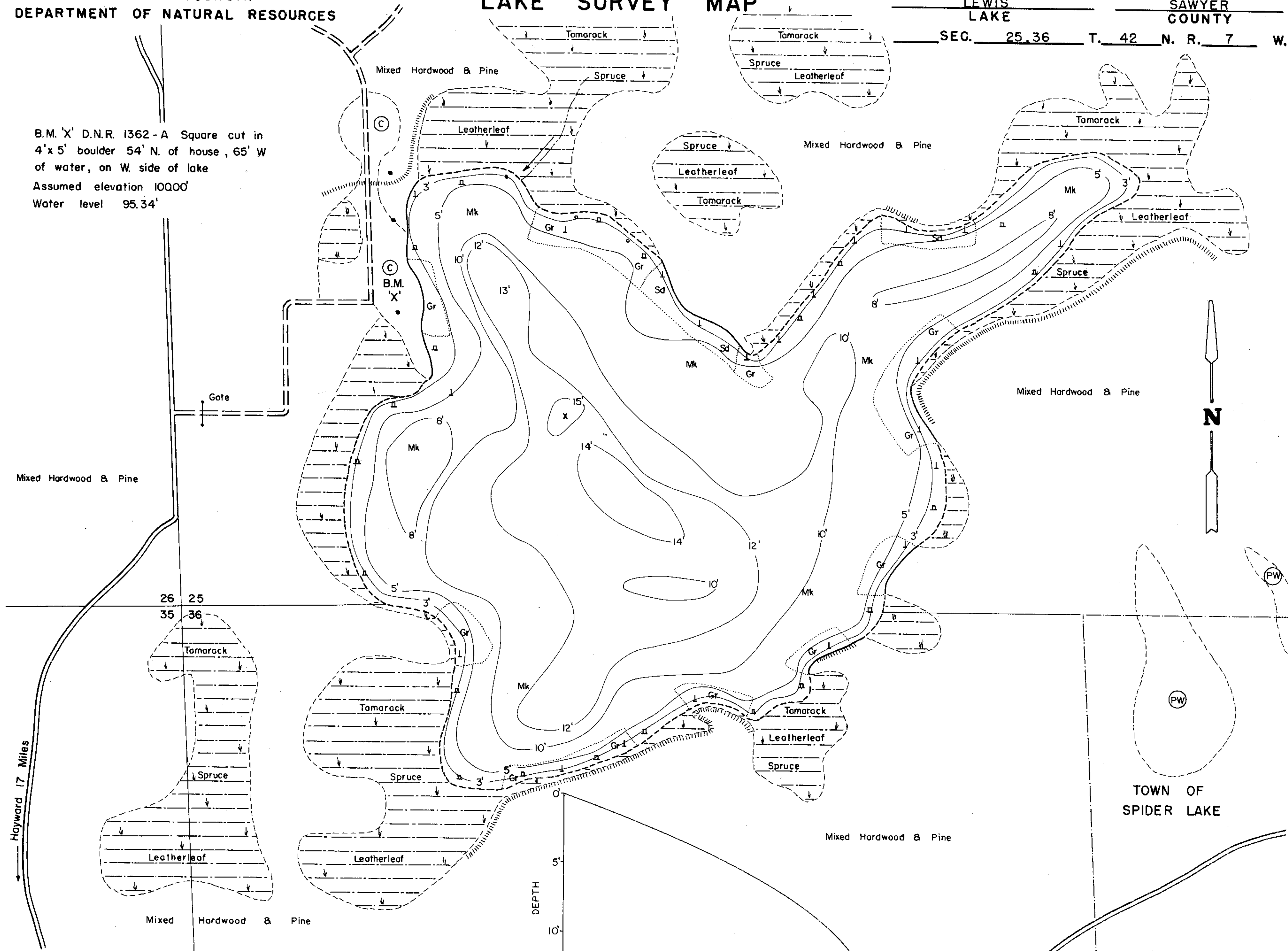


LAKE SURVEY MAP

Water level 95.34'

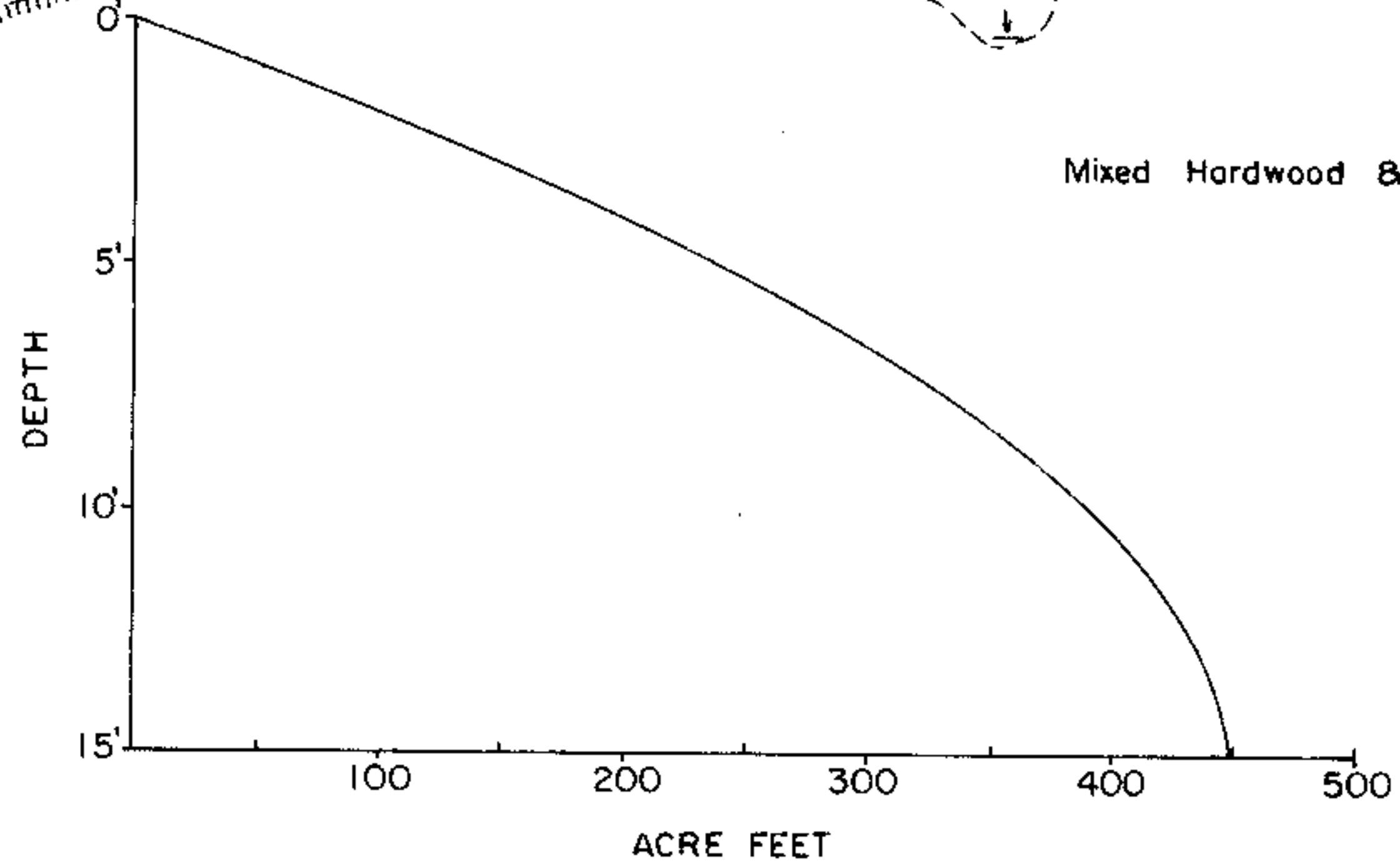


EQUIPMENT RECORDING SONAR MAPPED
