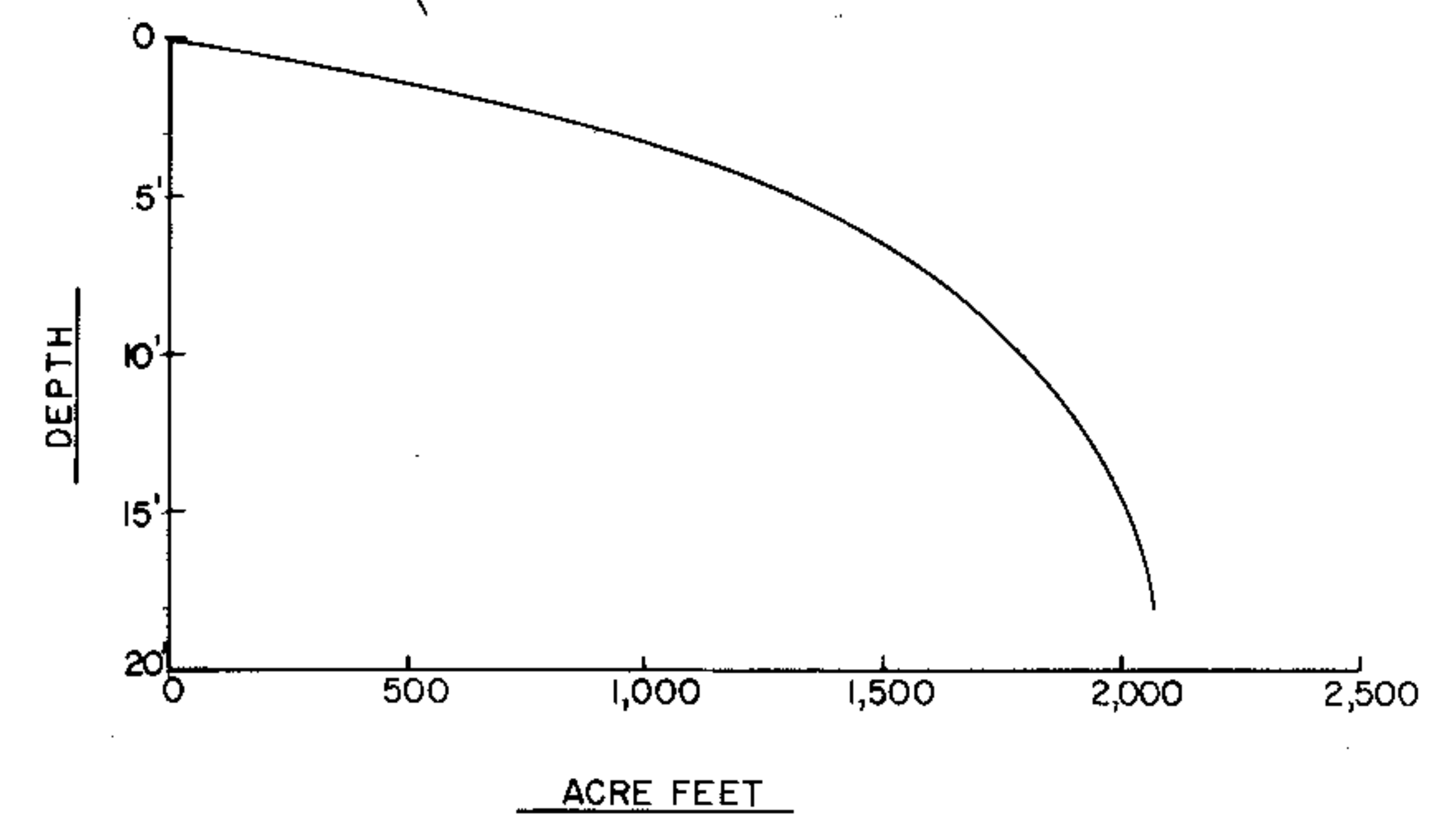


B.M. Square cut into northwest corner of top of dam.

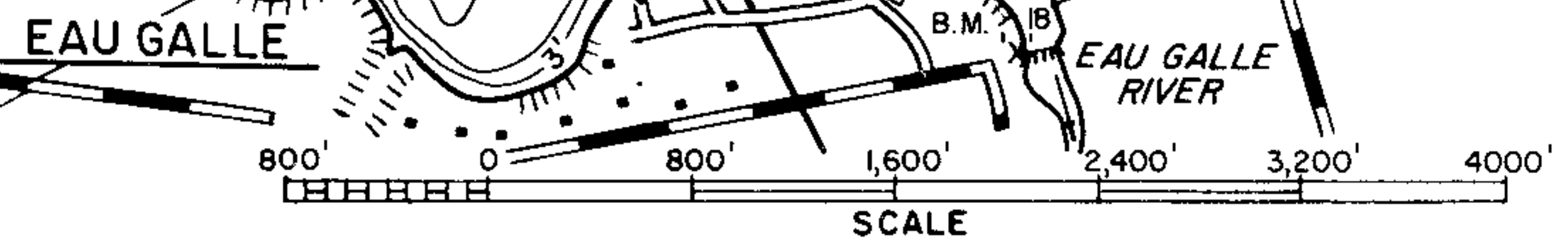


EQUIPMENT RECORDING SONAR MAPPED MAY 1967
