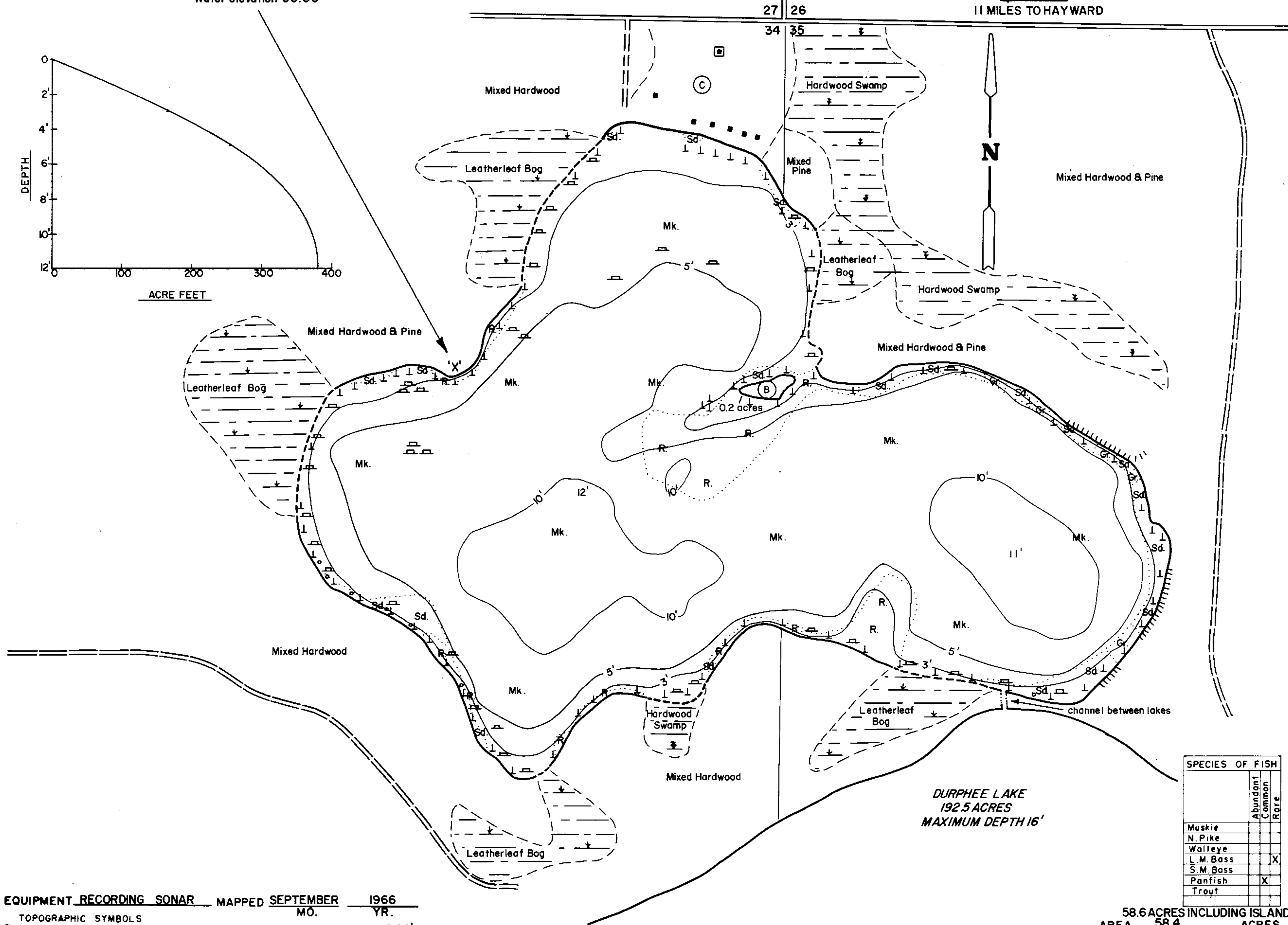
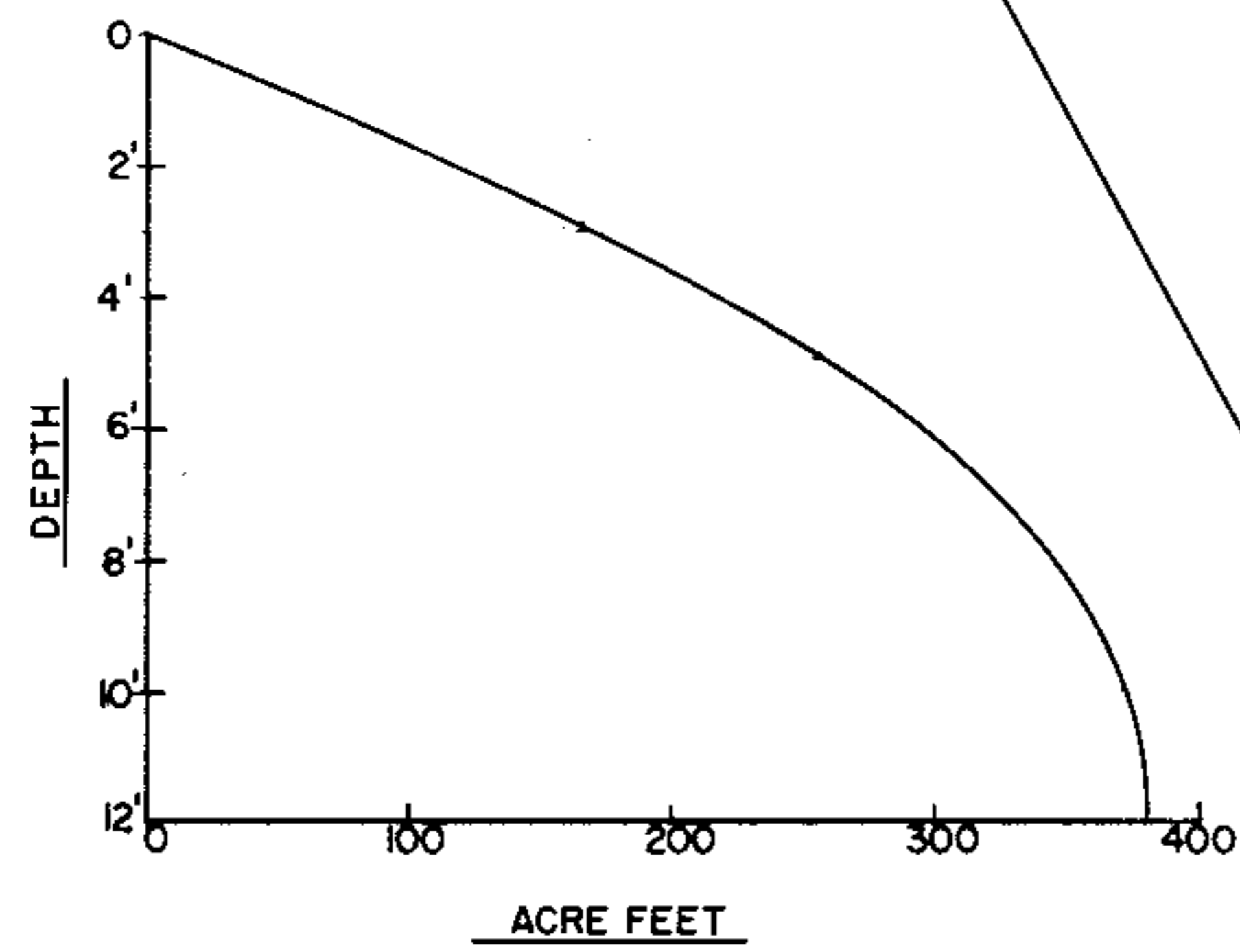


B.M. W.C.D. Spike in large white pine on point on northwest side of lake, southwest of public access.
