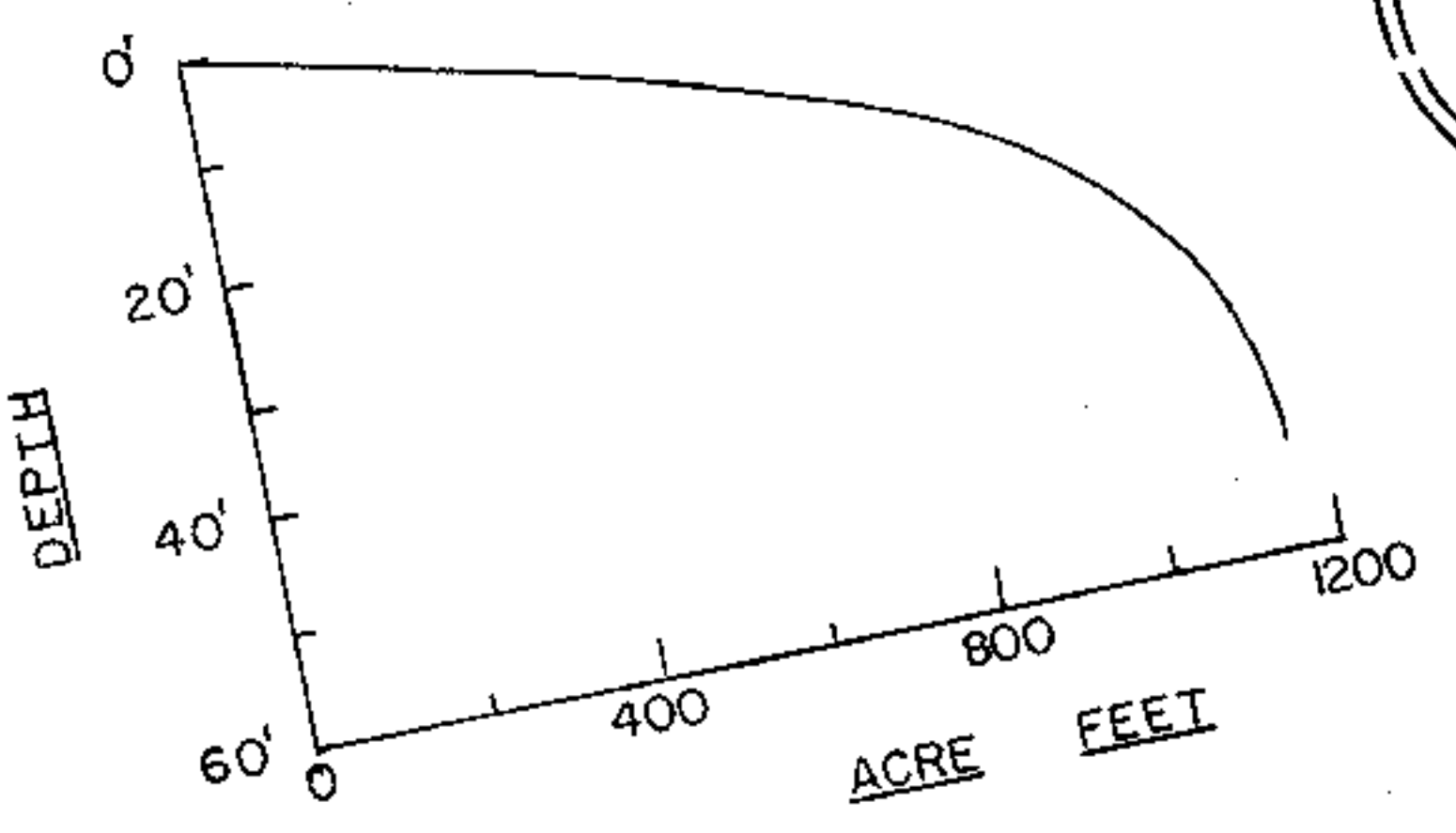


Breakfast Lake

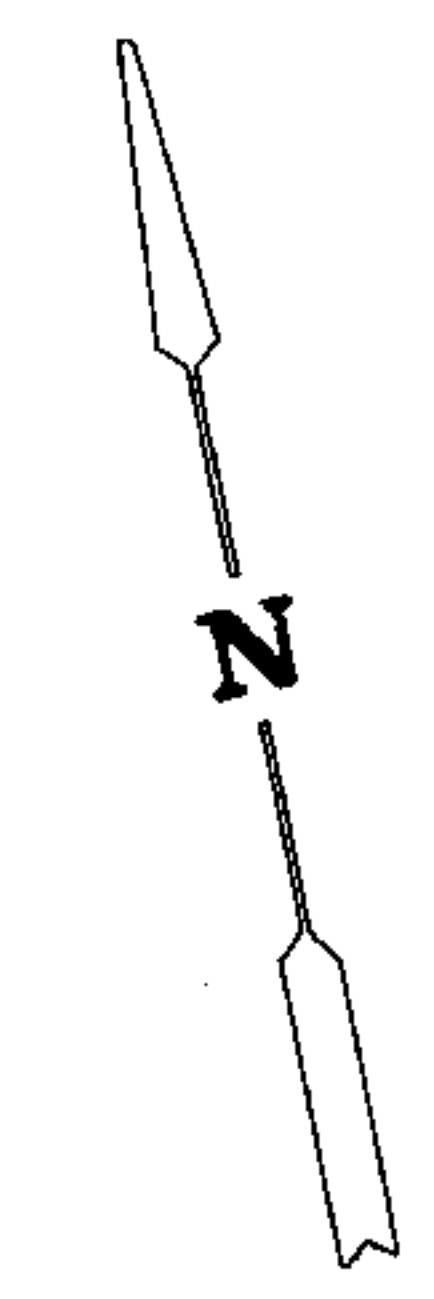
