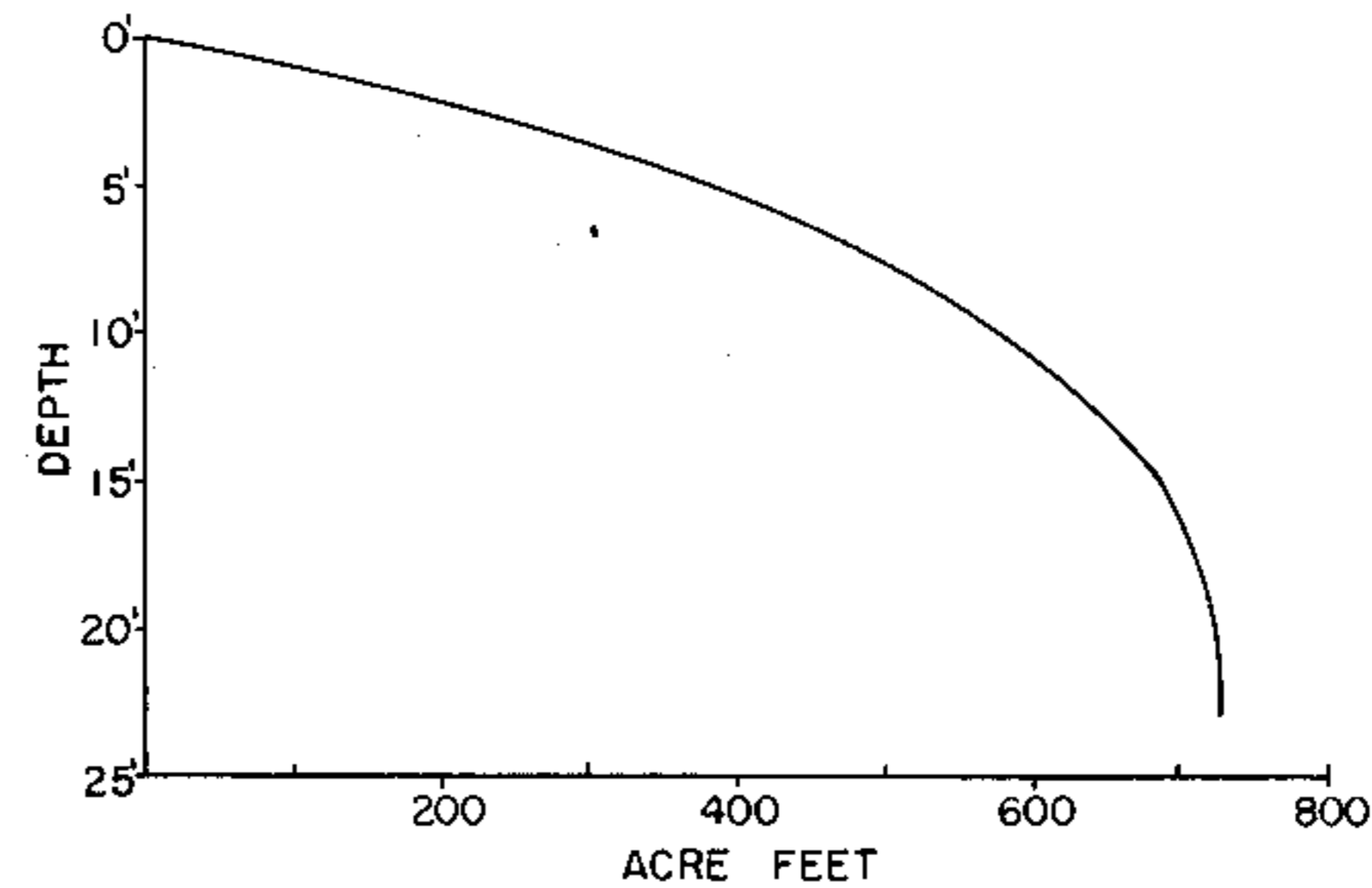

Water level 96.40'

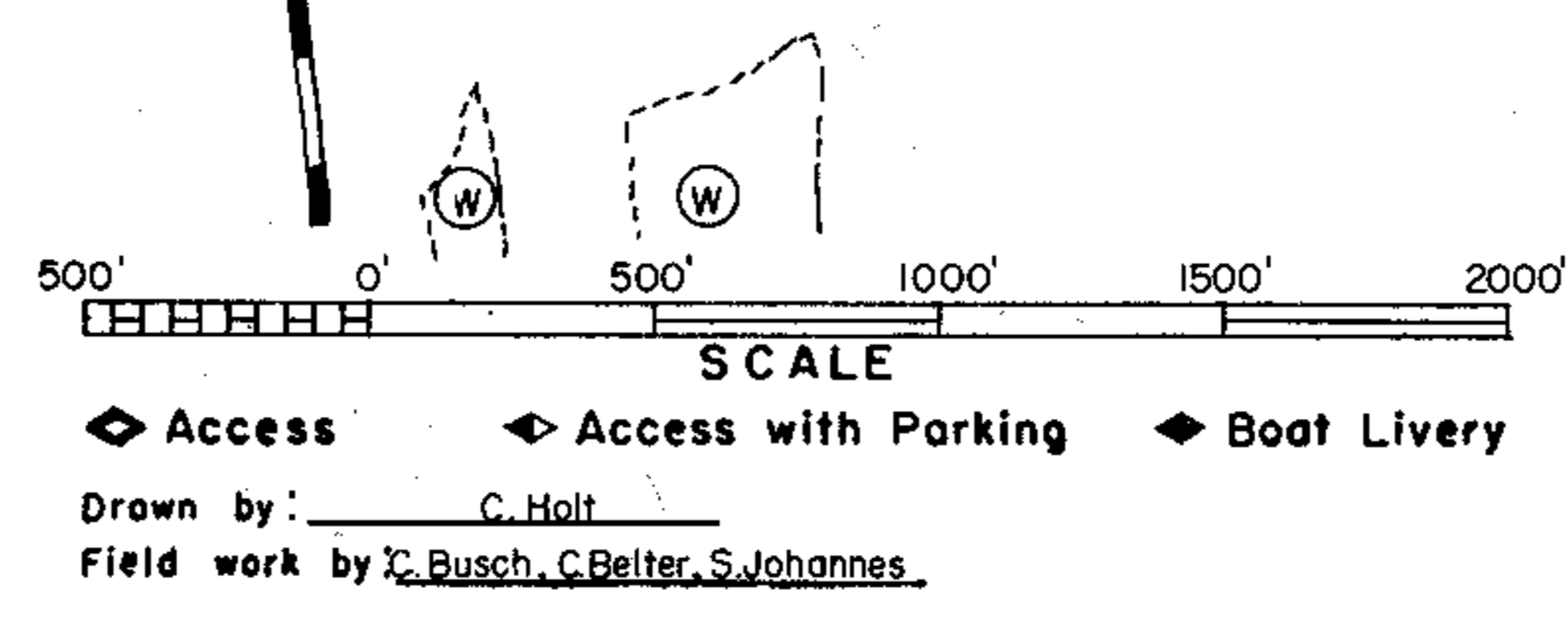
Tainter gate with droplogs. 24' head
