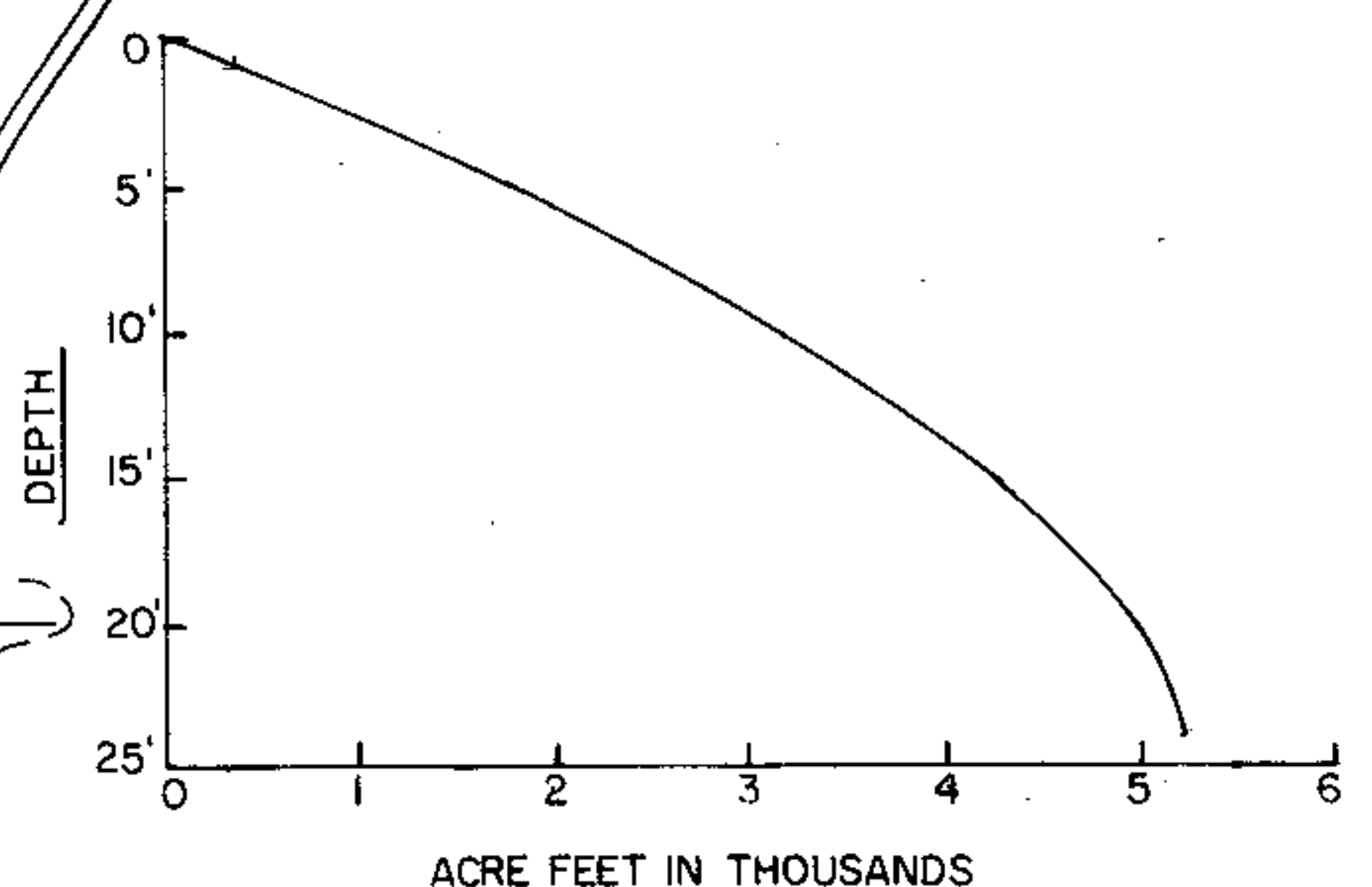


P.S.C. B.M. 'X' spike in 12" pine 165' north of culvert 20' from edge of lake.

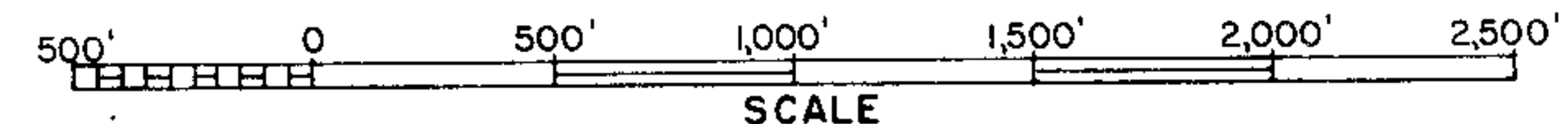
