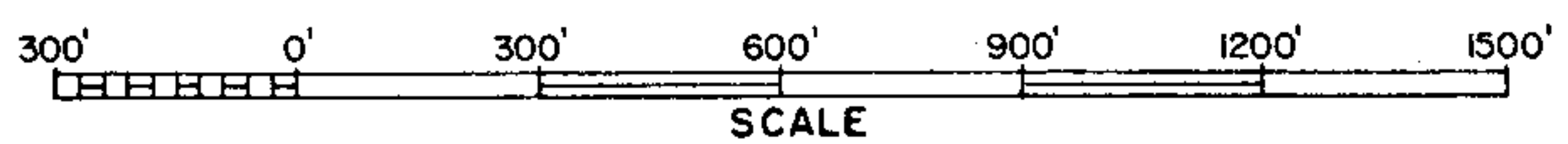


B.M. 'X' Located on Lower Kimball Lake

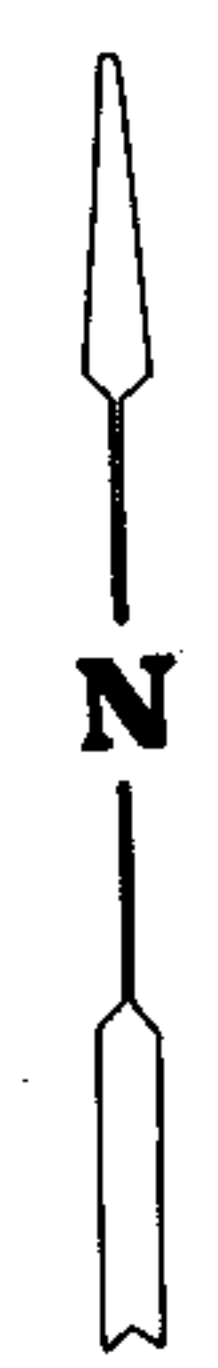
