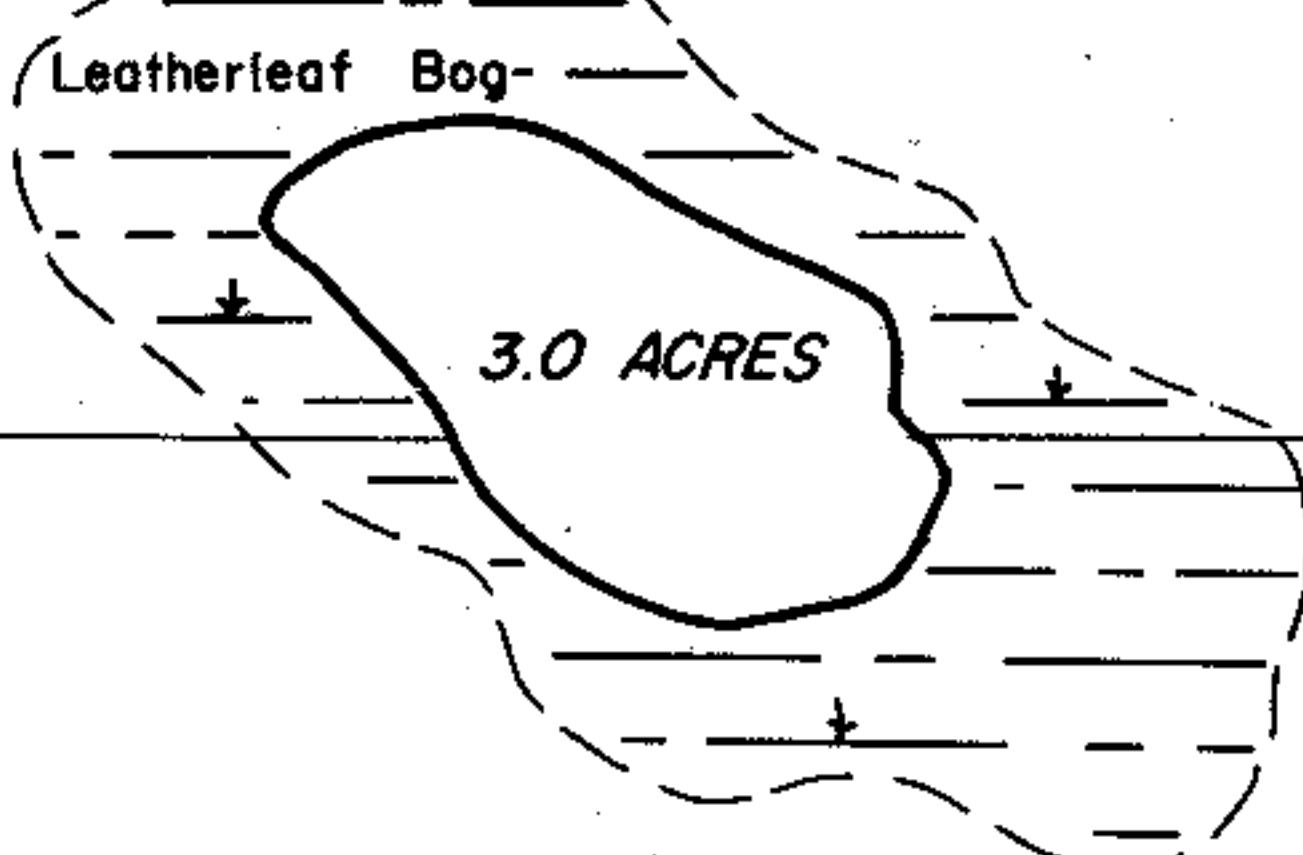


B.M. 'X' Spike in oak tree 90' east of point.
