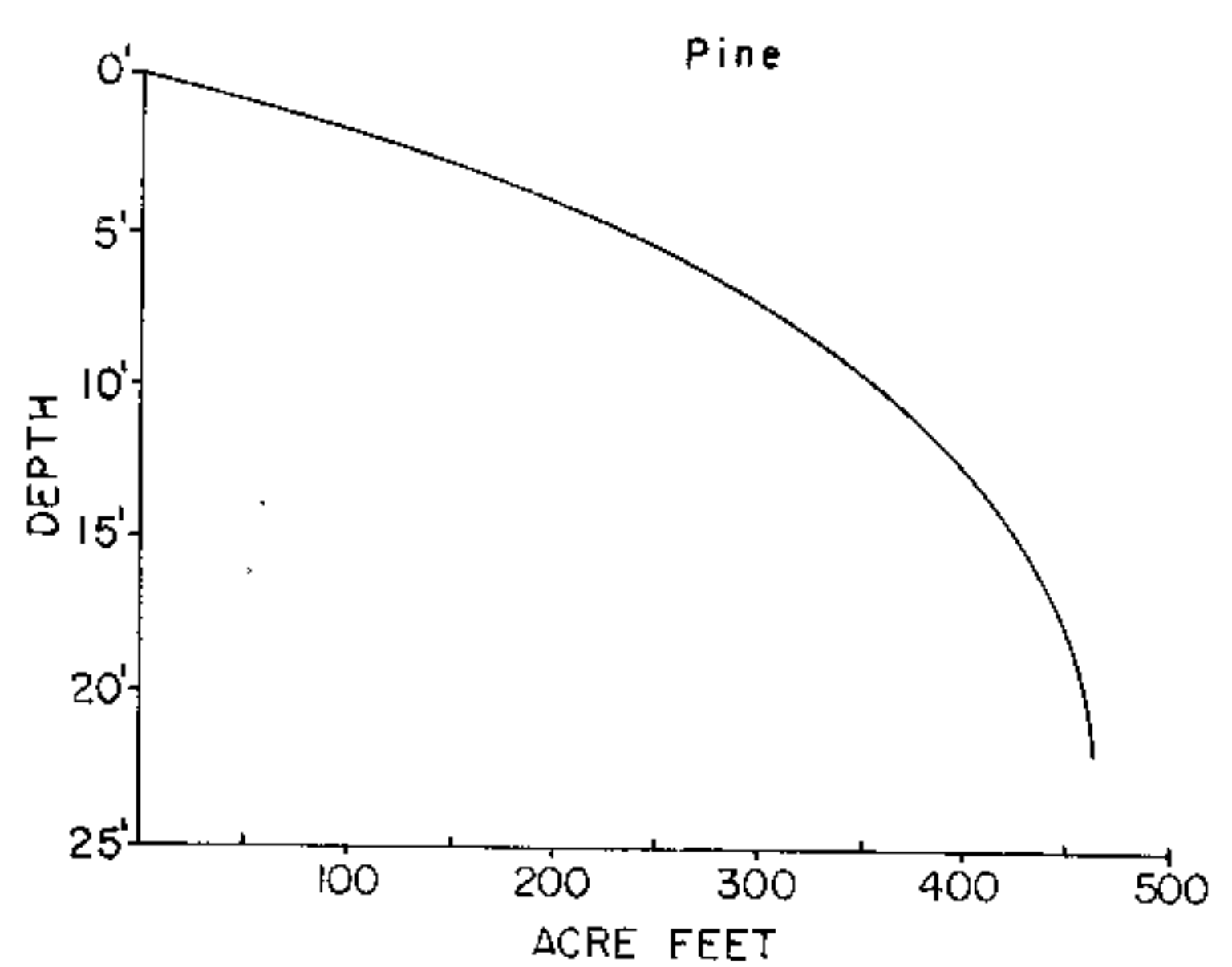
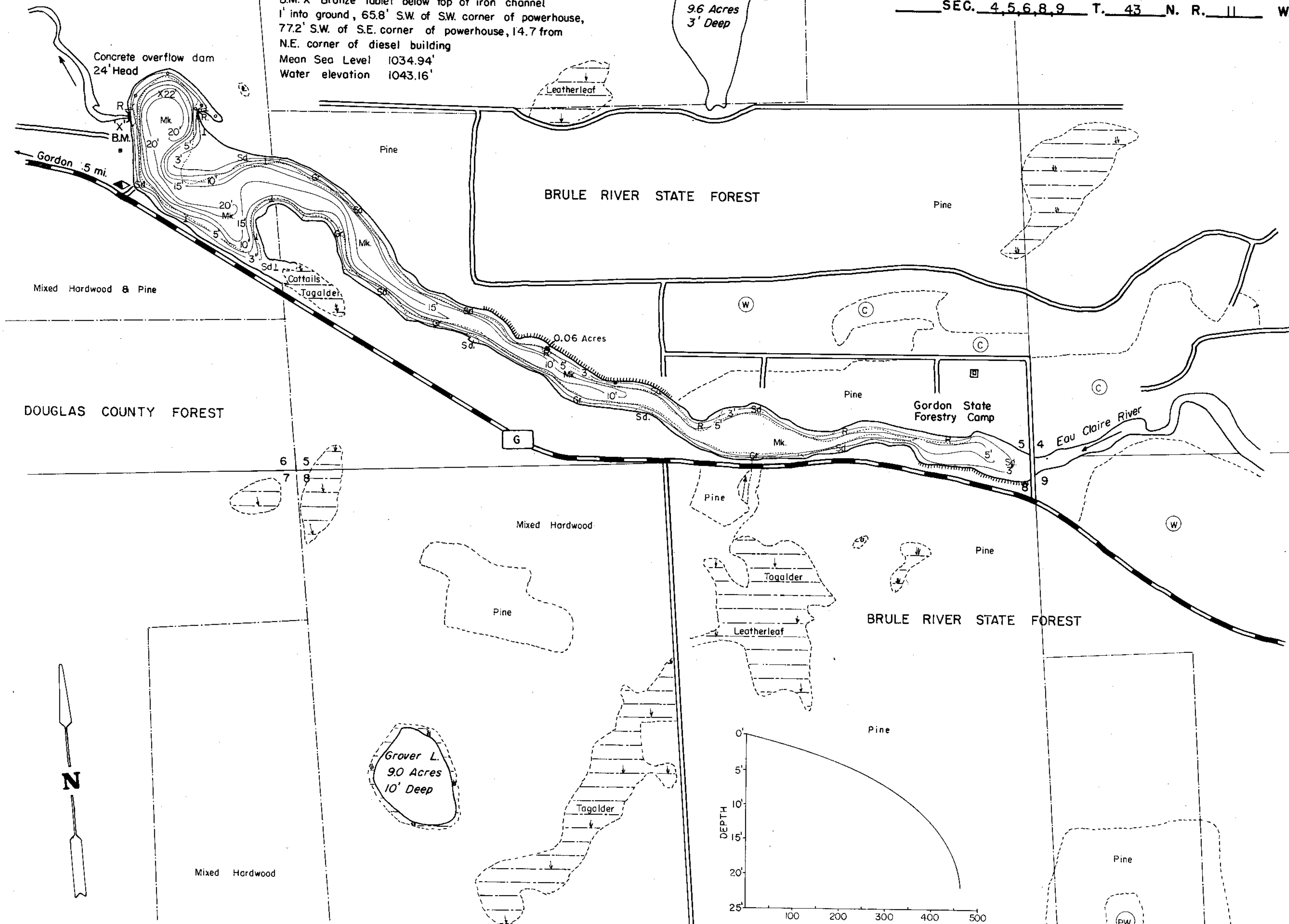


B.M. 'X' Bronze tablet below top of iron channel
