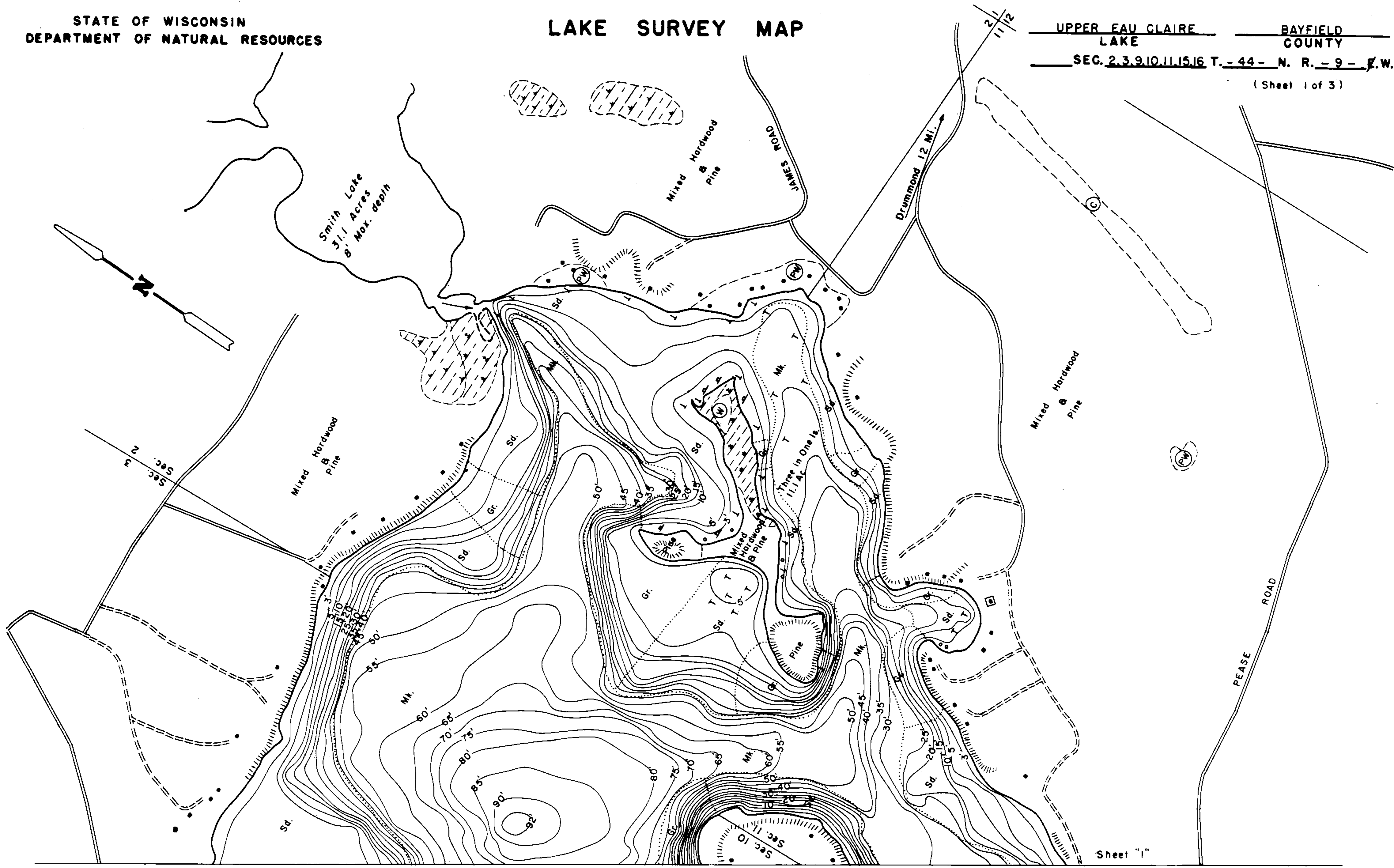


LAKE SURVEY MAP

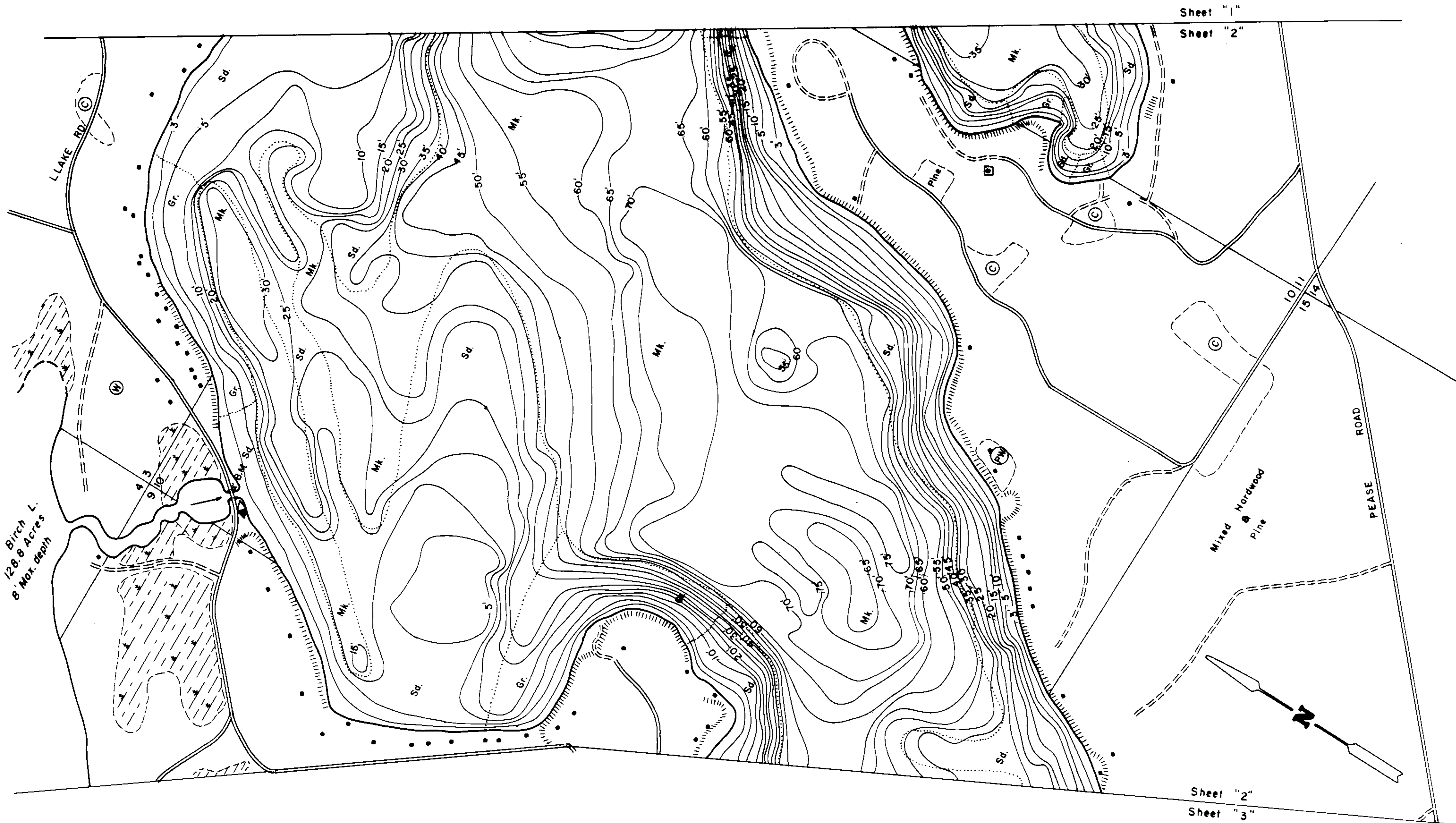

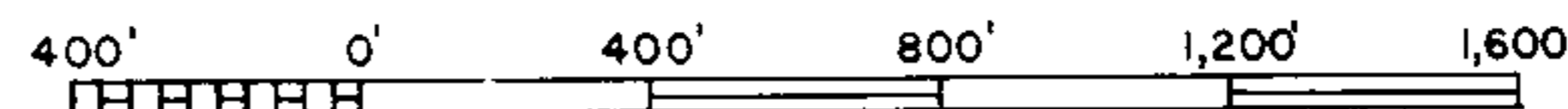
