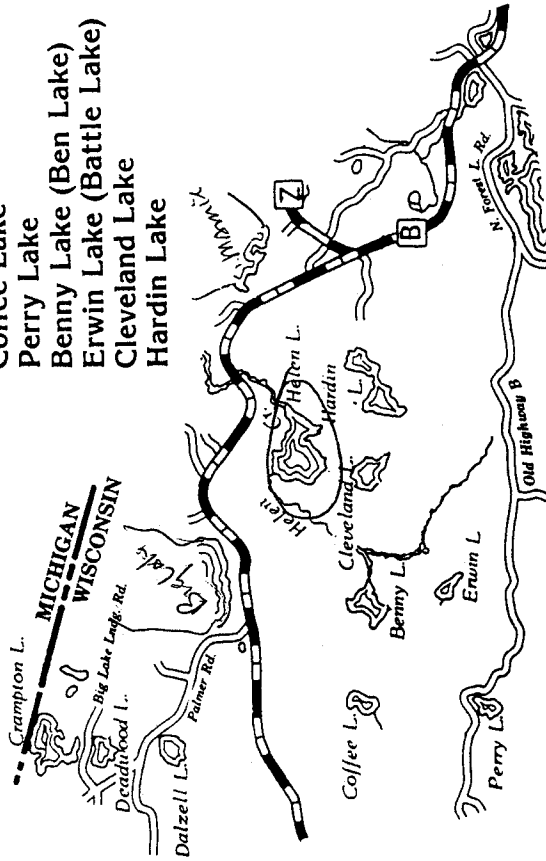

HELEN LAKE

LOCATION — In the central portion of the book area, south of Highway B and Mammie Lake.

ACCESS — Type V: On the east side of the lake via Helen Creek; adjacent to Highway B. Take Highway B west of Land O' Lakes 1.5 miles past the Highway Z junction to the roadside facility. There is an unimproved gravel ramp and landing, and roadside parking for 3 rigs. Consider that the creek is navigable only for small boats. Use of electric motors or oars is advisable in the creek.

SPECIAL FEATURES — The islands are privately-owned.

LAKE CHARACTERISTICS

- Size and Depth** - 111 acres and 19 feet.
- Water Source** - Drainage lake: An inlet (Helen Creek) enters on the west side and exits on the northeast shore.
- Shoreline** - Mostly upland with wetland dominating the east side. Entirely undeveloped.
- Bottom** - sand, with gravel, rock, and minor areas of muck.
- Water** - fertile and murky.
- Vegetation** - Emergent submergent and floating types are present.
