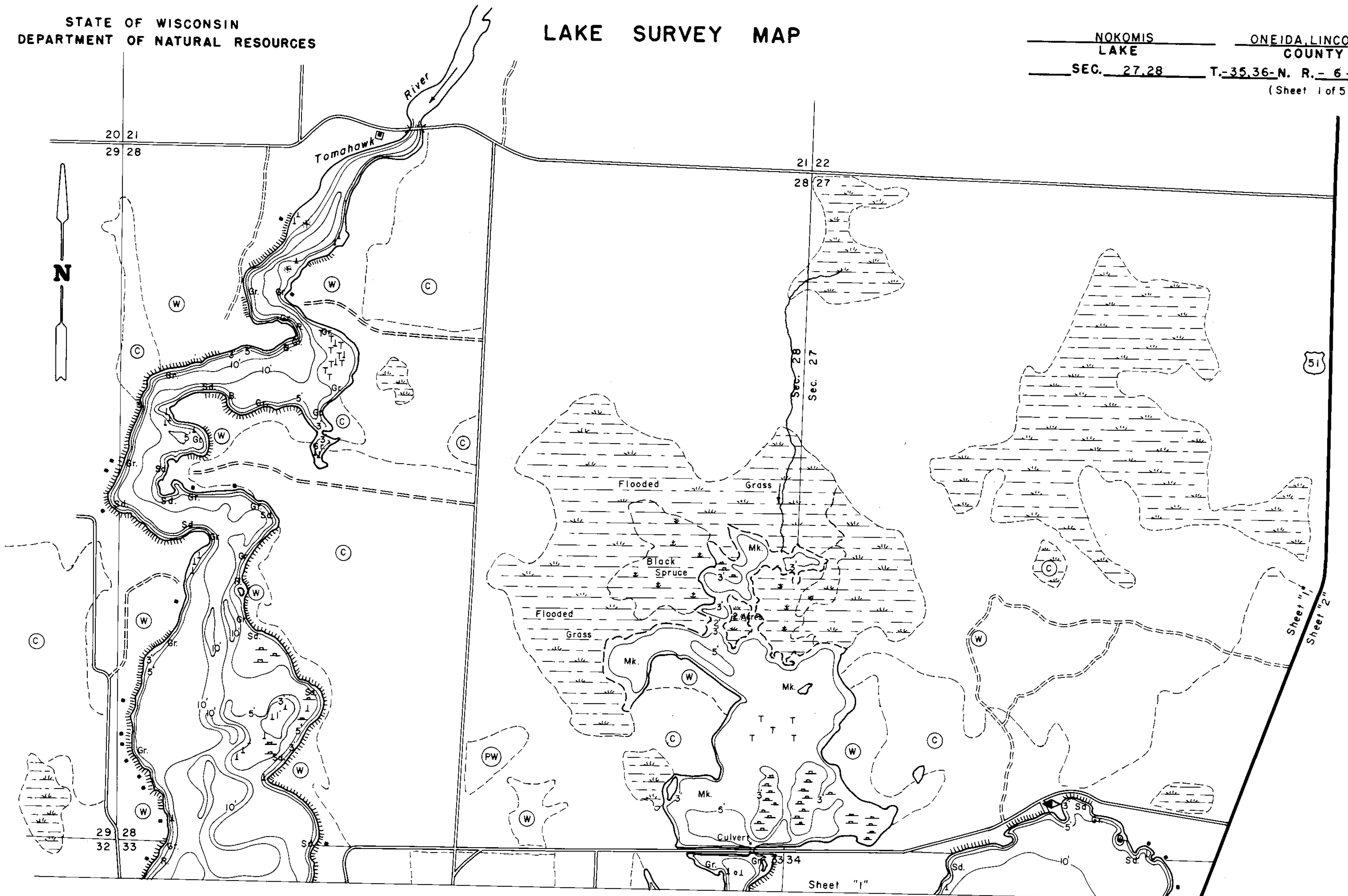


LAKE SURVEY MAP

SEC. 27.28 T. 35.36-N. R. 6-E. (Sheet 1 of 5)



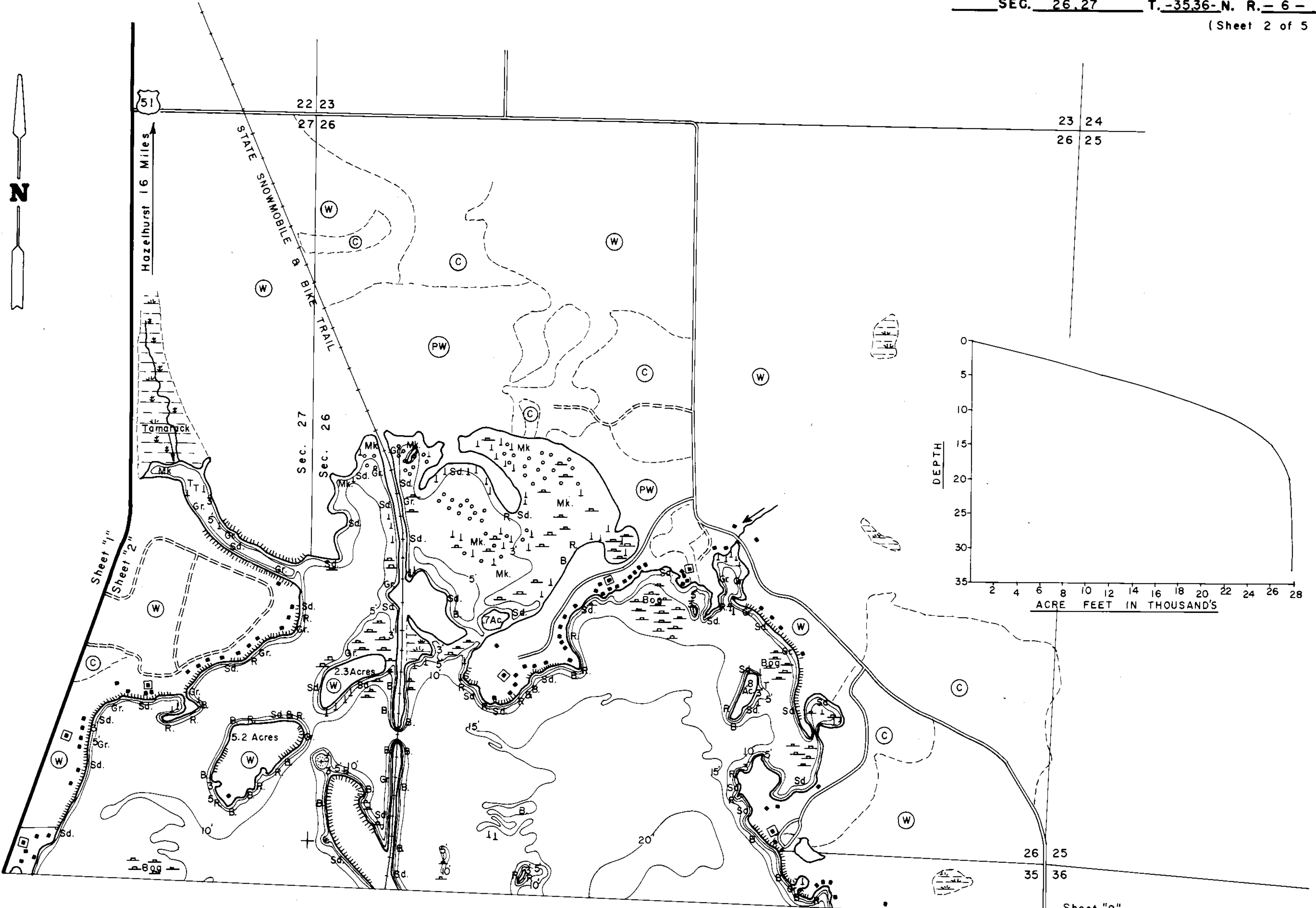

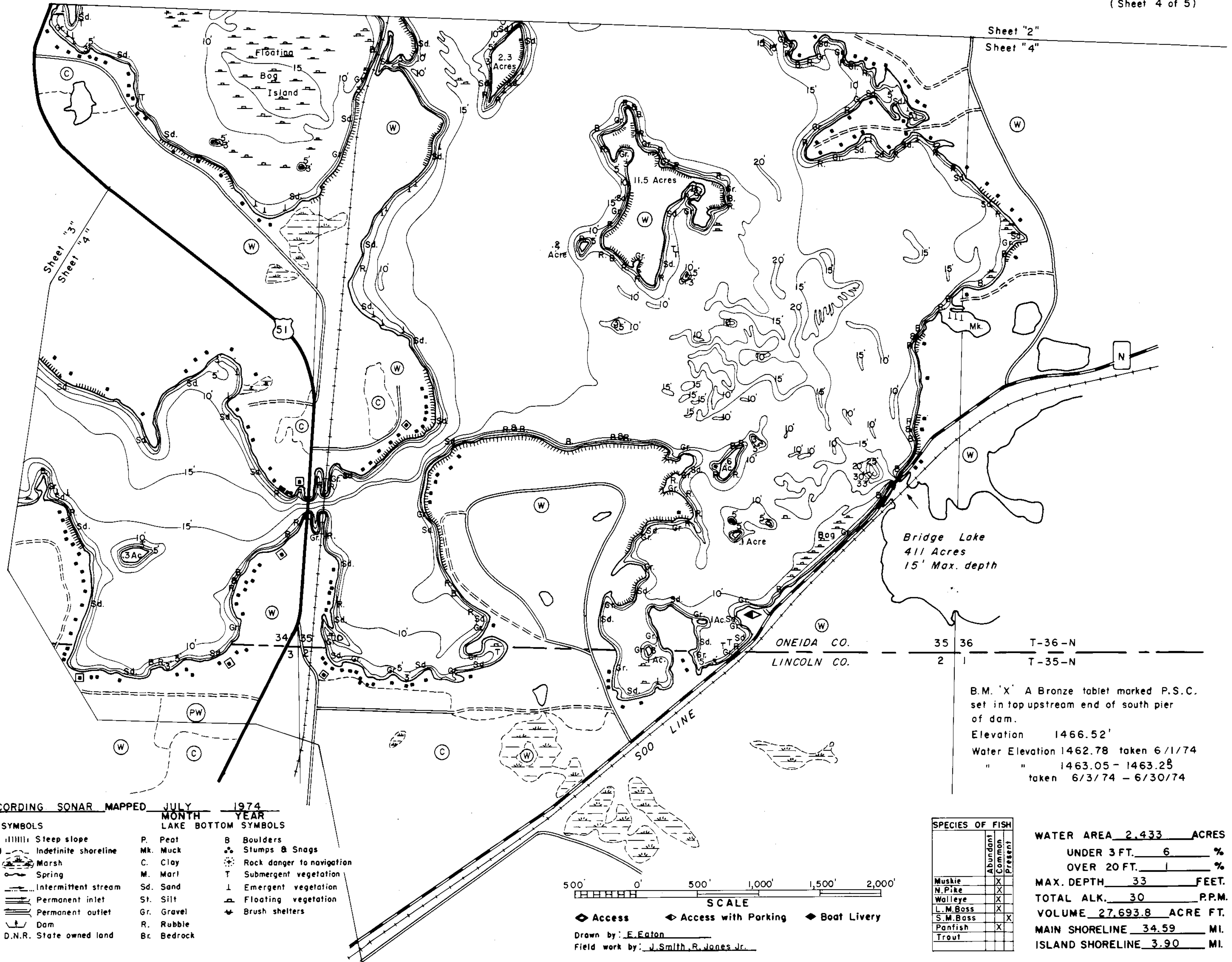
