Development nursery stock from the DNR, Wilson State Nursery is available for planting on county forests and is available now for ordering. Please remember the following when placing your order.

1. Place orders before **March 15, 2020**.
2. Submit orders using the attached order form. **If you do not receive confirmation of your order within 10 days, please contact Carey** at 715-424-3700.

3. An inventory of available stock is attached.
4. All development nursery stock is sold on a *first come, first served basis*.
5. Development nursery stock pricing for spring 2020 can be found on the list of available stock below. Prices vary depending on age; county forests are invoiced at 50% of the cost which reflects all costs, direct and indirect, associated with producing the stock.
6. Pick up - Development nursery stock can be picked up in the spring at the Wilson State Nursery in Boscobel where it is produced.
 - a. You will need to coordinate with the nursery to schedule a date, generally April and early May. In special cases, it can be picked up in the fall.
 - b. Please remember to transport your trees in an enclosed vehicle to prevent damage and ensure survival.
7. Delivery - Shipping is available during the regular spring distribution season, generally April and May, at a cost of \$0.50 per stem.
 - a. Stock can be shipped via county truck to the Griffith Nursery in Wisconsin Rapids or Hayward Nursery in Hayward. Cooler storage is available.
 - b. Stock can be shipped via a county truck to a central point in each county with the seedling shipments, usually to the DNR forester's office. This schedule is usually determined in mid-March. Please contact Carey at Griffith Nursery to receive a shipment schedule for each county.
