**Project Description Summary**

Florence County would like to raise a section of ATV/UTV trail that experiences a great deal of flooding. This trail section sees a great deal of traffic during the summer months. Over the course of the last 8-10 years this trail has been slowly getting lowered through the process of grooming maintenance and high usage. We have estimated this area to have approximately 2100' of trail that is affected. The rehabbed area will require a 10" lift consisting of 6" of crushed ore and 4' of compacted gravel. The installation of rip rap lined ditches will help move water away from the trail sections to lower common ground consisting of VsC, SnB, and SnC type soils.



Over the course of the last 8-10 years this trail has been slowly getting lowered through the process of grooming maintenance and high usage. We have estimated this area to have approximately 1725' of trail that is affected. The rehabbed area will require a 10" lift consisting of 6" of crushed ore and 4' of compacted gravel. The installation of rip rap lined ditches will help move water away from the trail sections to lower common ground consisting of VsC, SnB, and SnC type soils.

Work area will start on the east end of trail at 45.887161,-88.272413 and head west for approximately 1200' to end/start point 45.88842,-88.27607. Starting at the last location and heading south for approximately 525' to end point located at 45.887312,-88.277155.

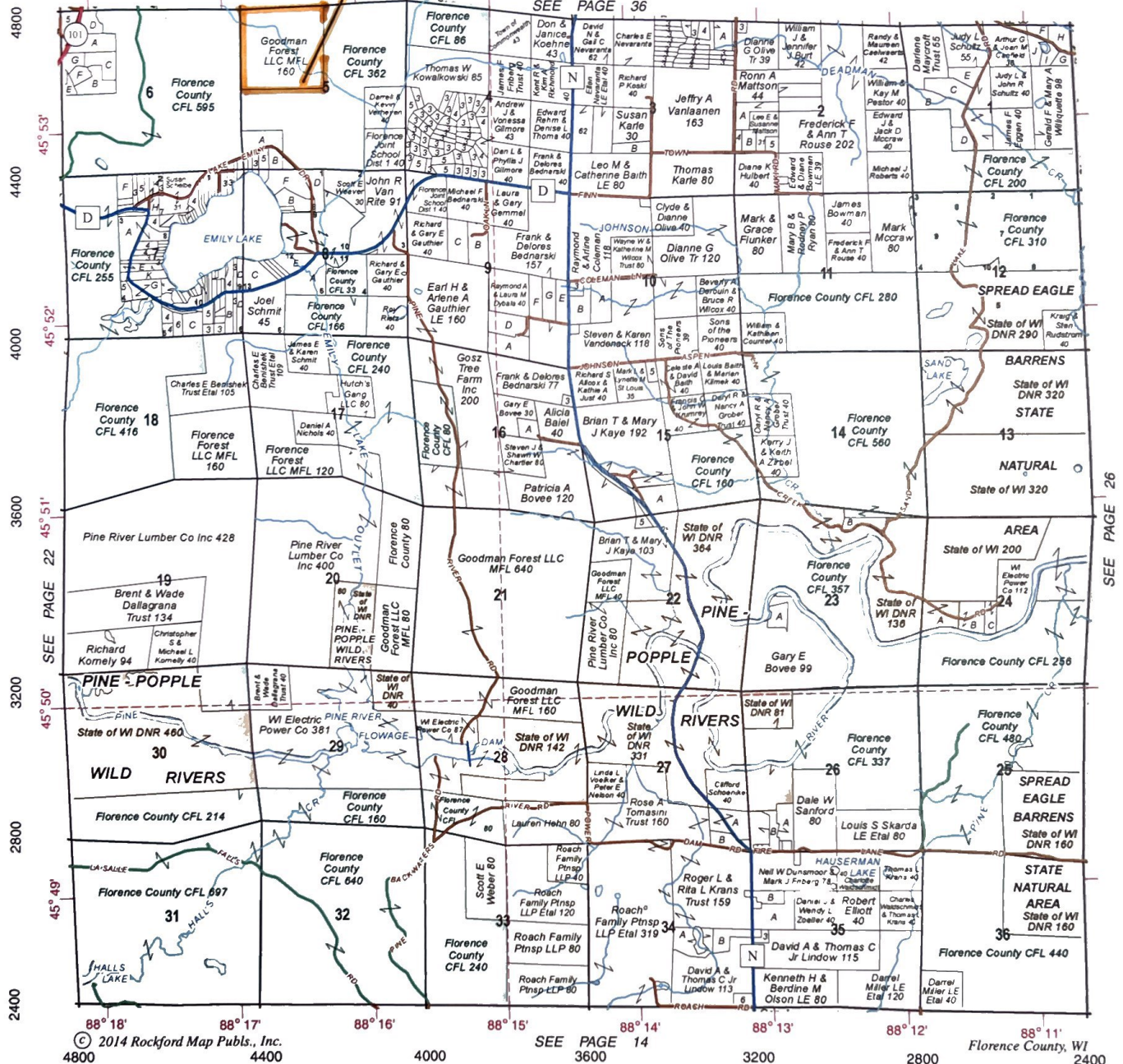

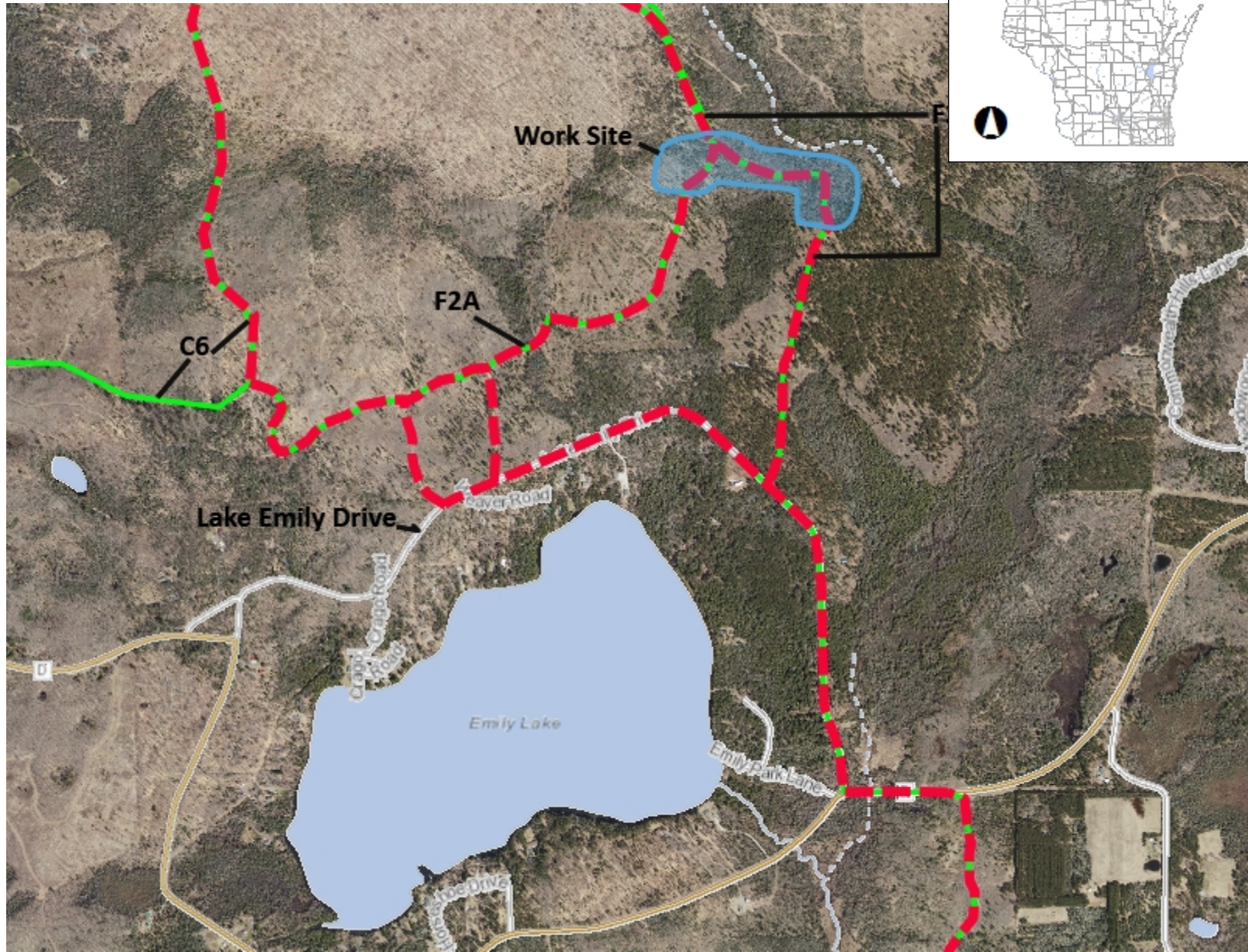

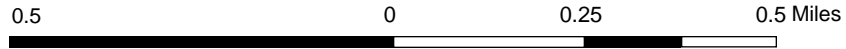


# Aerial Snowmobile and ATV/UTV Trail System 2023

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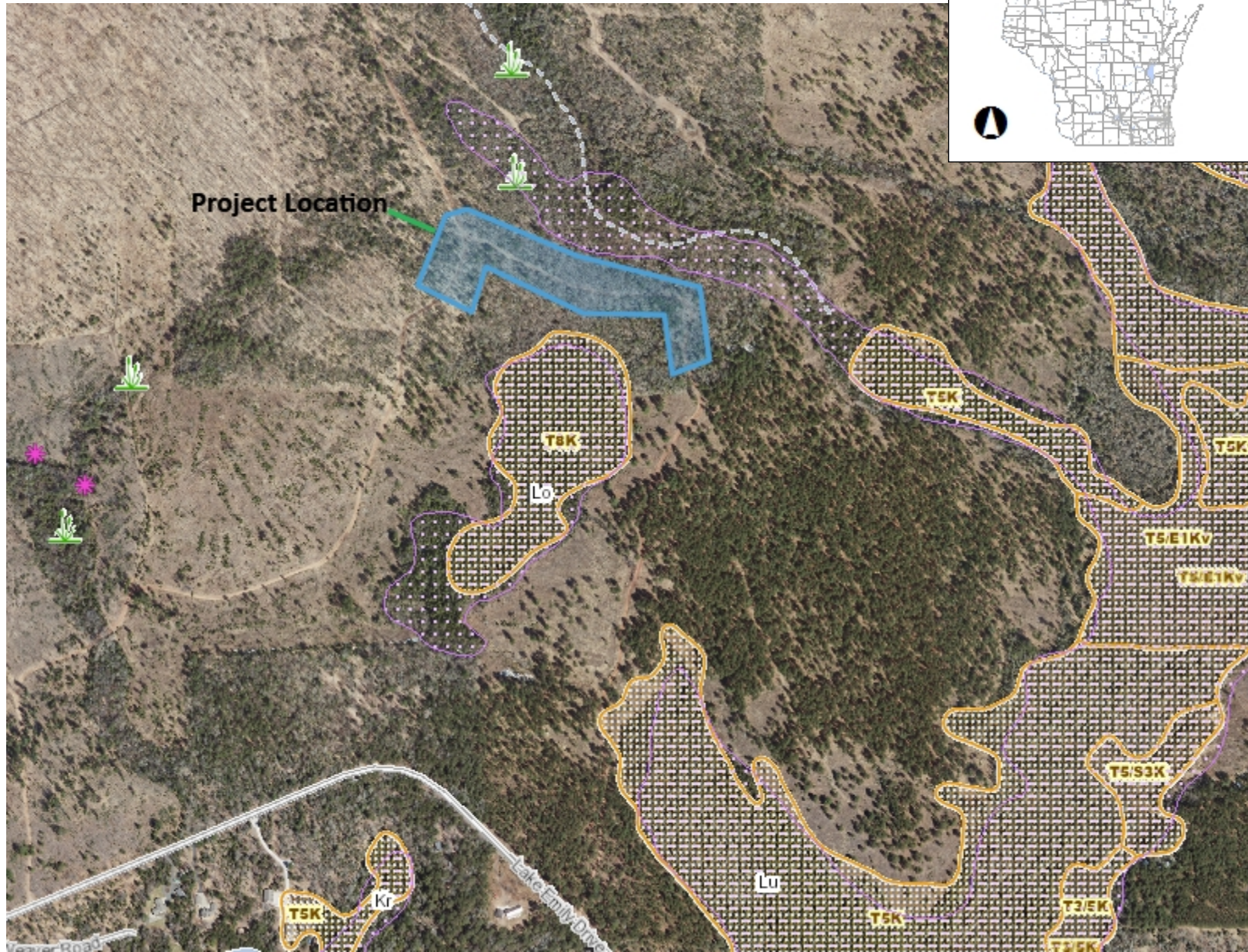
