Project Description Summary

Langlade County proposes to designate and maintain a new 3.5 mile summer ATV/UTV Trout in the Townships of Parrish and Elcho in northwestern Langlade County. Approximately 2/3 of this proposed Summer Trout is currently a designated snowmobile and winter ATV trail. The proposed Trout is located in a remote and scenic area of the County Forest. This trout would create an additional riding loop in a trail rich area that ATV/UTV riders can trailer into and ride all day with minimal repeating of trails.

Langlade County Winter ATV trails open ten days after the snowmobile trails open. They are open to ATVs only when the temperature is less than 28 degrees. UTVs are not permitted on the Langlade County Winter ATV trail system.

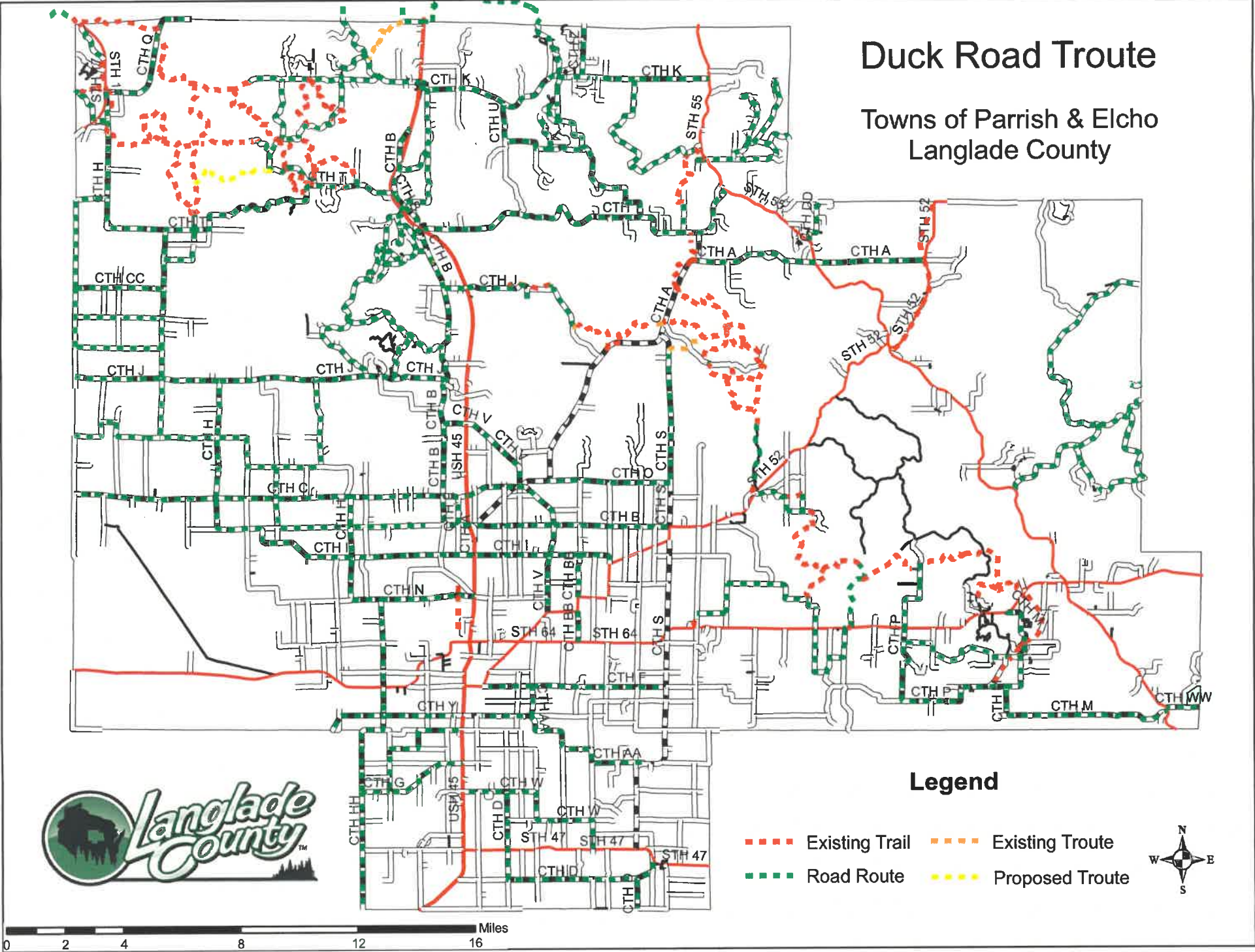

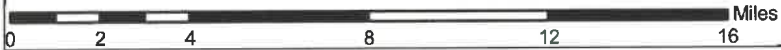
# Duck Road Troute

### Legend

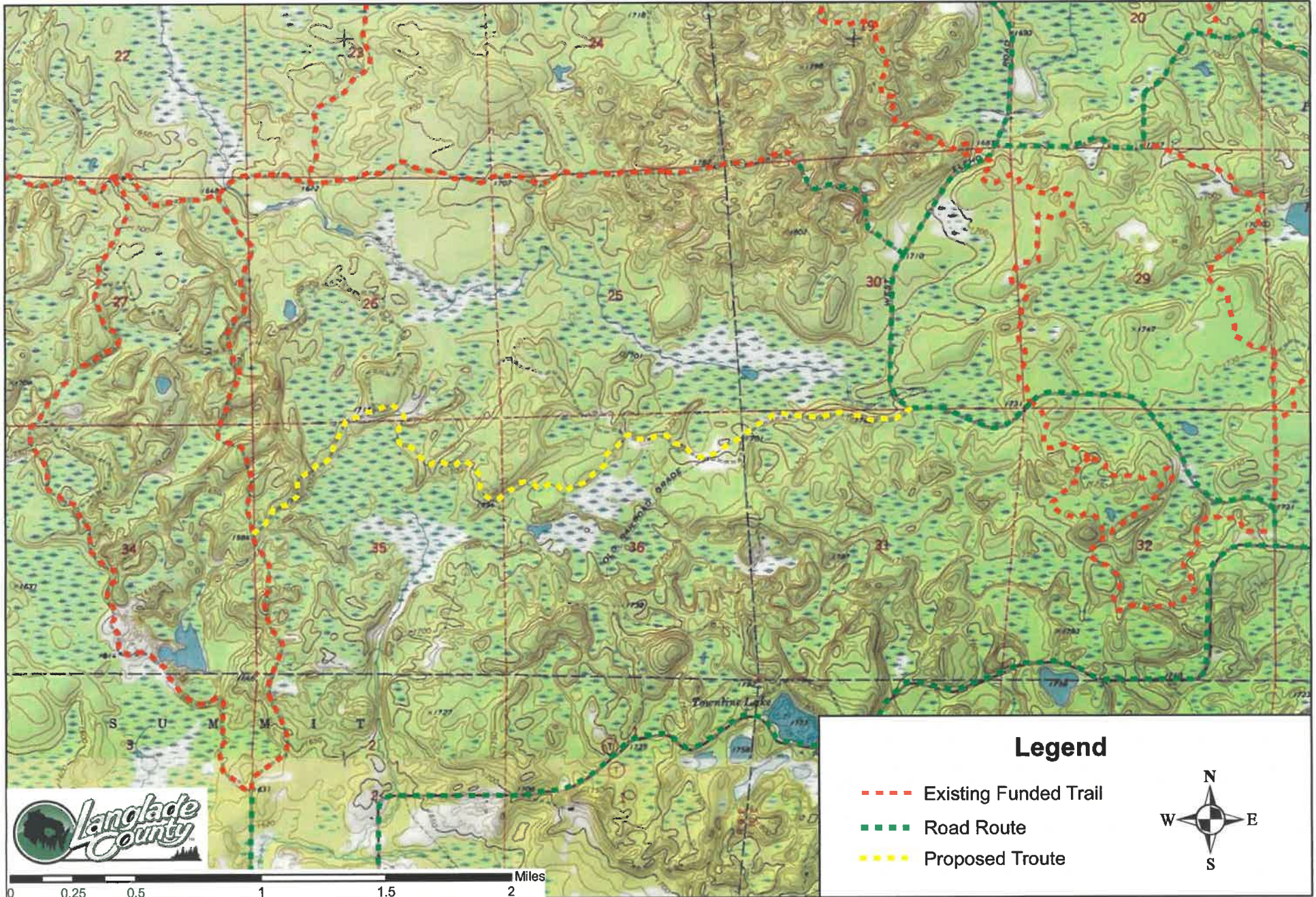
- Existing Trail
