Project Description Summary

Oconto County proposes to rehab 6 segments across 8 numbered troutes (2249B,2783,3877C,2320,2221B,2221A,2953, and 2531B) on USFS land. Rehab includes adding aggregate to fill in pot holes deeper than 4 inches and blading aggregate to blend in with existing surface prism. Rehab existing drainage structures and ditching. May include tree removal as well. These are open to ATV/UTV Summer only.

Total Cost estimate is \$123,838 but Trout Rehab is only eligible for 50% funding, so the request is \$61,919.

Oconto County hopes to obtain the other 50% from RTP.

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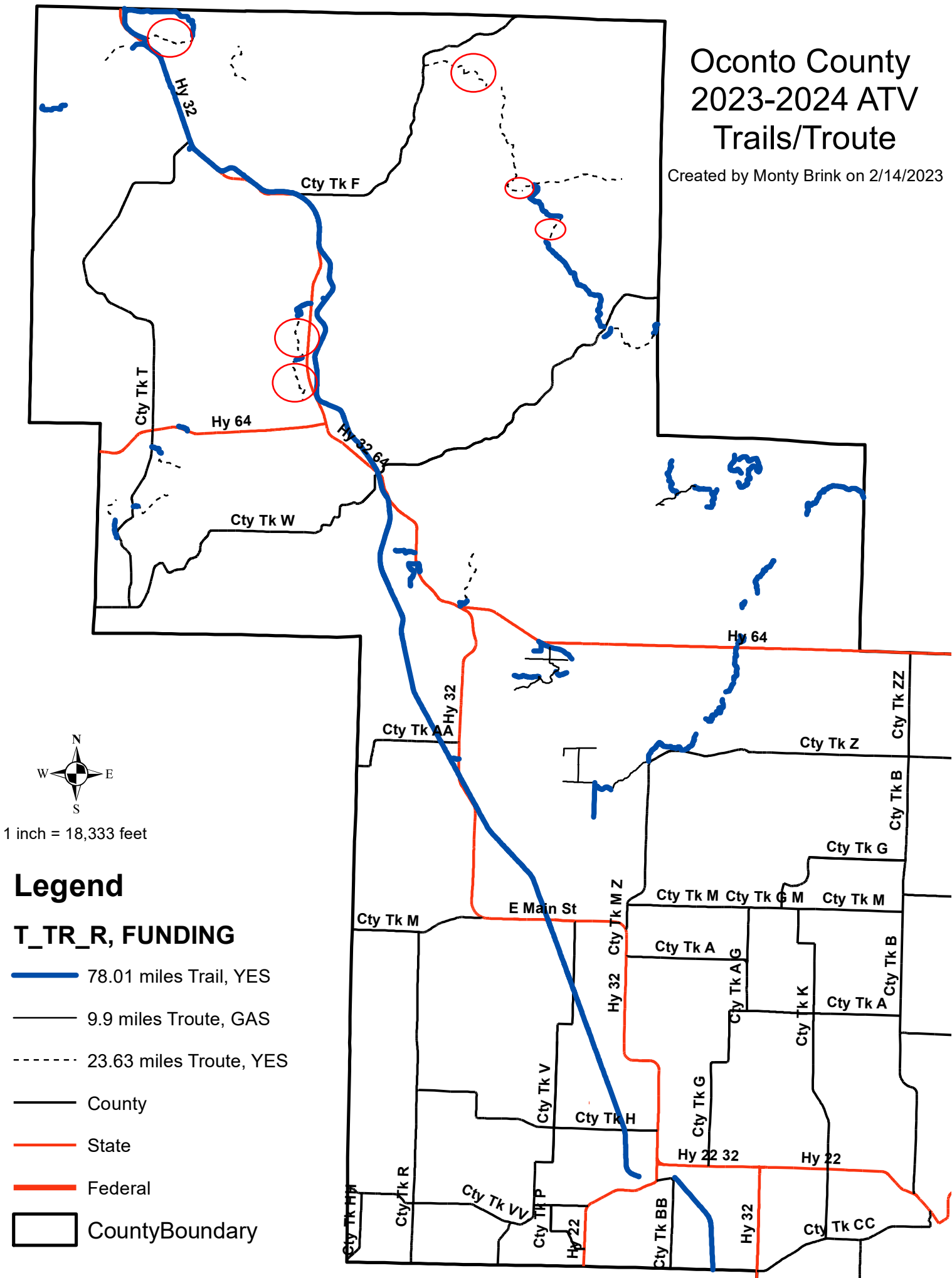

Trail Project Detailed Description

Rehab Summer ATV/UTV Trout segments to fill in pot holes, cover large boulders, remove bank corners, improve travel for safety, and keep riders on trail area instead of going off trail to avoid hazard areas. Utilization of pit run to create a base in larger pot holes and cap with 3-4 inches of 1 1/4 inch gravel. This will create a groomable surface tread for the club to maintain. Currently the large boulders and pot hole make it challenging to groom these sections. Having a gravel surface will provide for safer travel by ATV/UTVs by removing water hazards and off trail riding.

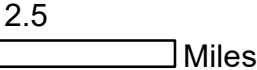

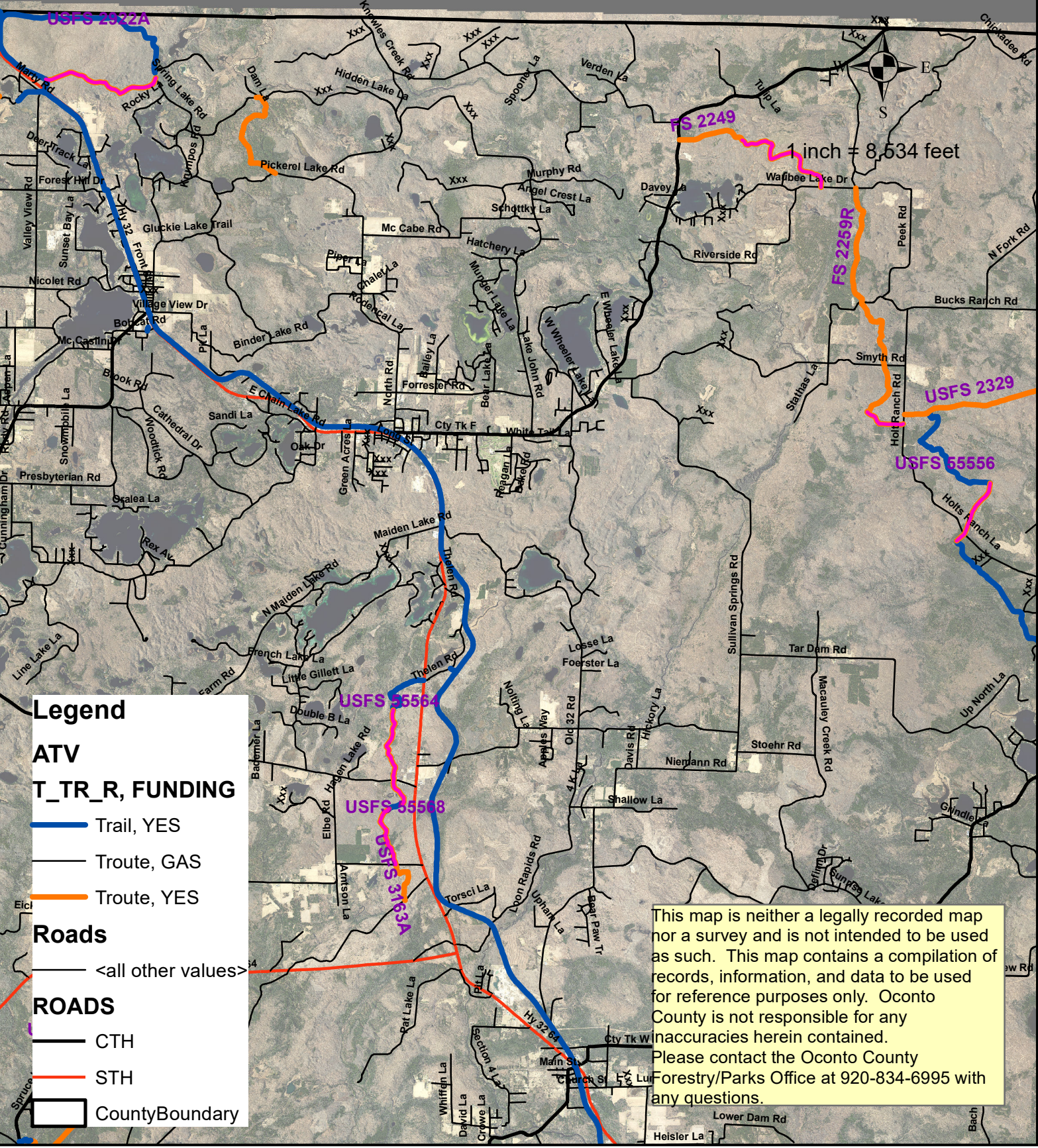
Oconto County USFS Troute Rehab 2023-2024

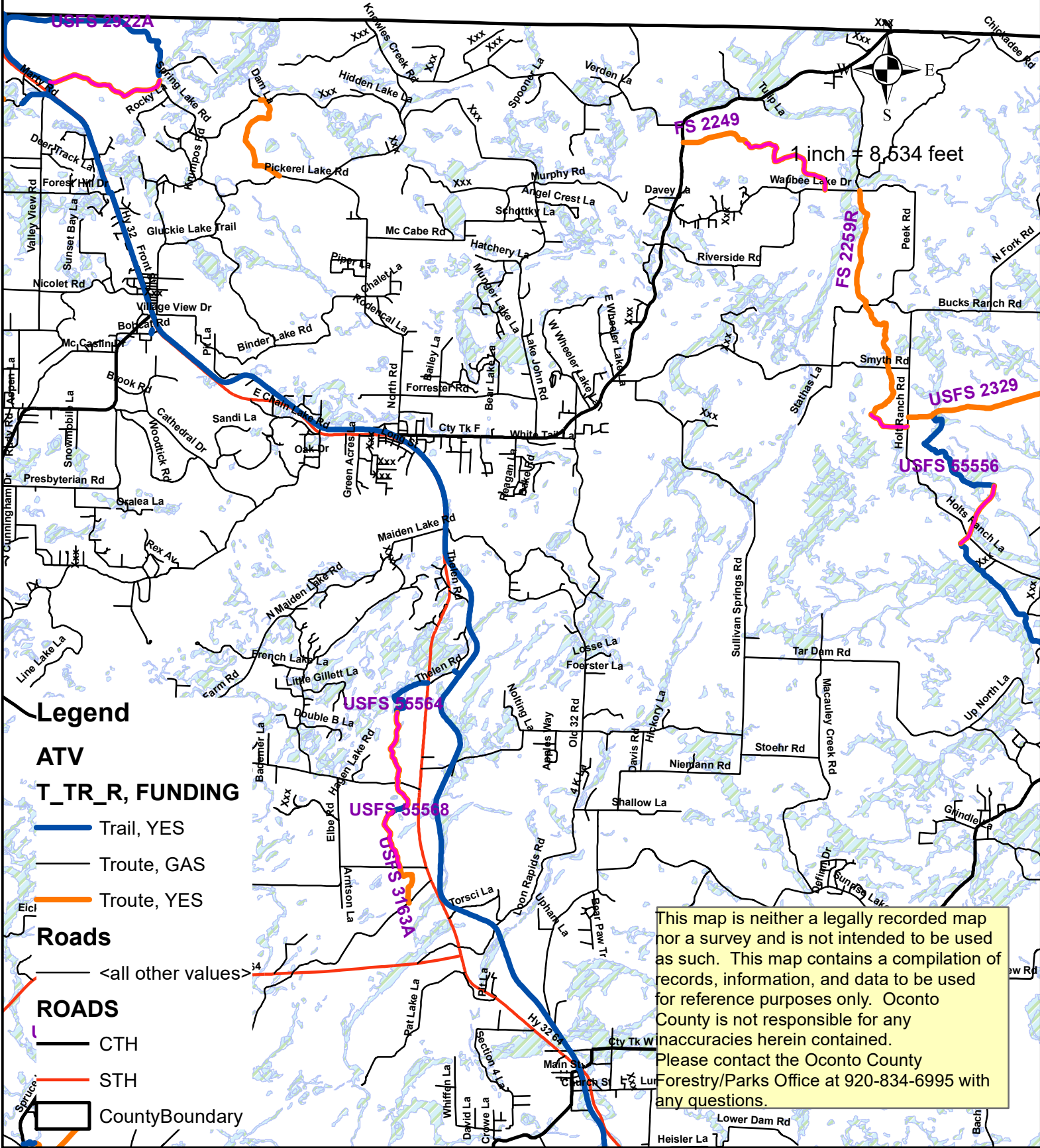
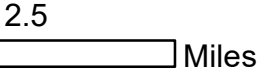


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Oconto County USFS Troute Rehab 2023-2024
