JACK LAKE NORTH TRAILHEAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Project Description

The goal of the Jack Lake North Trailhead Improvement Project is to designate this area as a multiuse trailhead with access to silent sport trails, ATV/UTV trails, and snowmobile trails. This project is designed to improve the quality and safety of the Jack Lake North Trailhead, thereby enhancing the overall user experience and increasing the economic impact of the trail system on nearby communities.

Trailheads are typically the starting point for a network of trails, where users can park their vehicles, obtain trail information, and access the trail system. Currently the Jack Lake North Trailhead is relatively undeveloped with a very large dirt parking area, silent sport trail signage, and provides user access to the Jack Lake ski trail, hiking trail, and Ice Age Trail system. But with the rising popularity of ATV/UTV and the 2018 development of the Bass Lake to Augustyn ATV/UTV connector trail (located directly to the north of the Jack Lake North Trailhead), as well as, heavy use of the snowmobile trail system which utilizes this same trail system, the Jack Lake North Trailhead has become a preferred access point for many motorized trail system users.

As the popularity of ATV/UTV's and snowmobiles increases, more people are seeking out places to ride these vehicles, which can lead to overcrowding and safety concerns at Langlade County's existing trailheads. Creating this new designated multiuse trailhead will help to alleviate these issues by providing all users additional parking and staging areas, restroom amenities, as well as access to new areas for riding. This improvement project will also help to spread out the numbers of users across a larger area, reducing overcrowding and minimizing the risk of accidents or conflicts between riders.

The proposed Jack Lake North Trailhead Improvement Project scope will consist of the following improvements to the trailhead:

- Improving and expand the parking lot area to accommodate heavier year-round use by adding approximately 4" of road gravel to the surface;
- Gravel the primary access point onto the trail and place boulders to limit access to ATVs/UTVs only;
- Install a prefab vault toilet with safety lighting and ADA accessible paths;
- Install gate to restrict traffic to appropriate trails;
- Install a Kiosk and associated signage for ATV, Snowmobile and Ski Trails.

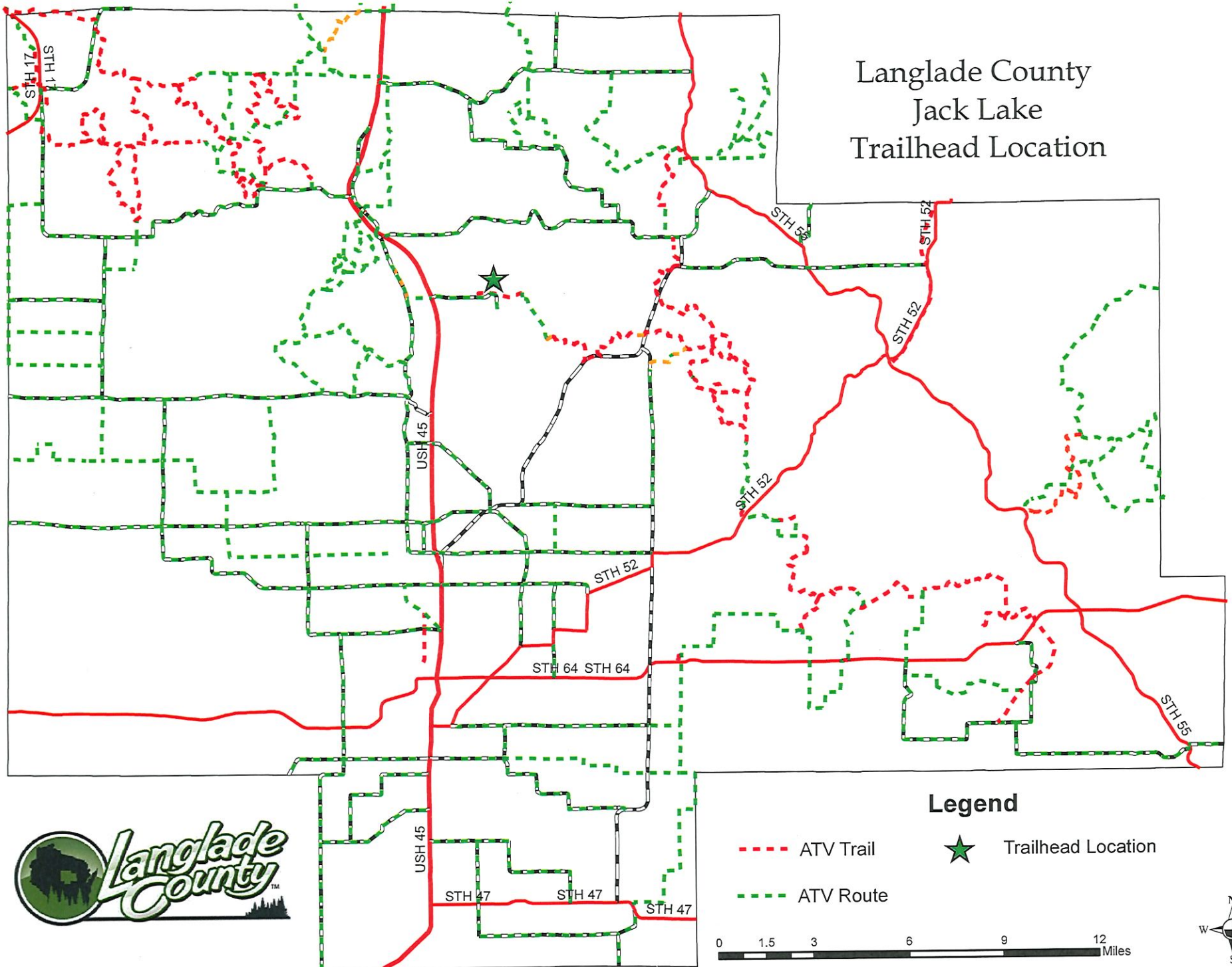
This project will be split between RTP (50%), ATV (25%) and Snowmobile (25%) with a total project cost of \$62,591.25.

Per Langlade County, currently Veterans Memorial Park allows access and parking for ATVs/UTVs by campers and park users in designated areas. This trailhead will help prevent additional congestion in the park from trail users and the trailhead location provides direct access onto the trail.

This proposed trailhead is located between the county's two busiest trailheads (Augustyn and CTH T) which are about 13-16 miles apart. These two trailheads normally fill up at high traffic times and have vehicles parked along the roads. With this proposed trailhead being located about halfway between the Augustyn and CTH T trailheads it would be able to reduce some of the demand on the other two.

Conflicts between Skiers and ATV/UTV users is not expected as primary ATV/UTV use is expected to be in this summer and the summer trail system closing for the season on December 1.
