Project Description Summary

The Rice Lake Snow and Dirt Club along with Barron County proposes to build a 18' grain bin style pavilion on the Bear Lake County Forest ATV trail. There will be (3) 46" steel round picnic tables with rubberized coating placed in the pavilion. The proposed cost estimate includes a stamped concrete floor. Barron County continually receives requests from trail users for facilities such as this for a place to take a break from trail riding and gather as a riding group. The location selected for this pavilion overlooks a pond. If the committee desires to have a gravel floor instead of the stamped concrete floor \$2,800 can be deducted from the total cost of the project.

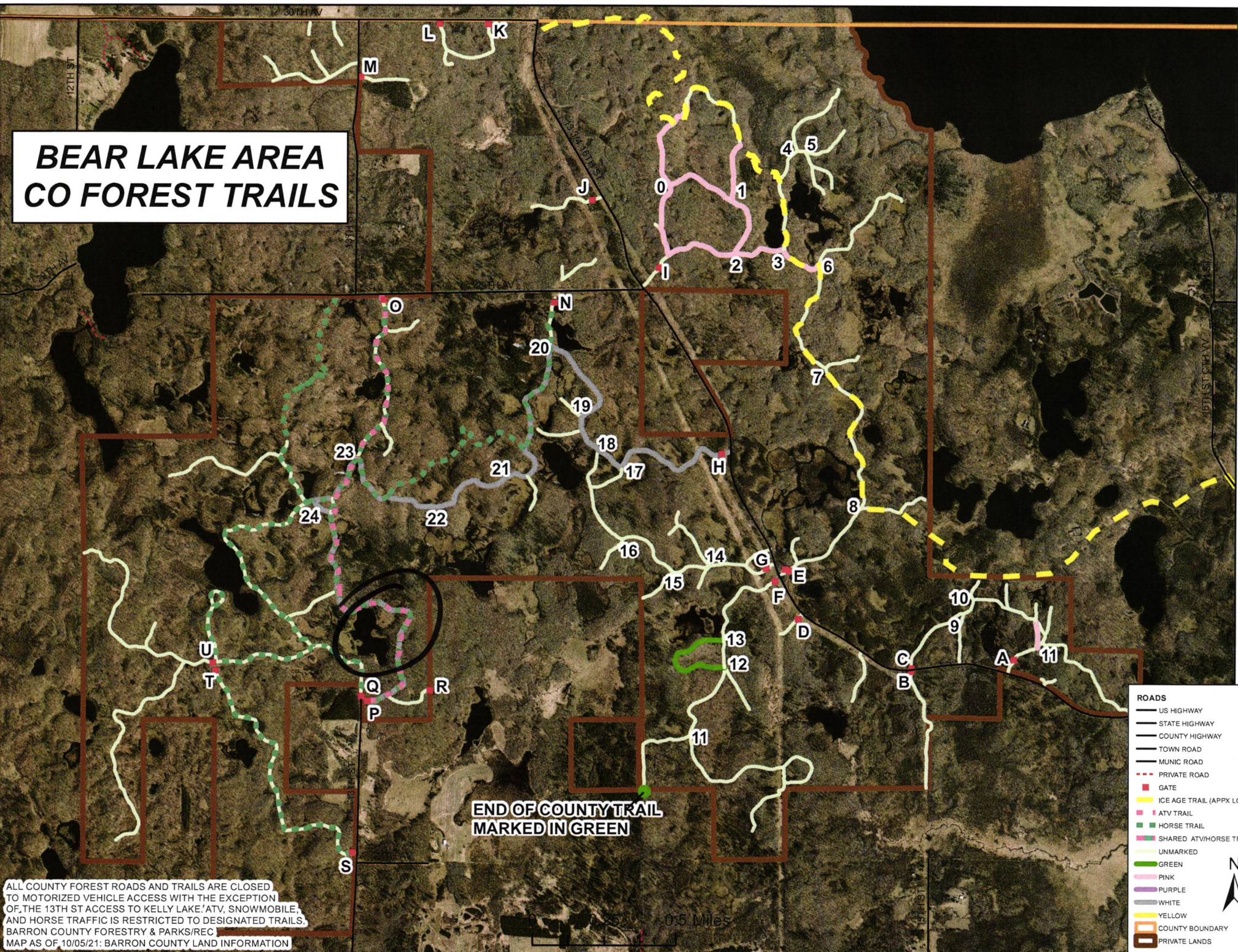
