Project Description Summary

The Rice Lake Snow and Dirt Club along with Barron County proposes to build a 20' x 32' pavilion at the intersection of 2 ATV/UTV trails located on the Cedar Lake County Forest block (intersection 6 on the attached map). These are heavily traveled ATV/UTV trails bear the Barron County boarder with Rusk County. We have received a number of requests to build a pavilion at this location by trail users. We are proposing to build a post frame construction pavilion with a copper colored steel roof, finished soffit and fascia and a finished ceiling. There will be (4) 8' steel picnic tables with rubberized coating placed in the pavilion. The proposed cost estimate includes a stamped concrete floor, if the committee wishes to remove that piece from the project the cost can be reduced by \$3,200 as we would then just provide a gravel floor.

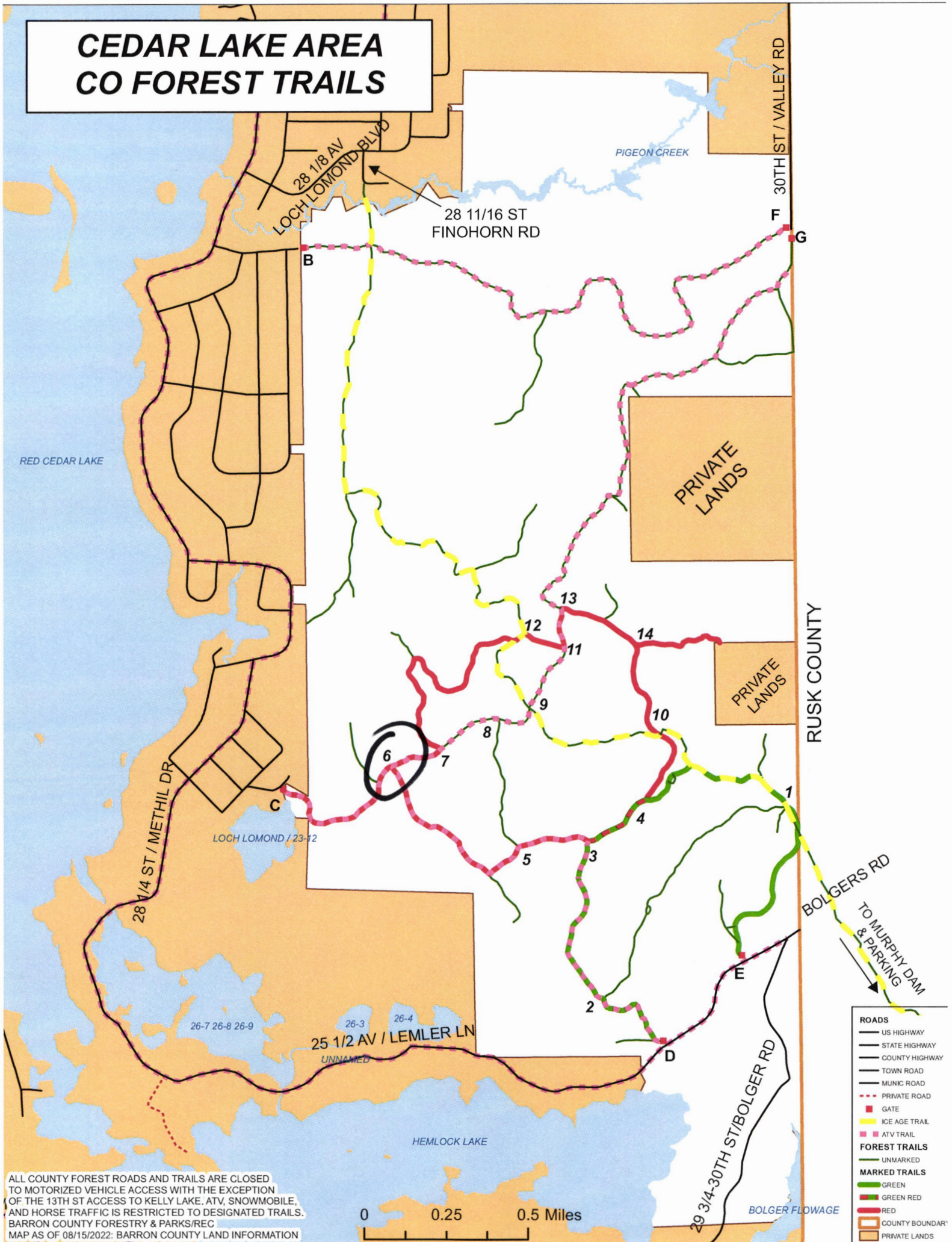
