

Trail Project Detailed Description

The 3-mile section addressed in this application needs to be widened to at least 20 ft, partially to accommodate the larger dimensions of the current grooming equipment. The repair efforts will target cleaning up the banks and slope to the inside of the trail, reestablishing and adding water breaks, and pushing out stumps and dead trees in narrow areas. Part of the section exists on the slope of a ridge top that will need significant work to regrade the trail to a safe condition.

Red line is the property owners we maybe be on doing dozer work touching up parts of trail needing work such as leveling spots removing stumps, removing sluffing of dirt on roadways putting in water-breaks to help run-off, leveling trail for better access with Piston-Bully hills to STEP for a tractor with chains, as they will only tear up ground so water will only wash-out hillside if ground doesn't sod over.





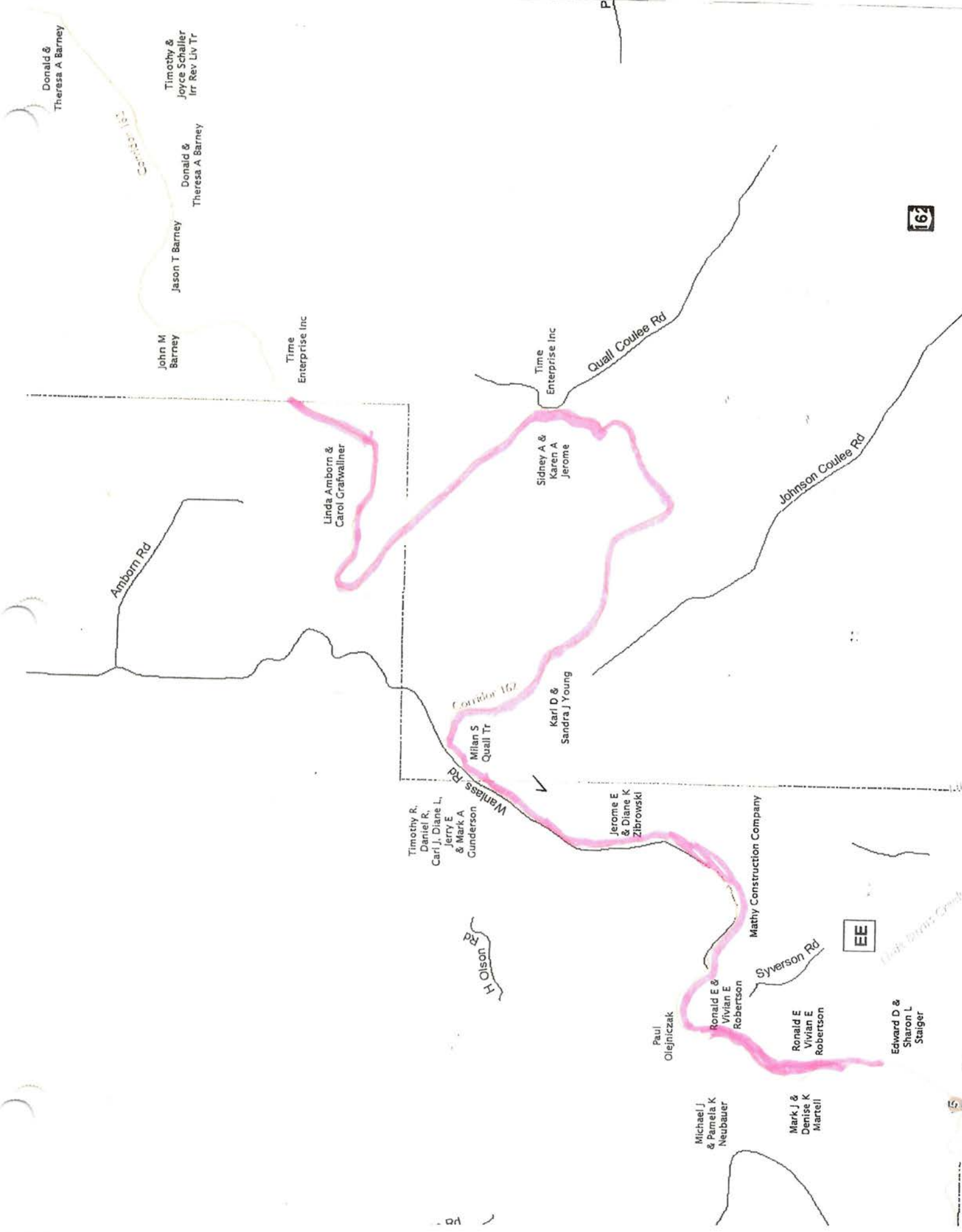
