During the Fall 2022, the White Thunder Riders received notice from a new landowner, on the east side of Hwy 122, on trail 3 that they intended to do construction on their property and the trail would be closed. The WTR rerouted the trail from Co Hwy A to Hwy 122, near the WI/MI state line which connects to the Gogebic County, MI snowmobile trail system. The construction was completed by a local contractor free of charge. The landowners where the new trail was constructed, agreed to try the trail for one season. White Thunder Riders have contacted the landowners, after the season has passed, and they agreed to extend their land use agreements (the new land use agreements will be forwarded as soon as they are made available to ICF). As a result, WisDOT requires a culvert to be installed on the east side of Hwy 122 at the trail intersection. A 30"x30' culvert is required as this ditch has significant water flow especially during spring runoff. This trail is snowmobile only. The adjustment in trail miles is made in our maintenance application.



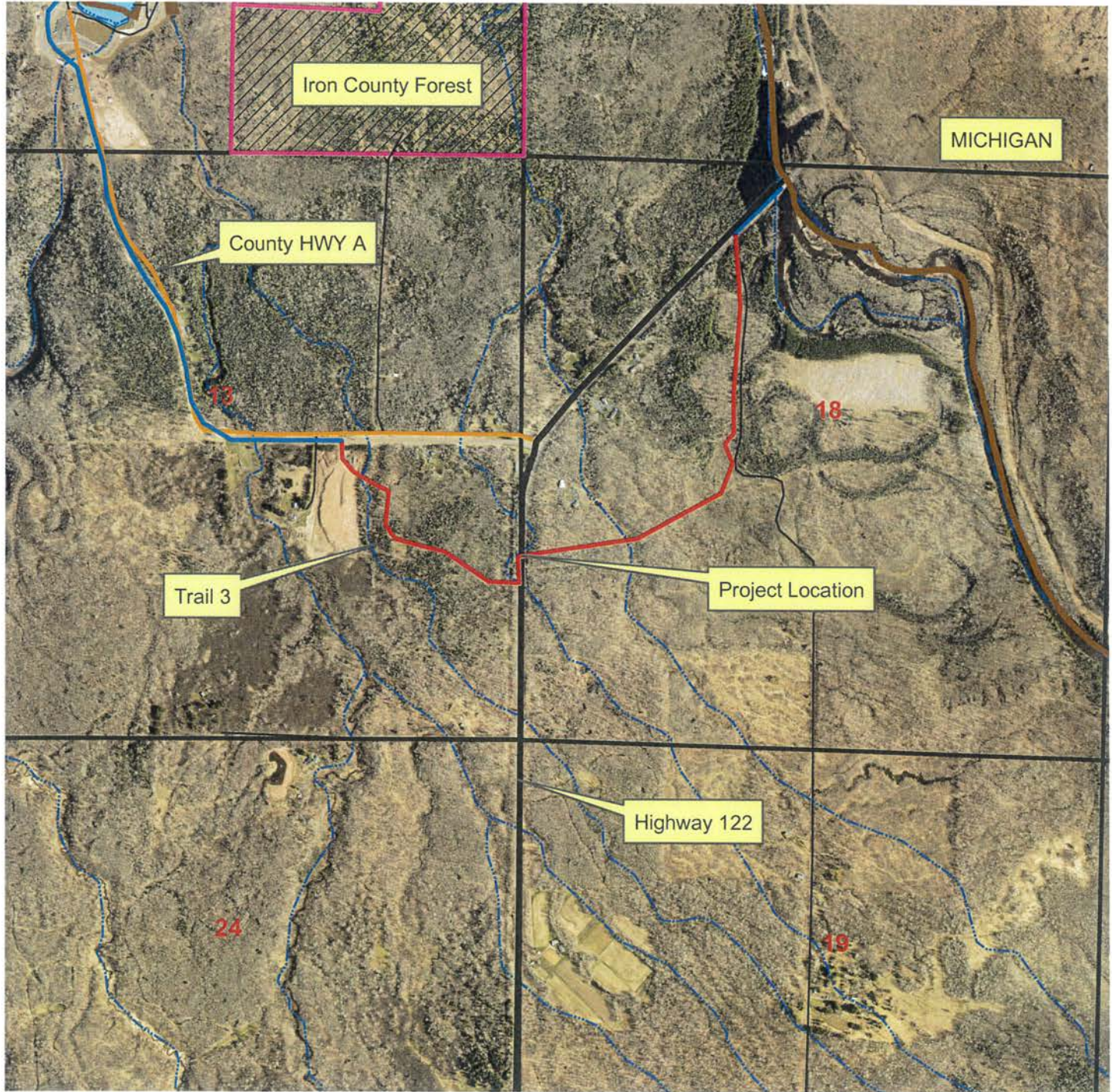
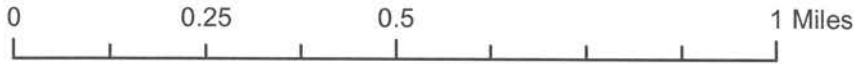
TRAIL 3 Hwy 122 Intersection





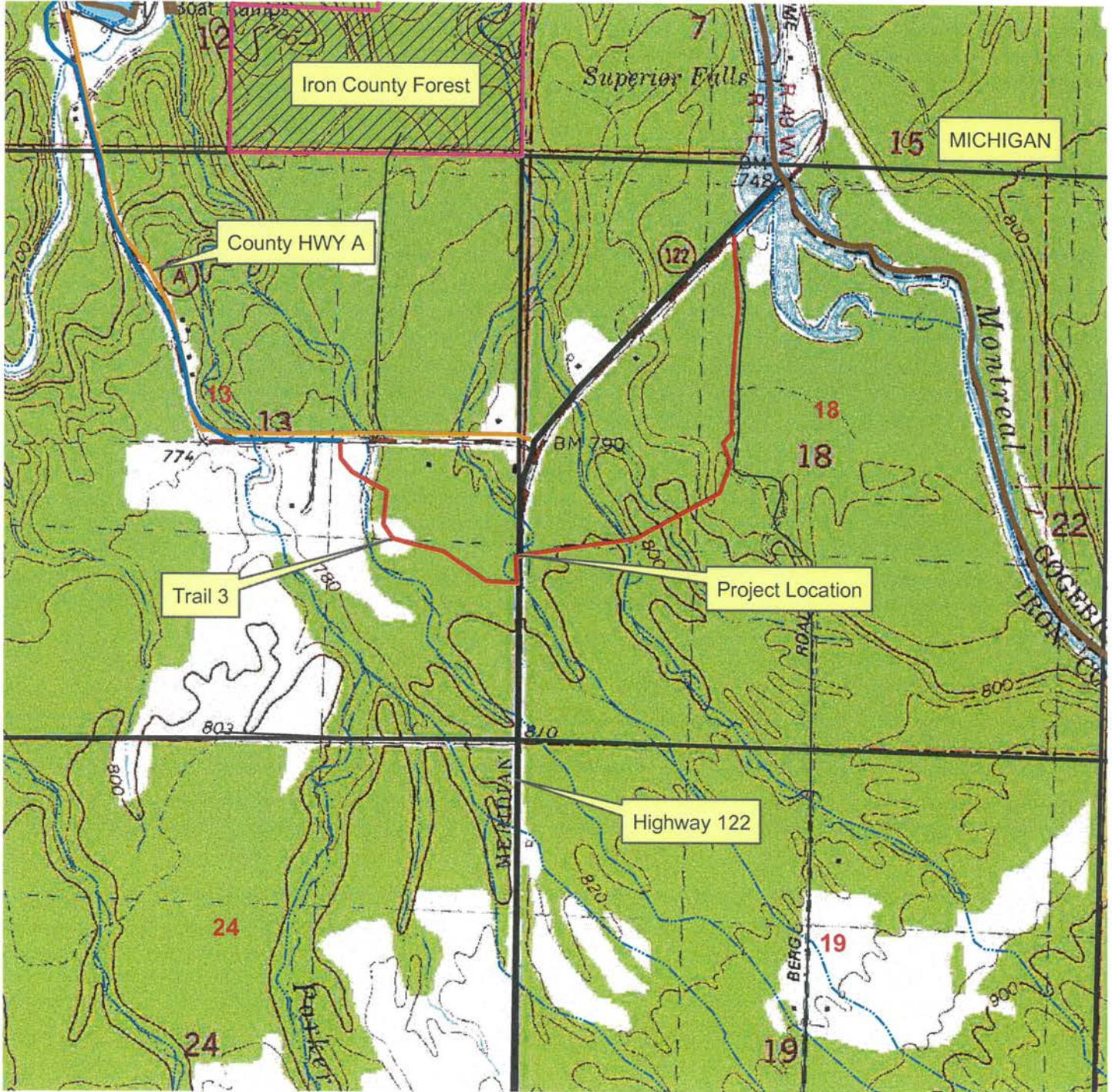
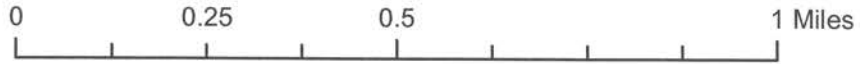

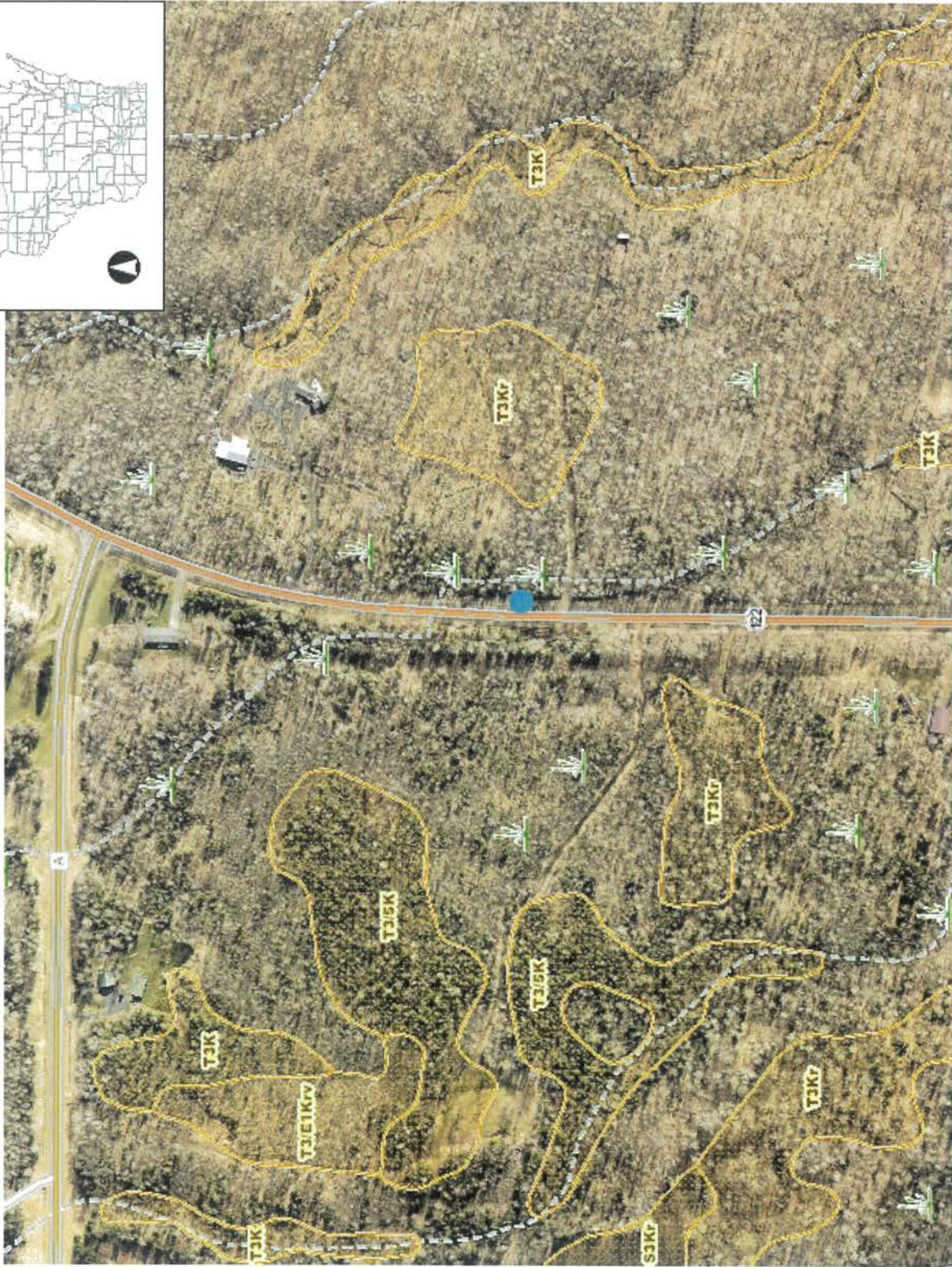

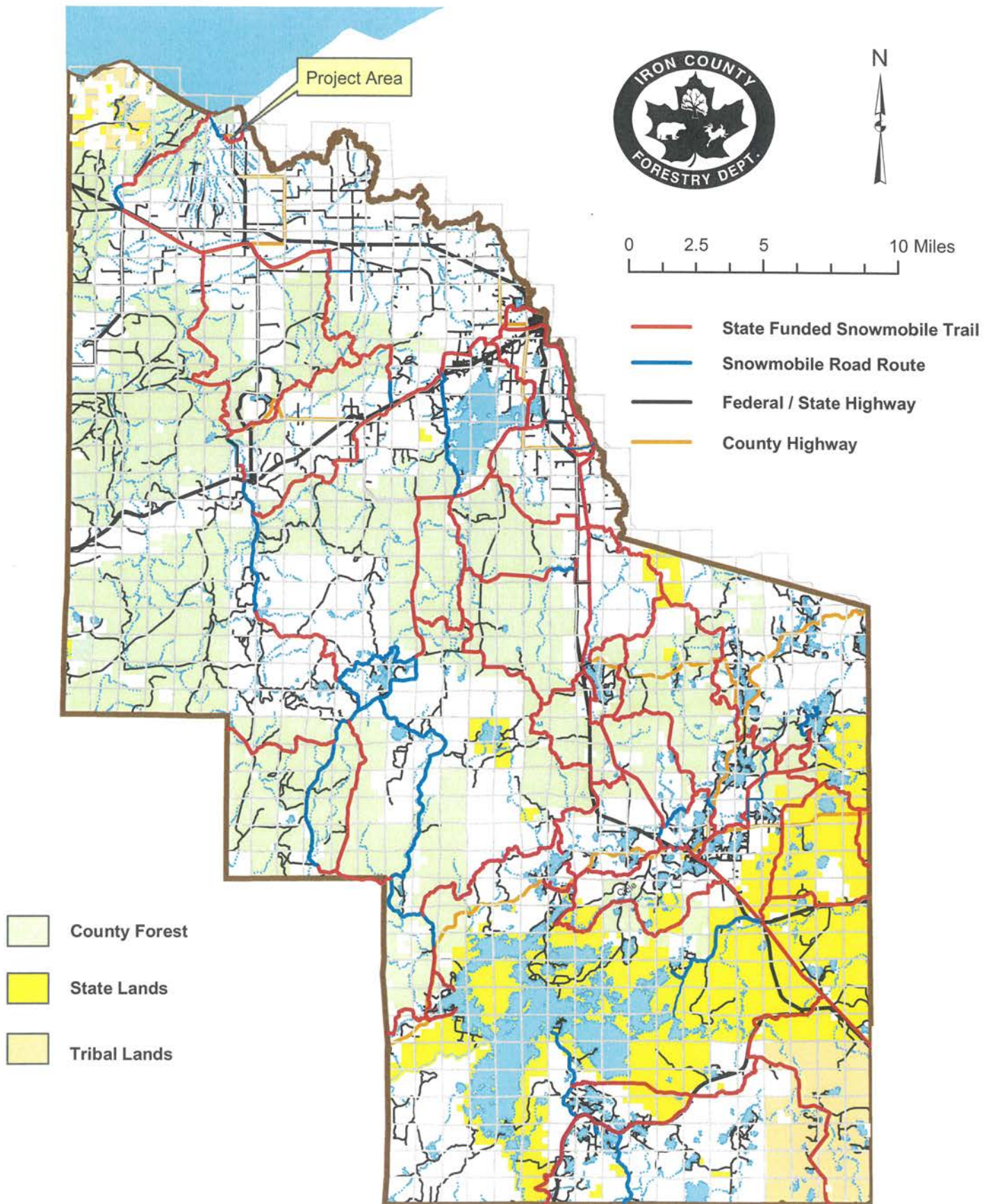


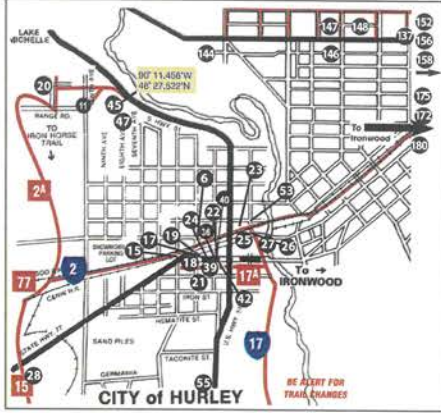
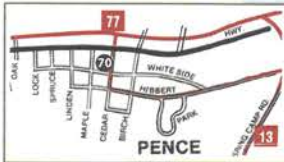
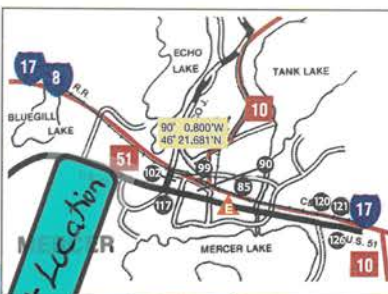
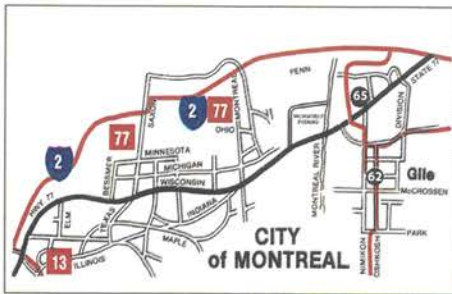
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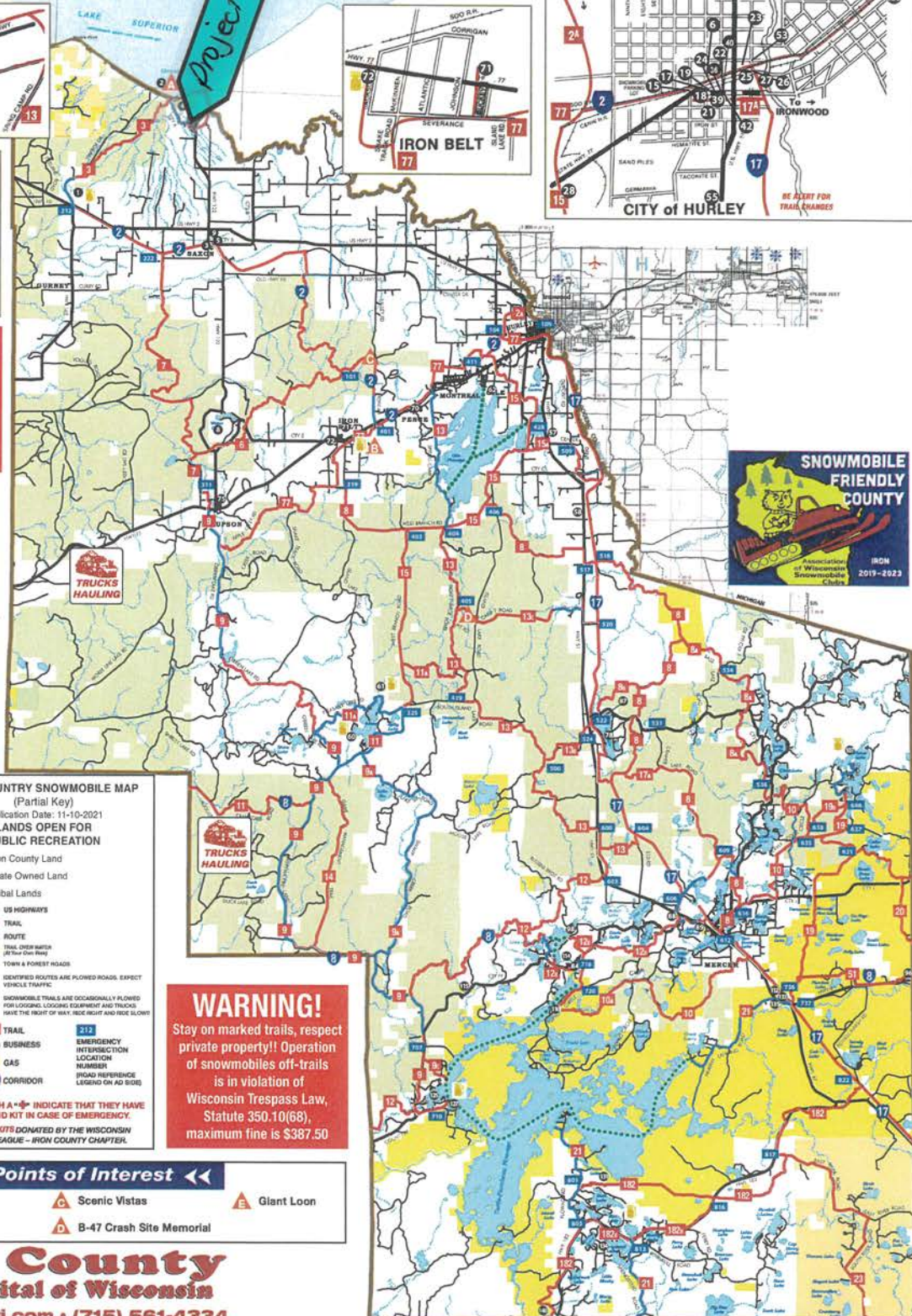


Iron County Forestry "Trail 3 HWY 122 Intersection" Iron County Snowmobile System

WHEREAS, Iron County is eligible to apply for various grants from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, Department of Commerce, Department of Economic Development, Coastal Management Program and the Federal Government Section 154 Corps of Engineers authority; and

WHEREAS, the grant applications must include maps, designs, specifications, work plans, and financial estimates;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Iron County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Forest Administrator and County Clerk to submit applications to the above mentioned funding authorities for grants, including Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Grants for land acquisition, in aid to administer the Iron County Forest for the year, 2023, and
