These pier stations are approximately 54' x 7.5' and 94' x 7.5'. They wil have benches, fishing stations and railings. An ADA accessible walkway will be built to access the entire pier and parking lot.

							Approach: The City will replace an unimproved dirt landing with a 15' x 44' concrete boat ramp to be served by a 10'x 20' floating dock with canoe/kayak launch and 5' x 30' aluminum gangway. Project will create a parking area in a previously disturbed area (see lower lot of overall plan). Parking improvements will include space for 5 vehicle-trailer units (1 ADA) and 13 vehicles (8 ADA), and 1 concrete vault toilet.

This project will provide shore fishing access for residents, especially those with disabilities. Fishing access is currently very limited.  Purpose: The purpose of this grant is to provide ADA-Accessible shore
							fishing opportunities for individuals with disabilities and the general public on Glen Loch.  Objectives:  1. Construct 2 Fishing Piers on Glen Loch by November 2018 Approach:  The City will construct 2 new fishing piers on Glen Loch: East Pier: 14'-6" x 39'-4" pier with a 15' long x10 wide gangway, and West Pier: 10' x 20' pier with a 15' long x 10 wide gangway.  Using other state, federal, and private funding sources (see budget justification/other grants sections), these piers will be linked by a 200' new shoreline boardwalk cantilevered over the water's edge to provide shore fishing opportunities. The project will include engineering, design, permitting, and ramp reconstruction.
						This project will involve rehabilitation of three concrete boat launch ramps on the north shore of the Kewaunee River in the City of Kewaunee. The existing ramps are as follows:  Existing  • West 32'x 50'  • Central 32'x 60'  34'x 70'	
							• East 40'x 60' 40'x 70'
							The three boat launch ramps offer a total of six lanes, two lanes per ramp. The current ramps have been degraded over time due to heavy use and as a result the city is looking to replace the ramps with larger and better designed ramps. Currently, the ramps are short, have an improper slope, and the concrete surfaces are worn providing little traction. The new proposed ramps are engineered to be ADA accessible and are designed to address each of the aforementioned problems.
							The scope includes full ramp and subgrade replacement with a 6" cast-in-place reinforced concrete and 12" base course. A minimum 16" cutoff wall will be constructed on the edges. The surface of the ramps will be finished with 1" V-grooves for added traction. The ramps will enter the water at the proper slope and the toe of the ramps will be at minimum 3 feet below the low water elevation. Rip-rap will be placed along the edges in order to protect the area.
