- With the reduced snow this season, our trail pass revenue is down. Typically we see \$4 million in trail pass generated revenue, but we're sitting at \$2.5 million. But so far, not expecting supplemental requests, so the funds should 'even out'.

 Sam Landes – Some DNR State Properties/Trails direct contracts to Clubs include only funding for grooming. If the entire \$300/mile is not spent on grooming, should they use some of that funding for signs, brushing, etc? Clubs should work with the DNR Property Manager. Those costs are eligible, but make sure the property manager doesn't have other plans for that funding, such as redecking projects.
