## Public Notice of an Air Pollution Control Permit Application Review

#### **Facility Description**

ChemDesign Products Inc., located at 2 Stanton Street, Marinette, Marinette County, Wisconsin, FID 438008340, submitted to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) a permit application, including plans and specifications for the renewal of 438008340-F20 for the operation of a specialty chemicals manufacturing facility; AND to monitor leaks from Processes P38, P52, P62 and P69 using Method 21 in accordance with USEPA's consent agreement and final order (CAFO); and increase the VOC LACT/VOC cap and facility-wide federal hazardous pollutants (HAPS) limits.

Air pollution control Synthetic Minor, Non-Part 70 source operation permit renewal no. 438008340-F30. Air pollution control construction permit revision no. 19-ETE-167.

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources issues Air Pollution Control Operation Permits for sources of emissions, as required by chapter NR 407, Wis. Adm. Code, and Title V of the Clean Air Act (Act). The draft operation permit also contains no revisions to Title I conditions.

All comments received by the DNR at the public hearing if one is held, and prior to the close of the comment period, will be considered prior to making a final decision regarding the proposed project. After the close of the public comment period, a final decision will be made on whether to issue or deny the air pollution control permit.
