RE: 2024 Timber Sale

Sealed bids will be received until 1:00 pm on Monday, May 6, 2024 in the Forest & Parks Office at 301 Washington Street, Oconto, WI 54153. Bids will be publically open Monday, May 6, 2024 at 1:00 pm in the County Board Room #3041 – Courthouse 3rd Floor – Bldg A. The committee or chairperson will take action on the bids received.

A sample of the timber sale contract is available upon request to the Forest & Parks Department. If you are a successful bidder and awarded a contract, please read the contract carefully. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.

Oconto County made changes to the contract to clarify some concerns on scaling and conversation factors.

10 UTILIZATION SPECIFICATIONS

- a. CORDWOOD PRODUCTS
 - i. Shall have a small end diameter between 4 inch or less and maximum diameter of 11 inches
 - ii. Minimum usable length is defined as eight (8) feet
 - iii. Exception Wood diameter greater than 11 inches see below (b)(v)
- b. SAWLOG PRODUCTS
 - i. Sawlog piles must be separated from cordwood piles
 - ii. Minimum usable length is defined as eight (8) feet
 - iii. Minimum diameter, small end for softwood species shall be utilized to a nine (9) inch and hardwood species to an eleven (11) inch with no maximum diameter
 - iv. Trim allowance is set at six inches.
 - v. Exception when a sawlog will not be suitable for the manufacture of lumber, beams, veneer, etc because of a natural defect as determined by the Administrator then said sawlog must be separated and may be scaled as pulpwood.
 - a. Natural Defect may include interior rot, fire scars, seams, cracks
- c. All merchantable wood bulldozed over during road construction must be utilized and paid for.
- d. STUMPS Maximum height shall not exceed the stump diameter, except that stumps of trees less than ten (10) inches in diameter shall not exceed ten (10) inches in height.

And

27. SCALING AND CONVERSION FACTORS

a. Seller will determine whether forest products are to be scaled on site (stick scale) or if haul ticket system will be authorized, or any combination thereof.

- b. Oconto County reserves the right to scale any time all product and species on the premise.
- c. Piles must be sorted according to species listed per contract
 - i. Stick Scale Minimum notice of 24 hours is required for Administrator to stick scale
 - 1. Cordwood Products
 - a. Unit of measure will be cord defined as four (4) feet by four (4) feet by one hundred (100) inches or 128 cubic feet.
 - b. Piles must be level and square.
 - c. Piles cannot be higher than twenty (20) feet
 - d. When peeled cordwood is measured, it is agreed that
 - i. 12.5% will be added to the volume for hand peeled, stroke delimber, or processor peeled
 - ii. 16% will be added to the volume for ring debarked
 - e. Lengths other than 100 inches will be measured to the tenth of inch and calculated based on 128 cubic feet.
 - f. Species sold by weight will have cord volume converted to weight according to species conversion in DNR Timber Sale Handbook 2461
 - i. Piles that are mixed species will be converted proportional by volume estimated for each species
 - g. Billing will be based on cord to weight conversion.
 - 2. Sawlog Products
 - a. Unit of scale will be 1000 board feet or 1 MBF.
 - i. The Scribner Decimal C Log Rule may be used for scaling logs.
 - ii. Piles scaled utilizing cordwood scale, procedure above, then it is agreed that the conversion is as follows:
 - 1. Softwoods 2.44 cords per 1 MBF
 - 2. Hardwoods 2.20 cords per 1 MBF
 - b. Piles cannot be higher than six (6) feet.
 - c. Piles must have small end toward the road/trail to be scaled.
 - d. Piles containing logs of various lengths must have log lengths written on the small end of log with a log crayon.
 - e. Trim allowance exceeding 6 inches allowed will be scaled at the next highest length.
 - f. Maximum scaling length will be sixteen (16) feet.
 - i. Logs over 16 feet will be scaled as two or more logs with the butt log being the longest if split unequally.
 - g. Billing will be based on gross scale and thus grade standards are not a condition of this contract. Risk of loss is assumed by Purchaser for sawlogs not meeting grade standards based on market.
 - ii. Mill Haul Ticket -
 - 1. List of Mill Destinations must be given to Administrator prior to hauling for approval
 - 2. Loads must be scaled by a third party to utilize this method
 - 3. Ticket book will be issued after receiving advance payment for the contract specified and shall not be used on the premise of any other contract
 - 4. Lock boxes will be placed on the premises convenient for Purchaser and Administrator
 - 5. Hauling Process
 - a. One (1) ticket for each load must be filled out prior to leaving the premises.
 - b. Each ticket is three (3) parts
 - i. White Ticket must be deposited into the lock box on premise
 - ii. Yellow Ticket must be attached to the third party scale ticket
 - 1. This ticket is to be returned within 14 days of the date the load was removed from the premise
 - iii. Pink Ticket is the Purchaser copy to be retained for Purchaser record keeping purposes.
 - Failure to follow Hauling process will be considered a breach of contract under Section 6(d)
 - 7. Billing will be based on third party net scale volume

Oconto County is a dual third party certified Forest. This certification requires SFI training for logging contractors, and certificates must be on file or with bid for the bid to be valid. https://dnr.wisconsin.gov/topic/timbersales/countyforests

Those sales requiring HRD spraying the Purchaser shall conduct HRD disease control work. Purchaser shall apply Cellu-Treat fungicide to all conifer stumps within 24 hours of tree cutting. Purchaser shall apply Cellu-Treat according to product label. Application of Cellu-Treat is not required for harvest operations conducted at temperatures below 32 degrees. It is the responsibility of the contractor to obtain any state licenses or certifications necessary for contractual pesticide applications on Oconto County property.







Thinning (15 acres): Cut all ash & aspen >5". Cut all orange marked trees. Leave all dead standing trees except along recreational trails. HRD treatment required daily on cut conifer stumps from April 1st – Nov. 30th. No harvesting April 15th - July 15th.

*In all cutting units - Can reach across red paint lines to cut ash trees.

Special Sale considerations all units

-Slash height shall not exceed 33". Slash must be reduced to 24" within 50' of town roads or recreation trails. No slash within 15' of town roads or recreational trails. Do not leave any slash in any non-forested wetlands.
