


WISCONSIN DNR FISHERIES INFORMATION SHEET

LAKE: Dam COUNTY: Oneida YEAR: 2021

In May 2021, the Department of Natural Resources conducted a fyke netting survey on Dam Lake to assess the Black Crappie population. Four nets were placed and checked daily over the course of three days. Dam Lake is a drainage lake with 744 surface acres, 6.8 miles of shoreline, and a maximum depth of 32 feet.




Black Crappie

A total of 329 Black Crappies were captured while surveying Dam Lake. Lengths ranged from 5.9 to 11.4 inches. The size structure was moderate with 10% of the black crappies measuring 10 inches or greater.


Yellow Perch

A total of 127 Yellow Perch were captured while surveying Dam Lake. Lengths ranged from 4.9 to 10.9 inches. Of the Yellow Perch measured, only 4% were 8 inches or greater.

Bluegill Length Frequency Distribution




Bluegill

A total of 25 Bluegills were captured while surveying Dam Lake. Lengths ranged from 5.3 to 8.7 inches. Of the Bluegills measured, 84% were 7 inches or greater.

Muskellunge

Muskellunge were not specifically tagerted during the survey of Dam Lake, but were measured when caputured. Eight muskellunge were captured and lengths ranged from 34.6 to 45.3 inches.
