# Summary of Fishing Tournaments in Wisconsin for 2012

## Applications

- 603 applications for fishing tournaments were received
- 0 applications were denied
- 23 permitted events were cancelled by organizers
- 12 applications were withdrawn
- 2 applications were left incomplete
- 566 applications were approved and held
- 316 traditional tournaments ( $56 \%$ )
- 334 catch-hold-release tournaments (59\%)
- 149 catch and keep tournaments ( $26 \%$ )
- 112 ice fishing tournaments ( $20 \%$ )
- 83 immediate release tournaments ( $15 \%$ )
- 57 Great Lakes tournaments ( $10 \%$ )


## Distribution

- Tournaments took place in 64 counties throughout Wisconsin (Figure 1)
- Top counties included Winnebago (45), Dane (31), LaCrosse (28), Oneida (27), Polk (26) and Vilas (21)

Results (received as of 2/15/13)

- Seven more tournaments were held in 2012 than in 2011.
- Although fewer anglers fished in 2012 than in 2011, over $\$ 1,000,000$ more was paid out in prizes.
- The number of Great Lakes caught salmon and trout more than doubled from 2011 to 2012.
