SUBJECT: Disposal of solid waste generated as a result of the Germann Road fire

Solid waste generated by the Germann Road fire must be disposed at a Department-approved solid waste facility. Onsite disposal is not allowed. Following is a list of Department-approved solid waste disposal facilities able to accept waste from the fire. This is not an endorsement by the Department but a listing of those facilities within a reasonable disposal distance from the impacted area.
