IMPACTS

Control AIS when they are impacting ecological health or recreational access.

PLANNING

Make a plan to manage AIS over the long term.

MONITORING

Use local data to inform decisions about when and where to control AIS.

TOOLS

Consider all of the available tools before deciding which control technique is right.
