

   moved from "Identifying & Addressing Historic
   Discharges" (#8) to "Research & Knowledge" theme
- 6.1 & 6.3 Combined "Develop and Support Product Stewardship Mechanisms to Reduce PFAS Use" and "Phase Out Paper Products that Contain PFAS"
- 7.3 & 7.4 Combined "Provide Financial Tools for Local Governments" and "Invest in PFAS Clean-Ups in Wisconsin Communities"
