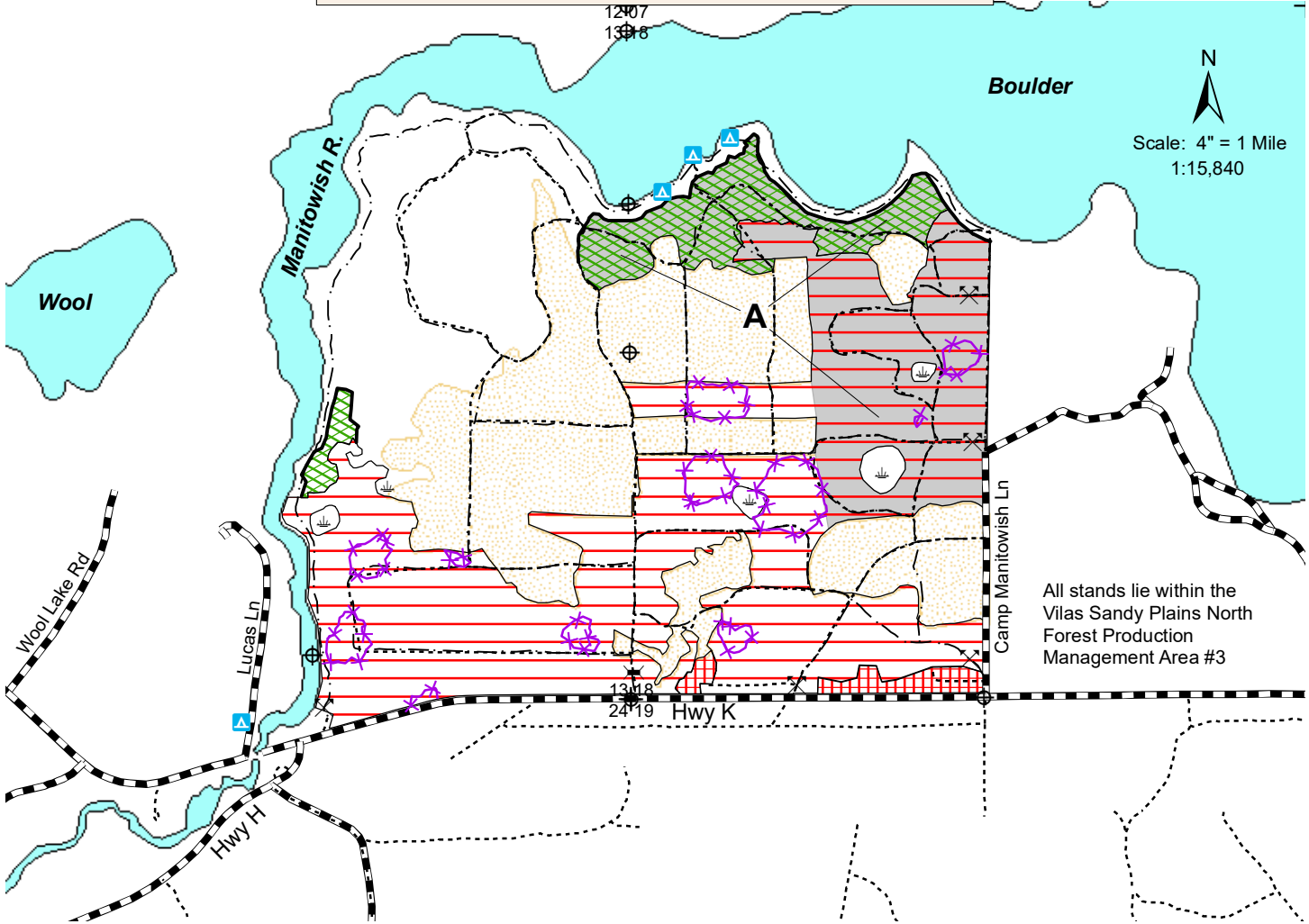

Aspen Coppice (29 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, maple and white birch not marked green. Cut all 1-5" aspen and maple.

Red Pine (207 Acres): Cut all orange marked trees. Cut all red pine within purple marked gaps including purple marked trees.

First Thinning Pine (6 Acres): Cut all orange marked trees.

Note: Do NOT cut trees marked with green paint.

Harvesting operations allowed July 16 - April 14.

Zone A: Harvesting operations allowed September 15 - April 14.

The cutting area is approximately 242 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

¹Volume includes approximately 5% jack pine and an estimated 40 MBF of potential white pine logs.

²Volume includes an estimated 1,250 MBF of potential logs.

³Volume consists of approximately 67% red maple and 33% white birch.

Total sale volume equates to 38.7 tons/acre or 17.2 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Do not cut, knock down, or utilize any dead standing snags unless they pose a hazard to the contractor. Logger may be asked to knock down standing dead trees adjacent to recreational trail for user safety. Biomass harvesting is not allowed.
2. Purple marked gaps are areas of red pine pocket decline. Minimize damage to understory trees within the gaps.
3. Slash within 50 feet of the highways/town roads must be lopped and scattered to lie within 2 feet of the ground and pulled back into the sale area at least 10 feet from the edges of those areas. No tops or slash allowed in adjacent seedling/sapling stands.
4. Recreational trails must be kept free of debris and slash pulled back 10 feet behind tree line. Trails must be repaired to pre-harvest condition.
5. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from the time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
6. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.

In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
