


## "Wilson Hills Aspen", Tract 2-23 Turtle Flambeau Scenic Waters Area Sections 21, 22, 28, T42N R3E, Iron County 58 acres harvested





Unit 1: Aspen Coppice, 58 acres. Harvest all trees 2" and larger except pine, spruce, hemlock, yellow birch, green-marked pockets of trees, or any green-marked trees. Contract Length 3 years.

## <u>Turtle Flambeau Scenic Waters Area: Tract # 2-23</u> "Wilson Hills Aspen"

The cutting area is approximately **58 acres**.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

<sup>1</sup> Aspen consists of approximately 93% quaking aspen and 7% bigtooth aspen.

Total sale volume equals approximately 47 tons/acre or 21 cords/acre. Volumes above reflect utilization to 4" top.

## **Special Considerations-**

- Harvesting will be allowed year-round. Equipment use will be restricted to very dry/firm or frozen ground conditions. There are two (2) areas of the sale that require crossing wetlands if accessed from State land. Wetland crossings must be approved by the forester.
- Equipment must be clean before entering sale area.
- Sale boundaries are marked with red or blue paint. Retain all boundary trees.
- Retain all suitable snag and den trees that do not pose a safety hazard.
- Scatter all slash and cut to within 2 feet of the ground.
- Hunter walking trails may be used as logging roads. These trails must be maintained free of debris as work is completed.
- Any new road, trails, and landings must be approved by the sale administrator.
- A wildlife opening north of Unit 1 can be used as a landing as long as the soil is not bull-dozed.
- All landings and access points shall be returned to original condition when the sale is completed.

<sup>2</sup> Mixed Hardwood consists of approximately 73% white birch and 27% red maple. Included is an estimated 4 MBF sawlog material.
