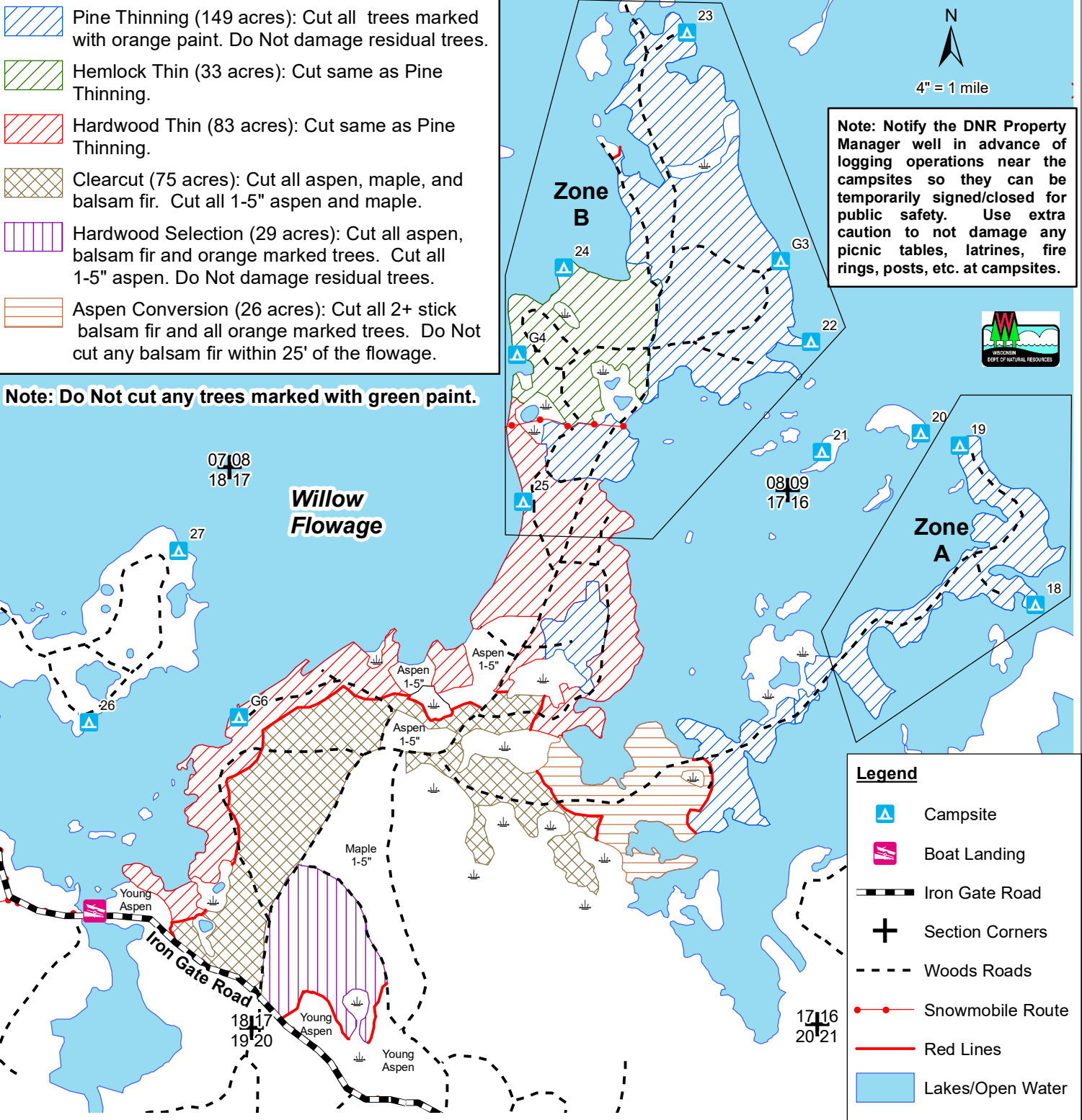

-  Pine Thinning (149 acres): Cut all trees marked with orange paint. Do Not damage residual trees.
-  Hemlock Thin (33 acres): Cut same as Pine Thinning.
-  Hardwood Thin (83 acres): Cut same as Pine Thinning.
-  Clearcut (75 acres): Cut all aspen, maple, and balsam fir. Cut all 1-5" aspen and maple.
-  Hardwood Selection (29 acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir and orange marked trees. Cut all 1-5" aspen. Do Not damage residual trees.
-  Aspen Conversion (26 acres): Cut all 2+ stick balsam fir and all orange marked trees. Do Not cut any balsam fir within 25' of the flowage.

Note: Do Not cut any trees marked with green paint.

Note: Notify the DNR Property Manager well in advance of logging operations near the campsites so they can be temporarily signed/closed for public safety. Use extra caution to not damage any picnic tables, latrines, fire rings, posts, etc. at campsites.

Zone A (29 acres): Logging operations are allowed only from Sept. 15 to January 15.
Zone B (143 acres): Logging operations are allowed only from Sept. 15 to May 15.
Overall sale logging operations are allowed during daylight hours only.

The cutting area is approximately 395 acres.

The contract period will expire on June 30, 2027.

All trees that are painted orange or that are designated to be harvested in a specified area and that yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Biomass (whole-tree) utilization is not allowed.

² Red Pine includes approximately 54 MBF sawtimber.

³ Mixed Hardwood is approx. 91% Red Maple, 5% Hard Maple, 4% White Birch. Includes 19 MBF red maple sawtimber and 1 MBF hard maple sawtimber.

Note: Total sale volume equates to 23.3 tons/acre or 10.4 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. Notify the Willow DNR Property Manager well in advance of logging operations commencing near the campsites so they can be temporarily signed/closed for public safety. Use extra caution to not damage any picnic tables, latrines, fire rings, signs, posts, etc. at the campsites.
2. Sale logging operations must occur during daylight hours to minimize impacts to campers and other recreation users.
3. Logging operations are only allowed from **September 15th to May 15th in Zone B** (143 acres).
4. In Zone A (29 acres): logging operations are allowed only from September 15th to January 15th.
5. Note: ATV's and snowmobiles are seasonally allowed on Iron Gate Road. Iron Gate Road is not plowed during winter. Contractor will be responsible for all snowplowing needs. Snowplowing must leave adequate snow for trail use by snowmobiles.
6. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees, except they may be cut down along roadways where they pose a safety hazard.
7. Slash within 50 feet of all roads, trails, and waterbodies must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and be pulled back 10 feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting. No slash allowed across any wetland or waterbody.
8. Do not cut any trees within 15 feet of the Willow Flowage or ephemeral ponds. All wetland areas are to be avoided as much as possible or only operated within during dry or frozen ground conditions to prevent rutting.
9. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Do not damage residual trees.
10. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved by the Willow Property Manager. Decking of wood will not be allowed within 200 feet of the Willow Flowage.
11. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
12. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
